SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to set up your podcast equipment bundle:

- 1. **Initial Charge:** Before first use, ensure the V8 Live Sound Card is fully charged using the provided USB charging cable. Connect the USB cable to the sound card and a compatible 5V DC power source.
- 2. **Assemble the Arm Stand:** Attach the adjustable suspension scissor arm stand to your desk using the desk mount clamp. Securely tighten the clamp.
- 3. Attach Shock Mount: Mount the shock mount onto the adjustable arm stand.
- 4. Insert Microphone: Carefully place the BM-800 condenser microphone into the shock mount.
- 5. **Connect Microphone Cable:** Connect the XLR end of the microphone cable to the BM-800 microphone and the 3.5mm end to the 'Condenser mic' input on the V8 Live Sound Card.
- 6. **Attach Pop Filter and Foam Cap:** Secure the pop filter to the arm stand in front of the microphone. Place the anti-wind foam cap over the microphone head.
- 7. **Connect to Device:** Use the audio output cables to connect the V8 Live Sound Card to your recording device (e.g., mobile phone, laptop, computer, gaming console). The sound card has multiple output ports for various connection scenarios.


- **Volume Knobs:** Adjust microphone volume, echo level, treble, bass, accompaniment volume, record volume, and monitor volume using the dedicated knobs.

Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your podcast equipment bundle, consider the following:

• No Sound/Low Volume:

- Ensure all cables are securely connected.
- o Check the volume knobs on the sound card (Mic, Monitor, Record, Echo) and your connected device.
- Verify the sound card is powered on and charged.
- Confirm the correct input/output device is selected in your computer's sound settings.

• Static/Background Noise:

- Ensure the microphone cable is not damaged and is properly connected.
- Test in a different environment to rule out electrical interference.
- · Adjust the microphone gain on the sound card.

• Voice Changer Not Working:

- o Confirm the voice changer function is activated on the sound card.
- Ensure compatibility with your specific device and application.

• Connectivity Issues (e.g., with iPhone):

 Some devices, particularly newer iPhones, may require a specific adapter (e.g., Lightning to 3.5mm adapter) which is not included in this bundle.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your equipment:

• Cleaning: Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the surfaces of the microphone and sound card. Avoid liquid cleaners.

- Storage: Store the equipment in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Cable Care: Avoid bending or twisting cables excessively to prevent internal damage.
