PINKCAT Multi-Device Bluetooth Keyboard User Manual

INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your PINKCAT Multi-Device Bluetooth Keyboard. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product to ensure proper functionality and to maximize your user experience.

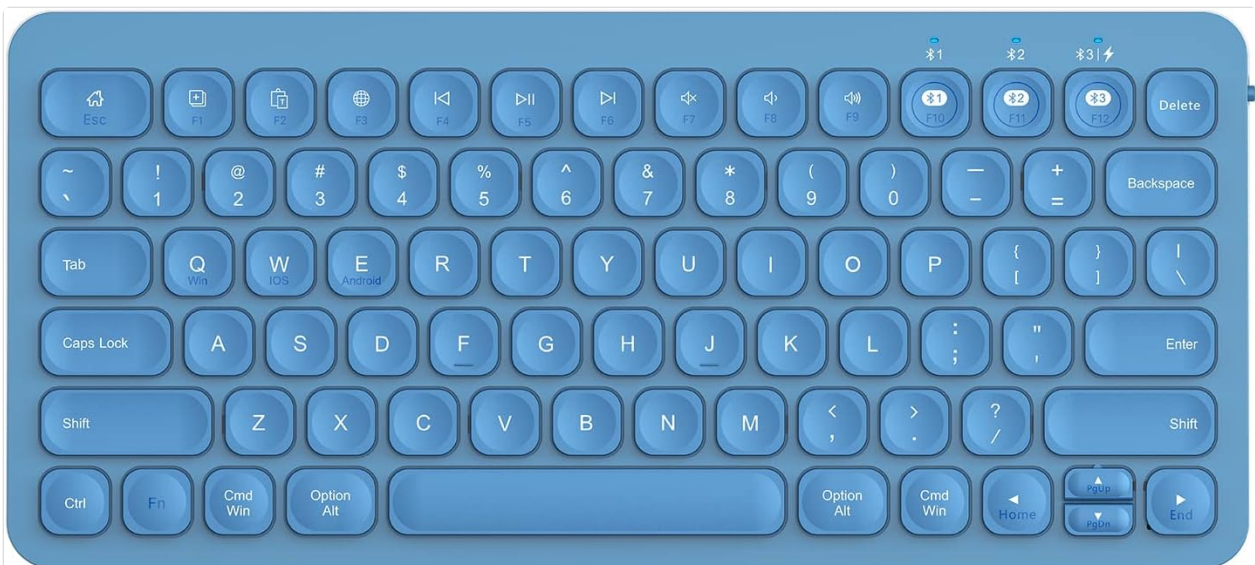


Image: Top view of the PINKCAT Multi-Device Bluetooth Keyboard, showcasing its compact layout and blue color.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Ensure all items are present in the package:

- PINKCAT Multi-Device Bluetooth Keyboard
- User Manual (this document)

Note: AAA batteries are required and not included in the package.

SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

1. Battery Installation

1. Locate the battery compartment on the underside of the keyboard.
2. Open the battery compartment cover.
3. Insert two (2) AAA batteries, ensuring correct polarity (+/-).
4. Close the battery compartment cover securely.

The keyboard requires 2 AAA batteries for operation. These are not supplied.

2. Bluetooth Pairing

The PINKCAT Bluetooth Keyboard can connect to up to three devices simultaneously. Follow these steps to pair with your devices:

1. Turn on the keyboard using the power switch, usually located on the side or back.
2. Press and hold the **Fn** key and one of the Bluetooth channel keys (**F10 (BT1)**, **F11 (BT2)**, or **F12 (BT3)**) for 3-5 seconds until the corresponding Bluetooth indicator light starts blinking. This indicates the keyboard is in pairing mode.
3. On your device (computer, tablet, smartphone), go to the Bluetooth settings.
4. Search for available Bluetooth devices. The keyboard should appear as "PINKCAT Keyboard" or similar.
5. Select the keyboard from the list to initiate pairing. Your device may prompt you to enter a code displayed on the screen using the keyboard, then press Enter.
6. Once paired, the indicator light will stop blinking and remain solid for a few seconds, then turn off. The keyboard is now connected.

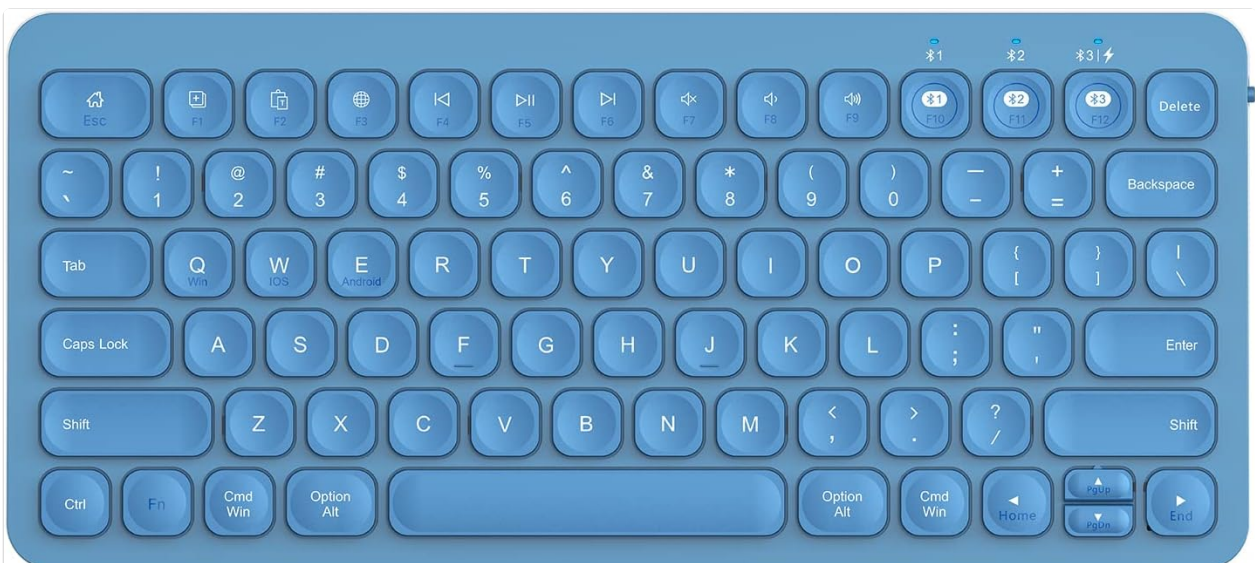


Image: Top view of the PINKCAT Bluetooth Keyboard, highlighting the F10, F11, and F12 keys for Bluetooth channel selection.

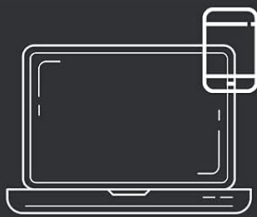

3. Switching Between Operating Systems

The keyboard is compatible with Windows, macOS, iOS, and Android systems. To optimize key functions for your specific operating system, use the following key combinations:

- **Fn + Q:** Switch to Windows OS layout
- **Fn + W:** Switch to iOS/macOS layout
- **Fn + E:** Switch to Android OS layout

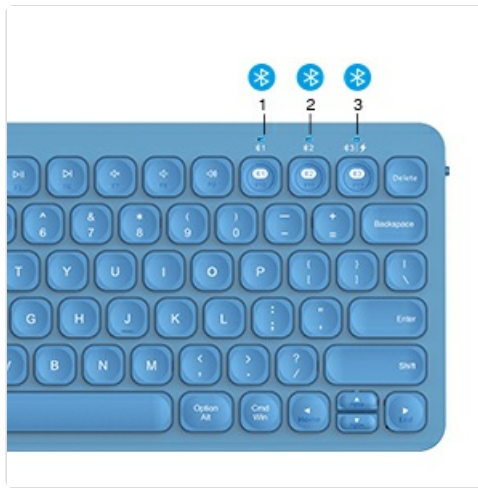


Image: Detail of the keyboard showing the Q, W, and E keys, which are used in combination with the Fn key to switch between operating system layouts.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

General Use

Once connected, the keyboard functions like a standard keyboard. The compact design and scissor-switch keys provide a comfortable and quiet typing experience.

Stable Scissor Mechanism

Function Keys (Hotkeys)

The keyboard features 16 hotkeys and programmable F-keys for quick access to various functions. These keys are typically accessed by pressing the **Fn** key in combination with the desired F-key (F1-F12) or dedicated multimedia keys.

- **F1-F9:** Multimedia and system control functions (e.g., Home, Search, Brightness, Play/Pause, Volume).
- **F10-F12:** Bluetooth device switching (BT1, BT2, BT3).

Optimized Multimedia Keys

Smart Sleep Mode

To conserve battery life, the keyboard will automatically enter a smart sleep mode after 30 minutes of inactivity. To wake the keyboard, simply press any key. It will automatically reconnect to the last paired device.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

- Ensure the keyboard is turned off before cleaning.
- Use a soft, lint-free cloth slightly dampened with water or a mild cleaning solution.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasives, or solvents, as these can damage the keyboard's surface.
- For dust and debris between keys, use compressed air.

Battery Replacement

When the keyboard's performance degrades or it fails to connect, it may be time to replace the batteries. Follow the battery installation steps in the "Setup Instructions" section to replace the two AAA batteries.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Keyboard Not Connecting/Pairing

- **Check Batteries:** Ensure fresh AAA batteries are correctly installed.
- **Power On:** Verify the keyboard is turned on.
- **Pairing Mode:** Make sure the keyboard is in pairing mode (indicator light blinking) by pressing and holding **Fn + F10/F11/F12** for 3-5 seconds.
- **Device Bluetooth:** Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your device and it is discoverable.
- **Forget Device:** If previously paired, try "forgetting" or "removing" the keyboard from your device's Bluetooth settings and then re-pair.
- **Distance:** Ensure the keyboard is within the 10-meter (33ft) Bluetooth range of your device.
- **Interference:** Move away from other wireless devices that might cause interference.

Keys Not Responding or Typing Incorrectly

- **Battery Level:** Low batteries can cause erratic behavior. Replace them.
- **OS Mode:** Ensure the correct operating system mode is selected (**Fn + Q** for Windows, **Fn + W** for iOS/macOS, **Fn + E** for Android).
- **Reconnection:** Turn the keyboard off and on, then allow it to reconnect.
- **Clean Keys:** Check for debris under the keys and clean if necessary.

Keyboard Enters Sleep Mode Too Quickly

The keyboard is designed to enter sleep mode after 30 minutes of inactivity to save power. This is a normal function. Press any key to wake it up.

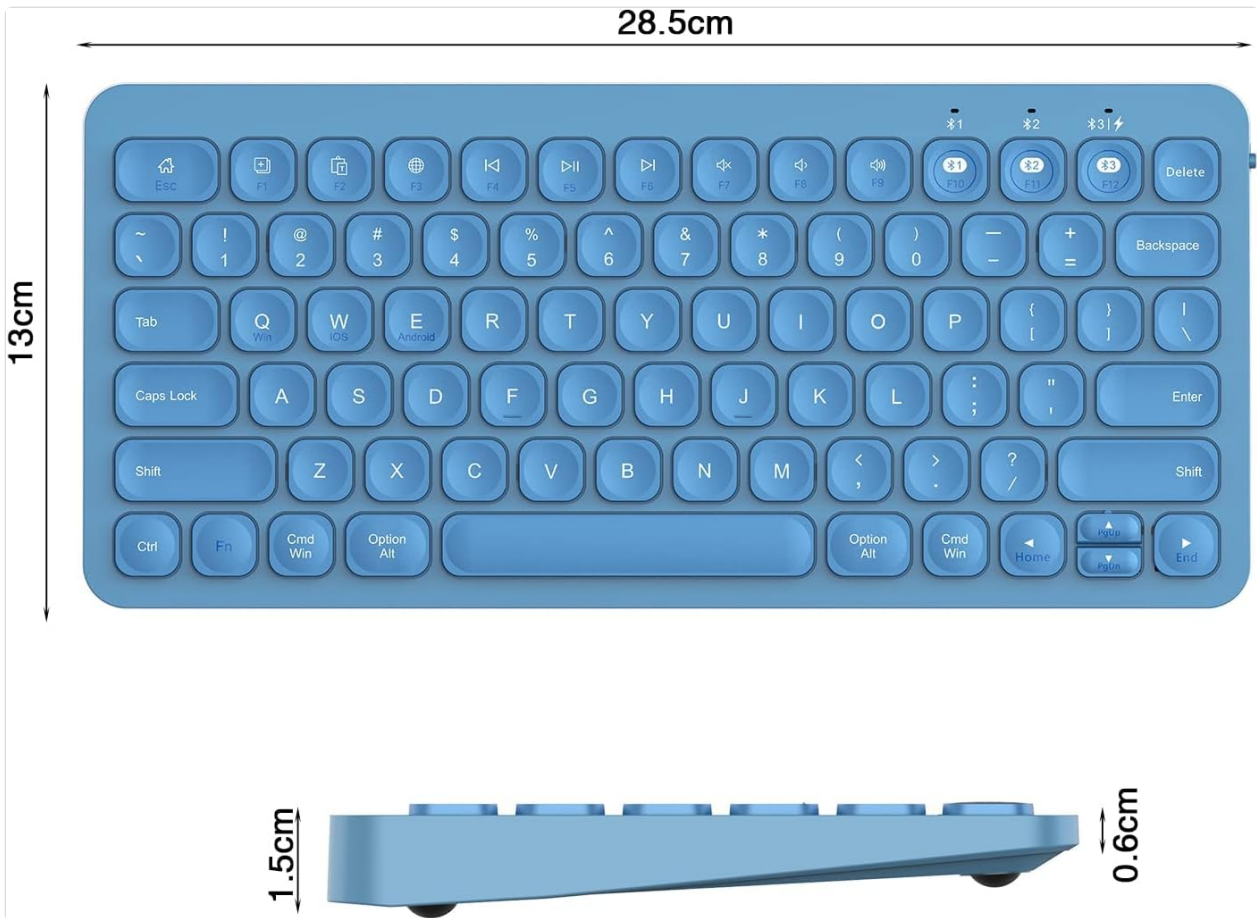
