- **AirLite Bumper Guard:** Offers lightweight protection for the racket frame edge against impacts.

2. SETUP

The Wilson Burn Tour XP 103 tennis racket comes pre-strung and ready for immediate use. No complex assembly is required.

Initial Inspection:

- Unpackaging:** Carefully remove the racket from its packaging.
- Visual Check:** Inspect the racket for any visible damage to the frame, strings, or grip that might have occurred during shipping.
- Grip Comfort:** Ensure the grip feels comfortable and secure in your hand. If desired, an overgrip can be applied for additional comfort or moisture absorption.
- String Tension:** While pre-strung, players may choose to have the string tension adjusted by a professional stringer to suit their personal preference and playing style.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Wilson Burn Tour XP 103 is designed for general tennis play. Its features are optimized for players seeking a balance of power and control.

Using Your Racket:

- Grip:** Hold the racket firmly but not too tightly. The perforated grip is designed to enhance moisture absorption and provide a secure hold.
- Swing Mechanics:** Utilize the racket's mid-size head and Arc 2 Technology for stable and controlled swings. The Double Hole Grommet Technology expands the sweet spot, making it more forgiving on off-center hits and boosting power.
- Court Use:** This racket is suitable for all court surfaces. The AirLite bumper guard provides protection during groundstrokes and serves, especially near the baseline.

4. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance will extend the life and performance of your Wilson Burn Tour XP 103 tennis racket.

Care and Storage:

- Cleaning:** Wipe the frame and strings with a soft, damp cloth after each use to remove dirt and sweat. Avoid harsh chemicals.
- String Care:** Check strings regularly for fraying or breakage. Replace broken strings promptly to prevent damage to the frame. Consider restringing periodically based on frequency of play and string type.
- Grip Care:** If the grip becomes worn or loses its tackiness, replace it or apply a new overgrip.
- Storage:** Store the racket in a racket bag or cover to protect it from extreme temperatures, moisture, and physical damage. Avoid leaving it in direct sunlight or in a car trunk for extended periods.

- **Bumper Guard:** The AirLite bumper guard is designed for protection, but inspect it periodically for wear. If severely damaged, it may need replacement by a professional.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your tennis racket.

Common Issues and Solutions:

- **Loss of Power/Control:**

- *Cause:* Worn-out or loose strings.
- *Solution:* Restring the racket. Consult a professional for optimal tension.

- **Vibration During Play:**

- *Cause:* Loose strings, cracked frame, or lack of a vibration dampener.
- *Solution:* Check string tension. Inspect frame for cracks. Consider adding a vibration dampener to the strings.

- **Grip Slipping:**

- *Cause:* Worn grip, sweat accumulation.
- *Solution:* Replace the grip or apply an overgrip. Ensure hands are dry before playing.

- **Frame Damage:**

- *Cause:* Impact with court, net, or other objects.
- *Solution:* Minor scratches are normal. Significant cracks or deformities may require racket replacement. The AirLite bumper guard helps mitigate minor impacts.
