INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the Lexmark MS823dn Desktop Laser Printer. 1. SETUP

2. OPERATION

2.1 Basic Printing

- 1. Ensure the printer is powered on and connected to your computer or network.
- 2. Open the document you wish to print on your computer.

- 6. Close the front access door.

3.2 Cleaning the Printer

Regular cleaning helps maintain print quality and extends printer life.

- Exterior: Wipe the exterior surfaces with a soft, damp, lint-free cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners.
- Interior: Periodically clean the paper path and rollers using a dry, lint-free cloth. Refer to the printer's display for

3.3 Imaging Unit and Fuser

The Lexmark MS823dn features a long-life imaging unit and a fuser designed for extended use, potentially never requiring replacement under normal operating conditions. Consult the printer's display or Lexmark support for any specific messages regarding these components.

4. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your Lexmark MS823dn printer.

4.1 Printer Not Responding

- Ensure the printer is powered on and the power cord is securely connected.
- · Check the USB or Ethernet cable connection between the printer and your computer/network.
- Verify that the correct printer driver is installed and selected on your computer.
- · Restart both the printer and your computer.

4.2 Paper Jams

- Follow the instructions displayed on the printer's control panel to locate and clear the paper jam.
- Carefully remove any jammed paper, pulling in the direction of the paper path to avoid tearing.
- Ensure paper trays are loaded correctly and paper guides are adjusted properly.

4.3 Poor Print Quality

- · Check the toner cartridge level and replace it if low.
- Ensure you are using appropriate paper for your print job.
- Clean the printer's interior, especially the paper path and rollers.
- · Adjust print quality settings in your printer driver.
