## INTRODUCTION

---

Thank you for choosing the GLOBBER NL 205 Scooter. This manual provides important information regarding the assembly, safe operation, and maintenance of your scooter. Please read it thoroughly before first use and retain it for future reference. This scooter is designed for recreational use by children aged 8 and above, teenagers, and adults.

## SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

To ensure a safe riding experience, always adhere to the following safety guidelines:

- Always wear a helmet, knee pads, elbow pads, and wrist guards.
- Ensure all locking mechanisms are securely fastened before each ride.
- Do not ride in wet conditions, on uneven surfaces, or at night.
- Avoid riding on public roads with vehicle traffic.
- Maintain a safe distance from pedestrians and other riders.
- Check brakes, wheels, and steering for proper function before each use.
- The maximum weight capacity for this scooter is 100 kg (220 lbs).
- Adult supervision is recommended for younger riders.

## ASSEMBLY

---

The GLOBBER NL 205 Scooter comes largely pre-assembled. Follow these steps for final setup:

1. **Unfold the Scooter:** Place the scooter on a flat surface. Locate the patented folding mechanism near the front wheel. Press the release button or lever and gently pull the handlebar stem upwards until it locks into the upright position. Ensure it clicks securely.
2. **Attach Handlebars (if detached):** If the handlebars are separate, slide them into the T-bar until they click into place. Ensure the quick-release clamp is tightened securely.
3. **Adjust Handlebar Height:** Loosen the quick-release clamp on the handlebar stem. Adjust the T-bar to your desired height, ensuring it is comfortable and safe for riding. Align the T-bar with the front wheel. Tighten the quick-release clamp firmly. Ensure the handlebar does not wobble.
4. **Check All Connections:** Before riding, double-check all screws, bolts, and quick-release clamps to ensure they are tight and secure.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### Folding and Unfolding

The GLOBBER NL 205 features a patented folding system for easy storage and transport.

- **To Unfold:** Follow the assembly step 1. Ensure the stem is fully extended and locked.
- **To Fold:** Locate the folding mechanism at the base of the handlebar stem. Press the release button/lever and gently push the handlebar stem downwards until it folds completely. The scooter should stand independently in its folded position.

### Adjusting Handlebar Height

Adjust the handlebar height to ensure a comfortable and ergonomic riding posture.

1. Loosen the quick-release clamp on the handlebar stem.
2. Slide the T-bar up or down to the desired height. Ensure the T-bar is aligned straight with the front wheel.
3. Tighten the quick-release clamp firmly until there is no movement or wobble in the handlebar.

### Riding the Scooter

- Place one foot firmly on the deck of the scooter.
- Use your other foot to push off the ground to gain momentum.
- Once moving, place both feet on the deck, one behind the other.
- Steer by gently leaning and turning the handlebars in the desired direction.
- To brake, use the hand brake lever on the handlebar or press down on the rear fender brake with your foot. Apply brakes gradually to avoid sudden stops.

## MAINTENANCE

---

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and safe operation of your scooter.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the scooter with a damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners. Avoid direct water spray on bearings.
- **Wheels and Bearings:** Regularly check wheels for wear and tear. Replace worn wheels. Bearings (ABEC 7) are sealed and generally maintenance-free, but avoid exposing them to water or excessive dirt.
- **Brakes:** Ensure the hand brake and rear fender brake are functioning correctly. Adjust if necessary (refer to a professional if unsure).
- **Fasteners:** Periodically check all bolts, nuts, and quick-release clamps for tightness. Tighten any loose fasteners.
- **Storage:** Store the scooter in a dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Handlebar wobbles	Quick-release clamp is loose.	Tighten the quick-release clamp firmly.
Scooter does not fold/unfold easily	Folding mechanism is stiff or obstructed.	Apply a small amount of lubricant to the mechanism. Ensure no debris is blocking it.
Brakes are not effective	Brake cable loose or worn brake pad.	Check brake cable tension. Inspect and replace worn brake pads. Consult a professional if needed.
Wheels are noisy or rough	Dirty or worn bearings.	Clean wheels and check bearings. Replace bearings if necessary.
