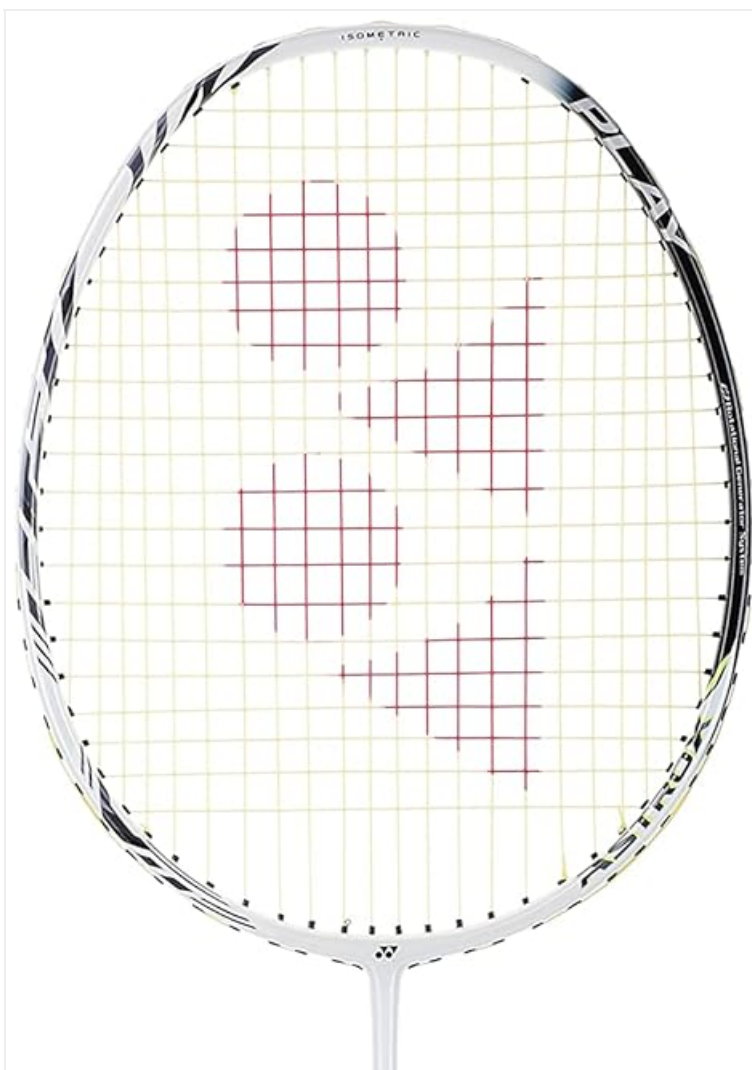




Figure 1: The YONEX Astrox 99 Play Badminton Racquet, featuring its white and black design with a black grip.

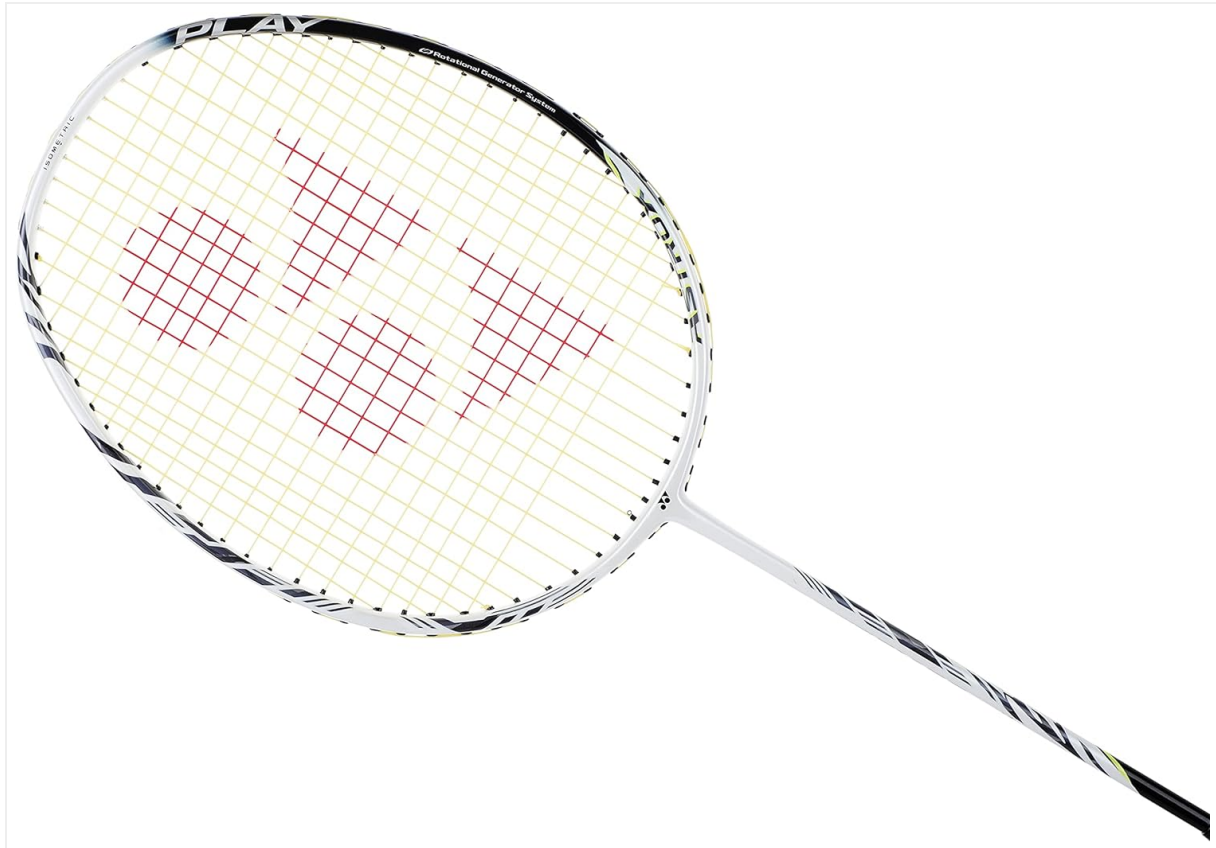


Figure 2: Close-up view of the racquet head, highlighting the isometric design and "Rotational Generator System" text.

## SETUP

---

The YONEX Astrox 99 Play Racquet is pre-strung and ready for immediate use. It includes a protective cover.

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the racquet from its packaging and the included cover.
2. **Grip Inspection:** Check the grip for proper adhesion and comfort. If desired, an overgrip can be applied for personalized feel and sweat absorption.
3. **String Tension:** The racquet comes pre-strung. For advanced players, string tension can be customized by a professional stringer to match individual preferences.

## OPERATING (USAGE GUIDELINES)

---

The Astrox 99 Play is designed to enhance your badminton game, particularly for intermediate players. Understanding its characteristics can help optimize your performance.

- **Grip Technique:** Hold the racquet firmly but not too tightly. Experiment with different grip positions to find what provides the best control and power for various shots.
- **Sweet Spot Utilization:** The isometric head design provides a larger sweet spot. Aim to hit the shuttlecock within this area for maximum power and accuracy.
- **Power and Control:** The medium flex and innovative features like the Rotational Generator System and Slim Shaft are engineered to provide a balance of power for smashes and control for precise drops and clears.
- **Maneuverability:** The racquet's design promotes quick handling, allowing for rapid reactions and transitions between offensive and defensive play.

## MAINTENANCE

---

Proper maintenance extends the life and performance of your badminton racquet.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the frame and strings with a soft, dry cloth after each use to remove sweat and dirt. Avoid

using harsh chemicals.

- **Storage:** Store the racquet in its included cover to protect it from dust, moisture, and accidental damage. Keep it in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **String Care:** Inspect strings regularly for fraying or breakage. Replace broken strings promptly to prevent damage to the frame. Avoid resting the racquet on its strings.
- **Grip Replacement:** Replace the grip or overgrip when it becomes worn, slippery, or loses its tackiness to maintain optimal handling and prevent blisters.
- **Avoid Impact:** Protect the racquet from impacts with the ground, net, or other objects, as this can cause frame damage.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are solutions to common issues you might encounter with your badminton racquet:

- **Broken Strings:** If a string breaks, it is recommended to cut all remaining strings immediately to equalize tension and prevent frame warping. Take the racquet to a professional for restringing.
- **Slippery Grip:** If the grip becomes slippery due to sweat or wear, replace it with a new overgrip or base grip. Ensure hands are dry during play.
- **Loss of Power/Control:** This can be due to worn strings, incorrect string tension, or a worn grip. Consider restringing or replacing the grip. Ensure proper technique is being used.
- **Frame Damage:** Visible cracks or dents in the frame indicate significant damage. Continued use with a damaged frame can lead to further breakage and is not recommended.
