1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

This manual provides detailed instructions for the assembly, operation, and maintenance of your Bellemave Twin Over Twin Floor Bunk Bed with Slide. This low-profile bunk bed is designed for children, featuring a sturdy wooden frame, an integrated ladder, and a fun slide. It is crafted from solid pine wood, plywood, and MDF, ensuring stability and durability.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Adherence to these safety guidelines is crucial for preventing injuries and ensuring safe use of the bunk bed.

- **Supervision:** Always supervise children when they are using the slide and ladder.
- **Weight Capacity:** Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity. The upper bed supports up to 175 lbs, and the bottom bed supports up to 275 lbs.
- **Guardrails:** The upper bunk is equipped with a full-length guardrail. Ensure all guardrails are securely attached before use to prevent falls.
- **Mattress Thickness:** The recommended mattress thickness for the upper bed is 6 inches, and for the bottom bed is 8 inches. Using thicker mattresses may compromise guardrail effectiveness.
- **Slide Use:** Instruct children to use the slide in a seated position, feet first. Ensure the area around the slide is clear of obstructions.
- **No Horseplay:** Prohibit jumping on the bed or engaging in rough play on or around the bunk bed.

3. COMPONENTS LIST

Before beginning assembly, verify that all components are present and undamaged. This product typically ships in two separate boxes, which may arrive at different times.

Typical Components Include:

- Bed Frame Panels (Headboards, Footboards, Side Rails)
- Bed Slats for Upper and Lower Bunks
- Ladder Components
- Slide Components
- Hardware Pack (screws, bolts, nuts, wooden pegs, Allen wrench)
- Assembly Instruction Manual

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly typically requires two people and approximately 30 minutes. Follow the included detailed graphical instructions for best results. Avoid using power tools during assembly to prevent overtightening and damage to the wood.

Assembly Steps:

1. **Unpack and Identify:** Carefully unpack all components and lay them out. Refer to the parts list in your separate instruction manual to identify each piece.
2. **Assemble Bed Frames:** Begin by assembling the headboards and footboards for both the upper and lower bunks, attaching side rails as indicated in the manual.
3. **Install Slats:** Securely attach the bed slats to both the upper and lower bunk frames. Ensure even spacing and firm attachment for mattress support.
4. **Attach Ladder:** Mount the ladder to the designated side of the bunk bed, ensuring all connections are tight and stable.
5. **Attach Slide:** Securely attach the slide to the bunk bed frame. Verify that the slide is stable and properly aligned.
6. **Final Check:** Once assembled, double-check all screws, bolts, and connections to ensure they are tight and secure.

6. MAINTENANCE

- **Hardware Check:** Periodically inspect all bolts, screws, and connections to ensure they remain tight. Retighten as necessary to maintain structural integrity.
- **Environmental Conditions:** Avoid placing the bed in direct sunlight or near heat sources, which can cause wood to dry out or warp.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your bunk bed, consider the following:

- **Loose Connections:** If the bed feels wobbly or squeaks, check all assembly hardware and tighten any loose connections.
- **Missing Parts:** If parts were missing upon delivery, refer to the contact information in the Warranty and Support section.

- **Damage:** For any structural damage or defects, discontinue use and contact customer support.
