INTRODUCTION

SETUP: PLANTING INSTRUCTIONS

OPERATING: CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Consistent care will promote vigorous growth and abundant flowering.

1. Watering

After planting, water thoroughly to settle the soil. Once established, irises are relatively drought-tolerant. Water regularly during dry periods, especially during the growing season and before flowering. Avoid overwatering, which can lead to rhizome rot.

2. Fertilizing

Apply a low-nitrogen fertilizer in early spring and again after flowering. Avoid high-nitrogen fertilizers, which can encourage foliage growth at the expense of blooms.

3. Deadheading

Remove spent flower stalks by cutting them back to the base. This prevents the plant from expending

energy on seed production and encourages more blooms.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance helps keep your iris healthy and thriving.

1. Weeding

Keep the area around your irises free of weeds, which compete for nutrients and moisture. Hand-pulling weeds is recommended to avoid disturbing the shallow rhizomes.

2. Dividing

Over time, iris clumps can become crowded, leading to reduced flowering. Divide your irises every 3-5 years, typically in late summer or early fall, by digging up the rhizomes, discarding old or diseased sections, and replanting the healthy, younger rhizomes.

3. Pest and Disease Management

Inspect your plants regularly for signs of pests or diseases. Common issues include iris borers and rhizome rot. Good air circulation and proper drainage are key preventative measures. Remove any affected plant parts promptly.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If your Presby's Crown Jewel Bearded Iris is not performing as expected, consider the following common issues:

- **No Blooms:** This can be caused by too much shade, rhizomes planted too deeply, overcrowding, or excessive nitrogen fertilizer. Adjust conditions accordingly.
- **Yellowing Leaves:** May indicate overwatering, poor drainage, or nutrient deficiency. Check soil moisture and drainage.
- **Soft, Mushy Rhizomes:** A sign of rhizome rot, often due to excessive moisture. Improve drainage and remove affected parts.
