USER MANUAL

1. Product Overview

The Logitech Tap Scheduler is designed to simplify meeting room management, allowing users to easily view meeting details and reserve rooms. It serves as a dedicated scheduling panel for various room scheduling solutions, helping individuals efficiently locate and book available spaces.

2. What's in the Box

3. Setup and Installation

The Logitech Tap Scheduler offers flexible mounting options for various surfaces. Follow these steps for a clean and professional installation.

3.1 Choosing a Mount

Select the appropriate mount based on your installation surface:

- Multi-surface mount: Ideal for glass or drywall.
- Corner mount: For installations on room corners.
- Mullion mount: Designed for narrow frames or mullions.

3.2 Installation Steps

- 3. **Connect Cables:** Route the USB cable from the Tap Scheduler to your room scheduling system's host device. Ensure cables are managed cleanly to maintain a professional appearance.
- 4. **Mount the Device:** Carefully attach the Logitech Tap Scheduler to the installed mount. Ensure it clicks securely into place.
- 5. **Power On:** Connect the power adapter to the device and a power outlet. The device will power on automatically.

4. Operating Instructions

4.1 Understanding the Display

The main screen displays current room status, upcoming meetings, and options for booking.




Figure 4.1: The Logitech Tap Scheduler's display showing a typical meeting schedule and room availability status.

4.2 Checking Room Availability

The device uses colored LED lights on its sides to indicate room status at a glance:

- Green Light: Indicates the room is available.
- Red Light: Indicates the room is currently occupied.

4.3 Reserving a Room

To reserve a room directly from the Tap Scheduler:

- 1. If the room is available (green light), tap the 'Reserve' button on the screen.
- 2. Select the desired duration for your meeting.
- 3. Confirm your booking. The room status will update, and the LED lights will change accordingly.

5. Maintenance and Care

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Logitech Tap Scheduler, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- Cleaning: Use a soft, lint-free cloth slightly dampened with water to clean the screen and exterior. Avoid abrasive cleaners, solvents, or aerosol sprays, as they may damage the device.
- **Environmental Conditions:** Operate the device within its specified temperature and humidity ranges. Avoid exposing it to extreme temperatures, direct sunlight, or high humidity.
- Cable Management: Periodically check all connected cables to ensure they are secure and free from damage.

 Proper cable management prevents accidental disconnections and wear.
- **Software Updates:** Ensure the device's software is kept up-to-date. Refer to Logitech's official support resources for information on firmware updates.

6. Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your Logitech Tap Scheduler, try the following common troubleshooting steps:

6.1 No Display / Black Screen

- Ensure the power adapter is securely connected to both the device and a working power outlet.
- Verify that the USB cable connecting the Tap Scheduler to the host system is properly seated.
- Try restarting the host system or the Tap Scheduler by unplugging and re-plugging the power.

6.2 Incorrect Room Status / Booking Issues

• Check the network connection of the host system and the Tap Scheduler. A stable internet connection is

required for synchronization with scheduling services.

- Verify that the Tap Scheduler is correctly configured with your room scheduling software. Refer to the software's documentation for setup details.
- Ensure the time and date settings on the host system are accurate.

6.3 LED Lights Not Functioning


- Confirm the device is powered on and connected to the host system.
- Check the settings within your room scheduling software to ensure LED indicators are enabled and configured correctly.
- If the issue persists, a factory reset (if supported by your software) or contacting support may be necessary.


