Igloo Electric Countertop Ice Maker Machine - User Manual

Model: IGLICEB33BK

INTRODUCTION

This user manual provides important information regarding the safe operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Igloo Electric Countertop Ice Maker Machine. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the appliance and retain it for future reference.

The Igloo Electric Countertop Ice Maker is a compact and portable appliance designed to produce ice quickly and efficiently. It can produce up to 33 pounds of ice per day, with ice ready in as little as 7 minutes. The unit features an intuitive LED-lighted control panel, allowing you to select between small or large ice cube sizes and indicating when to add water or when the ice basket is full.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury when using your ice maker, follow these basic safety precautions:

- Read all instructions before using the appliance.
- Do not touch the evaporator or ice cubes when the ice maker is operating.
- Do not immerse the cord, plug, or any part of the appliance in water or other liquids.
- Close supervision is necessary when the appliance is used by or near children.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- Ensure the product dimensions and weight fit your intended space.
- Place the ice maker on a stable, level surface, away from direct sunlight or heat sources.
- Allow at least 6 inches of clearance around the unit for proper ventilation.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the components of your ice maker:

- **Control Panel:** Features ON/OFF and SELECT buttons, along with LED indicators for "LARGE", "SMALL", "ICE FULL", and "ADD WATER".
- **Ice Basket:** Removable basket for collecting produced ice cubes. Capacity up to 2 pounds.
- **Water Reservoir:** Internal tank for water, with a 2.5-quart capacity.
- **Ice Scoop:** Included for convenient ice retrieval.
- **Viewing Window:** Transparent lid to observe ice production.

SETUP

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove the ice maker from its packaging. Remove all packing materials, including any tape or protective film.
2. **Placement:** Place the unit on a flat, stable, and level surface. Ensure there is at least 6 inches of clearance on all sides for proper ventilation. Avoid placing near heat sources or in direct sunlight.
3. **Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, clean the interior of the ice maker. Remove the ice basket and wash it with warm, soapy water. Wipe the interior with a soft cloth and mild detergent, then rinse thoroughly.
4. **First Use Preparation:** After cleaning, allow the unit to sit upright for at least one hour before plugging it in. This allows the refrigerant to settle.
5. **Add Water:** Open the lid and fill the water reservoir with potable water up to the "MAX" fill line. Do not overfill.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Power On:** Plug the ice maker into a grounded electrical outlet. Press the **ON/OFF** button to turn on the unit. The "ON/OFF" indicator light will illuminate.
2. **Select Ice Size:** Press the **SELECT** button to choose your desired ice cube size:
 - **SMALL:** For smaller, quicker-forming ice cubes.
 - **LARGE:** For larger, more solid ice cubes.

The corresponding LED indicator ("SMALL" or "LARGE") will light up.

3. **Ice Production:** The ice maker will begin the ice-making cycle. The first batch of ice may take slightly longer (around 7-15 minutes) to form. Subsequent batches will be produced more quickly.
4. **Ice Collection:** As ice cubes are produced, they will drop into the removable ice basket.
5. **"ICE FULL" Indicator:** When the ice basket is full, the "ICE FULL" indicator light will illuminate, and the ice maker

will automatically pause production. Remove ice from the basket to resume operation.

6. **"ADD WATER" Indicator:** If the water level in the reservoir is too low, the "ADD WATER" indicator light will illuminate, and the ice maker will pause. Add more water to the reservoir to resume operation.
7. **Power Off:** To turn off the unit, press the **ON/OFF** button.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning and maintenance will prolong the life of your ice maker and ensure optimal performance.

1. Daily Cleaning:

- Unplug the unit before cleaning.
- Remove the ice basket and wash it with warm, soapy water.
- Drain any remaining water from the reservoir.
- Wipe the interior and exterior surfaces with a soft cloth and mild detergent.
- Dry thoroughly before storing or next use.

2. Deep Cleaning (Monthly or as needed):

- Prepare a solution of water and white vinegar (1:1 ratio) or a dedicated ice maker cleaning solution.
- Pour the solution into the water reservoir.

- Run a few ice-making cycles with this solution (do not consume this ice).
- Drain the solution completely and rinse the reservoir multiple times with fresh water to remove any residue.
- Wipe down all accessible parts.

3. **Storage:** If storing the ice maker for an extended period, ensure it is completely dry to prevent mold or mildew growth. Store in a cool, dry place.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Refer to this table for common issues and their solutions:

| Problem | Possible Cause | Solution |
|---|--|---|
| Ice maker not working. | No power; "ADD WATER" light on; "ICE FULL" light on. | Check power connection; Add water to reservoir; Remove ice from basket. |
| Ice cubes are small or cloudy. | Water temperature too high; Mineral buildup. | Use colder water; Perform a deep cleaning to remove mineral deposits. |
| "ADD WATER" light is on, but there is water in the reservoir. | Water sensor issue. | Unplug the unit for a few minutes, then plug back in. Ensure water level is above the minimum sensor. |
| Ice production is slow. | Poor ventilation; High ambient temperature. | Ensure adequate clearance around the unit; Operate in a cooler environment. |
| Unit is noisy. | Normal operation sounds; Unit not level. | Some noise during ice production is normal. Ensure the unit is on a level surface. |
