1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Havells Aquilla 1000W Dry Iron. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and care of your new appliance. Please read these instructions carefully before first use and keep them for future reference.

The Havells Aquilla dry iron is designed for effective garment pressing, featuring a non-stick coated soleplate and a shock-proof body for user safety and convenience.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and personal injury.

- Always ensure the voltage indicated on the rating label corresponds to your mains voltage.
- Do not immerse the iron, power cord, or plug in water or any other liquid.
- Unplug the iron from the power outlet when filling with water (for steam irons, not applicable here), emptying, or when not in use. Allow it to cool completely before cleaning or storing.
- Do not operate the iron with a damaged cord or plug, or if the iron has been dropped or damaged. Contact authorized service personnel for repair.
- Keep the iron and its cord out of reach of children.
- Never leave the iron unattended while it is connected to the power supply.
- Use the iron on a stable, heat-resistant surface.
- Avoid touching hot surfaces. Use handles or knobs.
- This appliance is for household use only.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

- **American Heritage Non-Stick Coated Soleplate:** Ensures smooth gliding over fabrics and prevents sticking.
- **Shock-Proof Plastic Body:** Provides enhanced safety during use.

4. SETUP

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the iron from its packaging. Retain the packaging for storage or future transport.
2. **Inspect:** Check the iron for any signs of damage. Do not use if damaged.
3. **First Use Preparation:** Before using for the first time, wipe the soleplate with a damp cloth to remove any manufacturing residues. It is normal for a slight odor or smoke to occur during the first few minutes of operation as the heating element cures. This will dissipate quickly.
4. **Placement:** Place the iron on a stable, heat-resistant ironing board or surface.
5. **Power Connection:** Ensure the temperature control dial is set to the 'OFF' or 'COOL' position before plugging the iron into a suitable 240V, 50Hz AC power outlet.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps for effective and safe ironing:

1. **Sort Laundry:** Separate garments according to fabric type (e.g., linen, cotton, wool, silk, synthetics). Start ironing with fabrics that require lower temperatures first.
2. **Check Fabric Labels:** Always refer to the garment's care label for recommended ironing temperatures.
3. **Set Temperature:** Turn the temperature control dial to the desired setting based on the fabric type. The indicator light will illuminate, showing the iron is heating.
4. **Preheating:** Allow the iron to heat up until the indicator light turns off, signifying that the set temperature has been reached. The light will cycle on and off during ironing to maintain the temperature.
5. **Ironing:** Begin ironing your garments. For best results, iron in smooth, even strokes.
6. **Finishing:** Once ironing is complete, turn the temperature control dial to the 'OFF' or 'COOL' position and unplug the iron from the power outlet.

6. MAINTENANCE

Proper care ensures the longevity and performance of your iron.

- **Cleaning the Soleplate:** If the soleplate becomes stained or dirty, clean it with a damp cloth and a non-abrasive cleaner specifically designed for iron soleplates. Do not use harsh scouring pads or metallic cleaners as they can damage the non-stick coating.
- **Cleaning the Body:** Wipe the exterior of the iron with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** Ensure the iron is completely cool before storing. Wrap the cord neatly around the cord winder (if applicable) or secure it with a tie. Store the iron upright on its heel rest in a dry, safe place, away from moisture and direct sunlight.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Havells Aquilla Dry Iron, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Iron does not heat up.	Not plugged in; power outlet fault; temperature dial set to 'OFF' or 'COOL'.	Check power connection; test outlet with another appliance; turn temperature dial to a fabric setting.
Iron is too hot or not hot enough.	Incorrect temperature setting for fabric.	Adjust temperature dial according to fabric type. Refer to garment care labels.
Soleplate is sticking to fabric.	Soleplate is dirty; temperature too high for fabric.	Clean the soleplate as per maintenance instructions; reduce temperature setting.
Smoke or odor during first use.	Manufacturing residues burning off.	This is normal and will stop after a few minutes. Ensure good ventilation.
