- Do not immerse the motor unit in water or other liquids. Clean with a damp cloth only.
- Keep hands and utensils out of the pitcher during operation to prevent injury and damage to the appliance.
- Ensure the lid is securely locked before operating the appliance.
- Unplug from the outlet when not in use, before assembling or disassembling parts, and before cleaning.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- The use of attachments not recommended or sold by the manufacturer may cause fire, electric shock,

or injury.

- This appliance is for household use only. Do not use outdoors.
- Exercise extreme caution when handling sharp blades.
- Do not let the cord hang over the edge of a table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.

SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

1. Unpacking and Placement

1. Carefully remove all components from the packaging.
2. Place the main unit on a stable, flat, and dry surface. Ensure there is enough space around the appliance for proper ventilation.
3. Keep packaging materials out of reach of children.

2. Initial Assembly

1. Attach the desired pitcher (stainless steel or ceramic-coated Havana pitcher) to the main unit by aligning it with the base and twisting until it locks securely.
2. Insert the appropriate blade or MamboMix spoon into the pitcher.
3. Place the lid on the pitcher and ensure it is properly closed and locked.

3. Power Connection

1. Plug the power cord into a grounded electrical outlet.
2. The appliance will power on, and the 7-inch TFT touchscreen will activate.

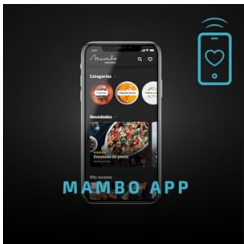
4. Wi-Fi Connectivity and App Setup

1. Download the "Mambo" app from your smartphone's app store.
2. Follow the in-app instructions to connect your food processor to your home Wi-Fi network.
3. Once connected, you can access over 1000 guided recipes, receive push notifications, and control the appliance remotely.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Understanding the 7-inch TFT Touchscreen

- Chop, Mince, Liquefy, Grind, Pulverize, Grate
- Reheat, Beat, Yogurt maker, Whip, Emulsify, Mix
- Cook, Stir, Steam cook, Poach, Candy, Knead
- Cook at low temperature, Boil, Keep warm, Ferment
- SlowMambo, Cook with precision degree-by-degree, Bain-marie cooking
- Slow cooking, Zero speed, Turbo function

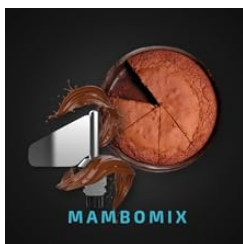


Image: Icon showing the MamboMix spoon, designed for optimal mixing and kneading without cutting ingredients.

The Mambo 12090 Havana features an integrated high-precision scale, allowing you to weigh ingredients directly in the pitcher for accurate recipe execution.

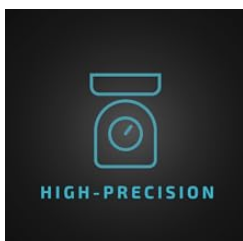


Image: Icon of a scale, indicating the integrated high-precision weighing function.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Proper cleaning and maintenance ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Mambo 12090 Havana.

1. Daily Cleaning

1. Always unplug the appliance before cleaning.
2. The stainless steel pitcher and the ceramic-coated Havana pitcher are dishwasher safe for quick and easy cleaning.
3. The MamboMix spoon and other accessories can also be washed in the dishwasher or by hand with warm, soapy water.
4. Wipe the main motor unit and touchscreen with a damp cloth. Do not immerse the main unit in water.

2. Storage

Store the appliance and its accessories in a clean, dry place when not in use. Ensure all parts are dry before storage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Mambo 12090 Havana, please refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Appliance does not turn on	Not plugged in; Power outlet issue; Main unit not properly assembled	Check power cord connection; Test outlet with another device; Ensure pitcher and lid are securely locked.
Motor stops during operation	Overload; Lid not properly closed	Reduce ingredient quantity; Ensure lid is securely locked; Allow motor to cool down.
Wi-Fi connection fails	Incorrect password; Router too far; Network interference	Verify Wi-Fi password; Move appliance closer to router; Restart router and appliance.
Ingredients not mixing properly	Incorrect accessory used; Too much liquid/solid	Ensure correct blade/MamboMix spoon is installed; Adjust ingredient ratios.
