1. INTRODUCTION

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always follow the assembly instructions precisely.
- Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of 450 lbs for the entire unit, 50 lbs for garment rods, and 40 lbs for each shelf. Overloading can cause instability and damage.
- Ensure all screws and fasteners are securely tightened before use. Periodically check for loose connections.
- Place the unit on a flat, stable surface to prevent tipping.
- Keep small parts and packaging materials away from children to prevent choking hazards.
- Do not climb on the unit or allow children to hang from the garment rods.

- Do not fully tighten screws until all components are loosely assembled. This allows for easier alignment.
- Ensure all parts are oriented correctly according to the diagrams.





Figure 4.1: Assembly Diagram with Dimensions. This diagram illustrates the overall dimensions and key measurements of the closet rack, including shelf heights and hanging rod length.








Figure 5.3: Four Small Shelves. This image details the four smaller shelves on the side of the unit, perfect for organizing folded garments, accessories, or small storage bins.




Figure 5.4: Two Bottom Shelves. This image displays the two lower shelves, ideal for shoe storage or larger bins.

Difficulty aligning parts during assembly.	Screws tightened too early.	Loosen all screws slightly, align the parts, then gradually tighten all screws evenly.
