Introduction

This manual provides essential information for the proper installation, operation, and maintenance of your Cuifati Electric Shaver Foil Head Replacement. This replacement head is designed to restore the performance of your compatible Braun 3 Series electric shaver, ensuring a comfortable and effective shave. Please read these instructions carefully before use to ensure optimal performance and longevity of the product.

Product Overview

The Cuifati Electric Shaver Foil Head is engineered for precision and durability. It features advanced comb teeth technology and a multi-directional mesh design to capture and cut beard hairs efficiently.

- **Comfortable Shaving Head:** The comb teeth technology arranges and guides messy beard into the trimmer, reducing repeated shaving and making the process more effective and comfortable.
- **Exquisite Design:** Features a delicate combination of large and small meshes, with 4 kinds of meshes of different shapes, arranged in 5 directions and 20 angles for multi-directional beard shaving.
- **Great Performance:** The 0.056mm ultra-thin mesh film shaves the beard closely, allowing your shaver to maintain excellent results for a long time.
- Premium Quality: Constructed from durable ABS and stainless steel material, ensuring good wear resistance, corrosion resistance, and safe use.
- Compatible: An important shaving accessory specifically designed for Braun 3 series electric shavers, including models such as 300S, 301S, 310S, 320S, 330S, 340S, 360S, 380S, 3000S, 3010S, 3020S, 3030S, 3040S, 3080S, 350CC, 370CC, 390CC, 3050CC, 3090CC, and Cruzer6.





Setup: Installing the Replacement Head

To ensure optimal performance and avoid damage, follow these steps for installing your new shaver foil head:

- 1. Preparation: Ensure your electric shaver is turned off and unplugged from any power source.
- 2. **Remove Old Head:** Gently press the release buttons (if present) on the sides of your shaver's existing head and lift it straight off. Dispose of the old head responsibly.
- 3. **Clean Shaver Body:** Before installing the new head, clean any hair clippings or debris from the shaver body, especially around the connection area. A small brush can be used for this.
- 4. **Install New Head:** Align the new Cuifati foil head with the shaver body. Press it down firmly until you hear a click, indicating it is securely locked into place. Do not force the head if it does not align easily.

5. Check Fit: Gently tug on the installed head to ensure it is firmly attached and does not wobble.

Note: Always handle the foil head by its plastic frame to avoid damaging the delicate foil screens.

Operating Instructions

Once the replacement head is installed, your shaver is ready for use. For best results, follow these general operating guidelines:

- **Skin Preparation:** For dry shaving, ensure your skin is clean and dry. For wet shaving (if your shaver supports it), use shaving foam or gel.
- **Shaving Technique:** Hold the shaver at a right angle (90 degrees) to your skin. Stretch your skin with your free hand to make hairs stand upright. Shave against the direction of hair growth using gentle, straight strokes.
- Pressure: Apply light, even pressure. Excessive pressure can cause irritation and wear out the foil head faster.
- Sensitive Areas: For sensitive areas, use even lighter pressure and shorter strokes.
- Post-Shave: After shaving, rinse your face with cool water and apply an aftershave balm if desired.

Maintenance

Regular cleaning and proper maintenance will extend the life of your Cuifati shaver foil head and ensure consistent performance.

Daily Cleaning:

- 1. Turn Off Shaver: Always turn off and unplug your shaver before cleaning.
- Remove Head: Detach the foil head from the shaver body.
- 3. Tap Out Hair: Gently tap the foil head against a flat surface to dislodge trapped hair clippings.
- 4. **Brush Clean:** Use the small cleaning brush (often supplied with your shaver) to brush away any remaining hair from the foil and the cutter block. Do not use the brush on the foil screen itself, as this can damage it.
- 5. **Rinse (if applicable):** If your shaver is waterproof, you can rinse the foil head and cutter block under warm running water. Ensure the water flows through the head to flush out debris.
- 6. Dry: Allow the foil head and cutter block to air dry completely before reattaching them to the shaver body or storing.

Weekly / Deep Cleaning:

For a more thorough clean, especially if using shaving foam or gel:

- After rinsing, apply a drop of mild liquid soap to the foil head and run the shaver for a few seconds.
- Rinse thoroughly under warm running water until all soap residue is gone.
- · Allow to air dry completely.

Lubrication:

Periodically apply a drop of light machine oil (like sewing machine oil or shaver oil) to the cutter block to maintain smooth operation and reduce wear. Refer to your original shaver manual for specific lubrication recommendations.

Replacement Schedule:

For optimal shaving performance, it is recommended to replace your shaver foil head every 18 months. However, if you notice reduced shaving performance, increased skin irritation, or visible damage to the foil, replace the head sooner.

Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your shaver after installing the new foil head, consider the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Poor shaving performance / Not cutting well	 Head not properly seated. Foil or cutter block is dirty/clogged. Foil or cutter block is worn out. Incorrect shaving technique. 	 Ensure the head clicks securely into place. Clean the foil head and cutter block thoroughly. If the head is old, consider replacing it. Review operating instructions for proper technique.
Skin irritation / Redness	Applying too much pressure.Foil is damaged or worn.Skin not properly prepared.	 Use lighter pressure during shaving. Inspect the foil for any nicks or damage; replace if necessary. Ensure skin is clean and dry (for dry shave) or properly lubricated (for wet shave).
Unusual noise from shaver	 Head not properly installed. Cutter block not properly seated within the foil head. Shaver motor issue (less likely related to head). 	 Remove and re-install the foil head, ensuring it clicks into place. Ensure the cutter block is correctly positioned inside the foil head. If noise persists and is not related to the head, consult your shaver's original manual or manufacturer.


