1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The HP Envy x360 Convertible 13-bd0063dx is a versatile 2-in-1 laptop designed for adaptability and performance. Featuring a 13.3-inch IPS Touch Full HD (1920x1080) display, it seamlessly transitions between laptop and tablet modes. Powered by an Intel Core i5-1135G7 processor with Intel Iris Xe Graphics, 8GB of DDR4 RAM, and a 256GB PCIe SSD, this device is equipped for everyday tasks, creative work, and entertainment. It operates on Windows 10 Home, offering a familiar and efficient user experience.

2. SETUP GUIDE

2.1 Initial Power-On and Configuration

1. **Unpack the Device:** Carefully remove the laptop and all accessories from the packaging.
2. **Connect Power:** Plug the power adapter into the laptop's charging port and then into a wall outlet. Allow the battery to

charge for at least 30 minutes before first use.

3. **Power On:** Open the laptop lid and press the power button, usually located on the side or top-right of the keyboard.
4. **Follow On-Screen Prompts:** Windows 10 Home will guide you through the initial setup process, including language selection, network connection, account creation, and privacy settings.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Using Convertible Modes

- **Laptop Mode:** Use the device as a traditional laptop for typing and productivity tasks.
- **Tent Mode:** Fold the screen back to form an inverted "V" shape. Ideal for watching videos or presentations.
- **Stand Mode:** Fold the screen back further, resting the keyboard face down. This positions the screen upright for viewing.
- **Tablet Mode:** Fold the screen completely back against the base, transforming the laptop into a tablet for touch-based interaction. The operating system will automatically prompt you to switch to tablet mode.

3.2 Touchscreen and Keyboard Usage

- **Touchscreen:** Interact directly with the display using your fingers for navigation, drawing, and app control.
- **Keyboard and Touchpad:** Utilize the full-size keyboard for typing and the precision touchpad for cursor control and gestures.

4. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Cleaning the Screen:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth slightly dampened with water or a screen cleaner. Avoid harsh chemicals.
- **Cleaning the Keyboard:** Use compressed air to remove dust and debris from between the keys. Wipe keys with a soft, damp cloth.
- **Battery Care:** To maximize battery life (up to 21 hours), avoid extreme temperatures and fully discharging the battery frequently. Store the laptop with a partial charge if not used for extended periods.
- **Software Updates:** Regularly install Windows updates and HP driver updates to ensure optimal performance and security.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure the laptop's vents are not obstructed to prevent overheating.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

Issue	Solution
Laptop not powering on:	Ensure the power adapter is securely connected and the outlet is functional. Try a different outlet. If the battery is completely drained, it may take a few minutes to respond after plugging in.
Touchscreen unresponsive:	Restart the laptop. Check for any pending Windows updates or driver updates for the touchscreen. Ensure the screen is clean and free of obstructions.
Slow performance:	Close unnecessary applications. Check Task Manager for resource-intensive processes. Ensure sufficient free space on the SSD. Run a disk cleanup and defragmentation (for HDD, not typically needed for SSD). Update drivers and Windows.
Wi-Fi connectivity issues:	Restart your router and modem. Restart the laptop. Check Wi-Fi settings and ensure the correct network is selected. Update Wi-Fi drivers.
