1. Introduction

Thank you for choosing the Sena SF2 Bluetooth Communication System. This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your device. The SF2 is designed to enhance your riding experience by providing seamless two-way intercom communication, smartphone connectivity for music and calls, and GPS navigation integration. Please read this manual thoroughly before using your SF2 to ensure proper functionality and safety.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Sena SF2 system consists of the main unit, high-definition speakers, and two types of microphones (boom and wired boom) to suit various helmet types. Below are the key components and controls.

3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Proper installation is crucial for optimal performance. Follow these steps to install your Sena SF2 on your helmet.

3.1 Mounting the Main Unit

The SF2 can be mounted using either the clamp kit or the adhesive mounting adapter.

- 1. **Clamp Kit Installation:** Loosen the screws on the clamp kit. Slide the clamp between the helmet shell and the inner padding, ensuring it is securely fastened. Tighten the screws.
- 2. **Adhesive Mounting Adapter Installation:** Clean the desired mounting surface on the helmet. Peel off the protective film from the adhesive adapter and firmly press it onto the helmet for at least 15 seconds. Allow 24 hours for the adhesive to fully cure before attaching the main unit.
- 3. Slide the SF2 main unit onto the mounted clamp or adhesive adapter until it clicks securely into place.

3.2 Speaker and Microphone Installation

- 1. Attach the hook and loop fasteners to the back of the speakers and inside the helmet's ear pockets.
- 2. Place the speakers securely in the ear pockets, ensuring they are aligned with your ears for best audio quality.
- 3. Choose the appropriate microphone for your helmet type:
 - Boom Microphone: Ideal for open-face or modular helmets. Attach the hook and loop fastener to the microphone base and position it inside the helmet near your mouth.
 - Wired Boom Microphone: Suitable for full-face helmets. Route the wire discreetly and attach the microphone to the chin bar area using the provided hook and loop fastener.
- 4. Connect the speaker and microphone cables to the corresponding ports on the SF2 main unit.

3.3 Charging the Device

Before first use, fully charge the SF2. Connect the USB-C charging cable to the SF2's charging port and plug the other end into a USB power source (e.g., computer USB port or wall adapter). The LED indicator will show charging status.

3.4 Pairing with Your Smartphone

To use smartphone features, you must pair your SF2 with your phone.

- 1. With the SF2 powered off, press and hold the central button for 5 seconds until the LED flashes red and blue, indicating pairing mode.
- 2. On your smartphone, go to Bluetooth settings and search for new devices.
- 3. Select 'Sena SF2' from the list of available devices.
- 4. Once paired, the LED on the SF2 will turn blue.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Learn how to use the various functions of your Sena SF2.

4.1 Power On/Off

- Power On: Press and hold the central button and the (+) button for 1 second.
- Power Off: Press and hold the central button and the (+) button for 1 second.

4.2 Volume Control

- Volume Up: Tap the (+) button.
- Volume Down: Tap the (-) button.

4.3 Intercom Communication

The SF2 supports two-person intercom communication with a range of up to 800 meters in open terrain.

- Starting Intercom: Tap the central button.
- Ending Intercom: Tap the central button.

4.4 Music Playback and Audio Overlay

Enjoy your music while staying connected via intercom with the audio overlay feature.

- Play/Pause Music: Press and hold the central button for 1 second.
- Next Track: Press and hold the (+) button for 1 second.
- Previous Track: Press and hold the (-) button for 1 second.

4.5 Phone Calls and GPS Navigation

- Answer Call: Tap the central button.
- End Call: Press and hold the central button for 2 seconds.
- Voice Dial: Press and hold the central button for 3 seconds (if supported by your smartphone).
- GPS Navigation: Audio instructions from your paired GPS device or smartphone will be heard through the speakers.

5. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Sena SF2, follow these maintenance guidelines.

- Cleaning: Wipe the main unit with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners. Ensure the USB-C port cover is securely closed to prevent water ingress.
- **Battery Care:** For best battery life, avoid storing the device in extreme temperatures. If storing for an extended period, charge the battery to about 50% before storage and recharge every few months.
- Storage: Store the device in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.
- **Firmware Updates:** Periodically check the Sena website or the Sena SF Utility App for firmware updates. Updating the firmware can improve performance and add new features.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Sena SF2, refer to the following common problems and solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Device does not power on	Low battery; Incorrect power-on procedure	Charge the device fully; Ensure you are pressing the central button and (+) button simultaneously for 1 second.
No audio from speakers	Speakers not connected; Volume too low; Loose connection	Check speaker connections; Increase volume; Ensure cables are firmly plugged in.
Cannot pair with smartphone	Device not in pairing mode; Bluetooth off on phone; Interference	Ensure SF2 is in pairing mode (red/blue flashing LED); Turn phone's Bluetooth off and on; Move away from other Bluetooth devices.
Intercom not connecting	Out of range; Not paired with other SF2; Interference	Ensure both devices are within 800m range; Re-pair the intercom units; Try moving to an open area.
Microphone not working	Microphone not connected; Incorrect microphone type for helmet; Damaged mic	Check microphone connection; Ensure correct mic is used (boom for open-face, wired for full-face); Contact support if damaged.

6.1 Factory Reset

If problems persist, you may need to perform a factory reset. This will restore the SF2 to its default settings.

- With the SF2 powered on, press and hold the central button for 12 seconds until the LED flashes red.
- Tap the (+) button to confirm the factory reset.
- The SF2 will power off. Power it on again to use.
