# Scheppach HCE2600 High-Pressure Cleaner User Manual

Model: HCE2600

## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

Thank you for choosing the Scheppach HCE2600 High-Pressure Cleaner. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your new high-pressure cleaner. Please read this manual thoroughly before first use and keep it for future reference.

The Scheppach HCE2600 is designed for cleaning various surfaces around the home and garden, including patios, driveways, vehicles, and garden furniture. Its powerful motor and versatile accessories make it an ideal tool for a wide range of cleaning tasks.

## 2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

---

Always observe basic safety precautions when using electrical appliances to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and personal injury.

### 2.1 General Safety

- Read all instructions carefully before operating the appliance.
- Keep children and bystanders away from the operating area.
- Wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE), including safety glasses and hearing protection.
- Do not operate the high-pressure cleaner if you are tired or under the influence of drugs, alcohol, or medication.
- Ensure the work area is well-lit.
- Never direct the water jet at people, animals, electrical equipment, or the appliance itself.
- Do not use the appliance to spray flammable liquids.

## 2.2 Electrical Safety

- Ensure the power supply voltage matches the rating on the appliance's nameplate (230V AC).
- Always connect the appliance to a properly grounded outlet.
- Do not use the appliance with a damaged cord or plug. If the cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent, or similarly qualified persons to avoid a hazard.
- Avoid touching the plug or outlet with wet hands.
- Do not abuse the cord. Never use the cord for carrying, pulling, or unplugging the appliance. Keep cord away from heat, oil, sharp edges, or moving parts.

## 2.3 Operating Safety

- Before starting, ensure all connections are secure and leak-free.
- Do not operate the pump without water. Dry running will damage the pump.
- Always hold the spray gun firmly with both hands during operation due to the recoil force.
- Never leave the appliance unattended while it is running.
- Disconnect the power supply and water supply before performing any maintenance or cleaning.

## 3. COMPONENTS AND ASSEMBLY

---

Your Scheppach HCE2600 High-Pressure Cleaner comes with several components for various cleaning tasks.

### 3.1 Included Components

- High-Pressure Cleaner Unit
- High-Pressure Hose (5 meters)
- Spray Gun
- Cleaning Lance with Extension
- Standard Nozzle
- High-Pressure Nozzle
- Surface Cleaner Attachment
- Cleaning Brush
- Detergent Container
- Adapter

## 3.2 Assembly Steps

1. **Attach the Wheels:** Securely attach the large wheels to the base of the unit for easy mobility.
2. **Install the Handle:** Assemble the handle to the main unit. Ensure it clicks into place or is fastened with provided screws.
3. **Connect High-Pressure Hose:** Connect one end of the 5-meter high-pressure hose to the outlet on the high-pressure cleaner unit. Connect the other end to the spray gun. Ensure all connections are tight to prevent leaks.
4. **Attach Accessories:** Select the desired nozzle or attachment (e.g., cleaning lance, surface cleaner, cleaning brush) and connect it to the spray gun using the Quick Connect System. Push firmly until it locks into place.

## 4. SETUP

---

### 4.1 Water Supply Connection

- Connect a garden hose (not included) to the water inlet on the high-pressure cleaner unit.
- Ensure the garden hose is free of kinks and has an adequate water supply. The maximum flow rate for the unit is 480 liters per hour.
- Turn on the water supply fully to ensure a steady flow to the unit.

### 4.2 Electrical Connection

- Plug the power cord into a grounded 230V AC electrical outlet.
- Ensure the power cord is positioned so it will not be stepped on, tripped over, or otherwise subjected to damage or stress.

## 5. OPERATION

---

### 5.1 Basic Operation

1. Ensure the water supply is turned on and the unit is plugged in.
2. Before turning on the unit, squeeze the trigger on the spray gun to purge air from the system. Hold the trigger until a steady stream of water emerges.
3. Turn the ON/OFF switch on the high-pressure cleaner to the "ON" position. The motor will start.
4. Begin cleaning by directing the spray gun at the surface. Maintain a safe distance to avoid damaging the surface.
5. To stop the flow of water, release the trigger. The motor will automatically shut off. To resume, squeeze the trigger again.
6. When finished, turn the ON/OFF switch to "OFF", disconnect the power, and turn off the water supply.

### 5.2 Using Accessories

- **Standard and High-Pressure Nozzles:** These nozzles provide concentrated jets for tough dirt. The high-pressure nozzle offers maximum cleaning power (up to 180 bar).
- **Surface Cleaner:** Ideal for cleaning large flat areas like patios and driveways. Attach it to the spray gun and move it evenly over the surface.

- **Cleaning Brush:** Use for gentle cleaning of sensitive surfaces or for scrubbing with detergent.

- **Detergent Container:** Fill with appropriate high-pressure cleaner detergent. The detergent is typically applied at low pressure.

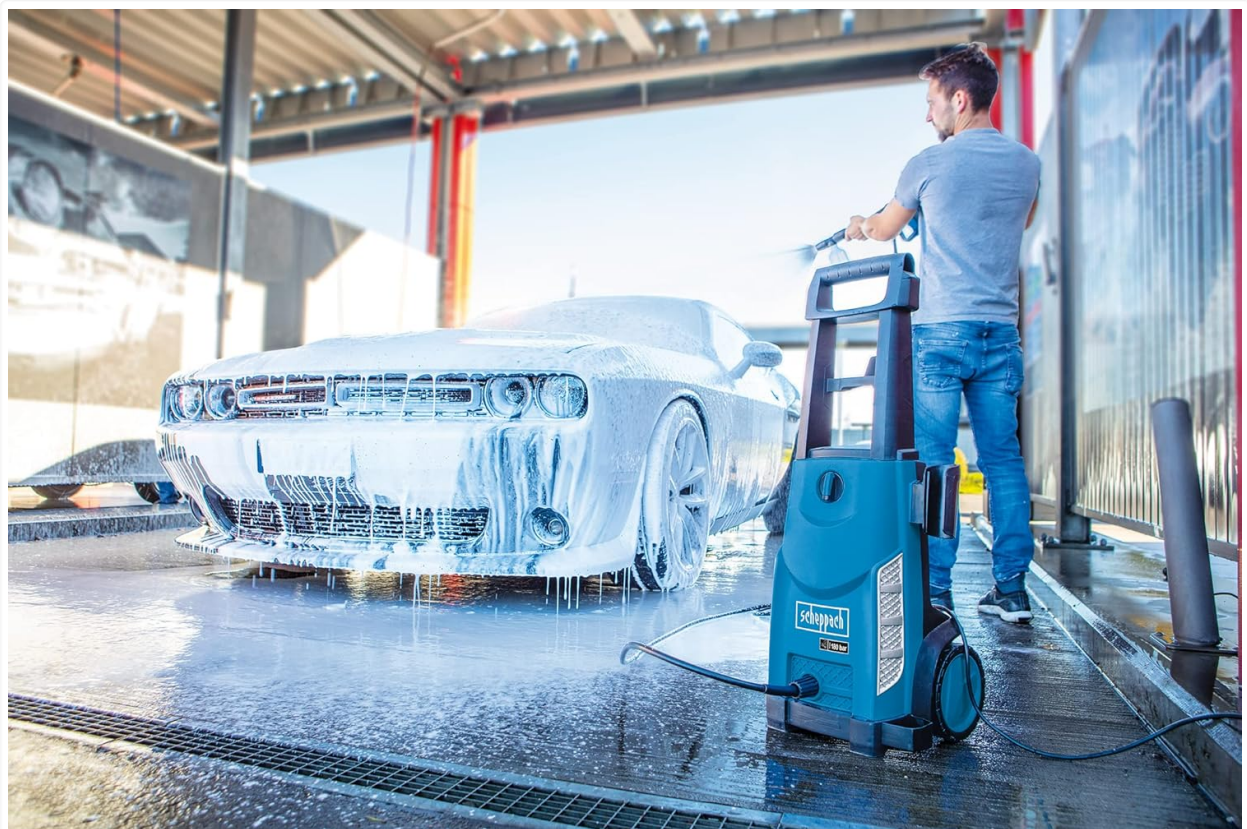


Figure 5: Applying cleaning foam to a vehicle using the detergent container, preparing for a thorough wash.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your high-pressure cleaner. Always disconnect power and water before performing maintenance.

### 6.1 Cleaning

- **Nozzle Cleaning:** If the nozzle becomes clogged, use the provided nozzle cleaning tool (or a thin wire) to clear any debris.
- **Water Inlet Filter:** Regularly check and clean the water inlet filter to prevent debris from entering the pump.
- **Exterior Cleaning:** Wipe down the exterior of the unit with a damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.

### 6.2 Storage

- **Drain Water:** After each use, disconnect the water supply and run the unit for a few seconds to drain any remaining water from the pump and hose. This is crucial to prevent freezing damage in cold climates.
- **Store Accessories:** Utilize the integrated holders on the unit for storing nozzles, the spray gun, and the high-pressure hose.
- **Location:** Store the high-pressure cleaner in a dry, frost-free location, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your high-pressure cleaner.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Unit does not start	No power supply; ON/OFF switch is OFF; Thermal overload protection activated.	Check power connection and outlet; Turn ON/OFF switch to ON; Allow unit to cool down for 30 minutes.
No water pressure or low pressure	Water supply off or restricted; Air in pump; Clogged nozzle; Kinked hose.	Turn on water supply fully; Purge air by squeezing trigger; Clean nozzle; Straighten hose.
Motor runs continuously	Air in pump; Leak in system; Bypass valve stuck.	Purge air from pump; Check all connections for leaks; Contact customer service if issue persists.
Water leaks from connections	Loose connections; Damaged O-rings.	Tighten all connections; Replace damaged O-rings.
