1. Introduction

This manual provides detailed instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your Hubble Nursery Pal Link Premium Twin 5-Inch Baby Monitor. This system includes a 5-inch parent unit and two smart cameras, designed to help you monitor your child. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product to ensure proper function and safety.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

- Use only the provided power adapters.
- Do not expose the product to water or moisture.
- Ensure proper ventilation for all components.
- Do not attempt to open or repair the product yourself. Refer all servicing to qualified personnel.

4. SETUP GUIDE

4.1 Charging the Parent Unit

Before initial use, fully charge the parent unit for approximately 16 hours. Connect the small plug of the power adapter to the parent unit and the other end to a power outlet. The battery indicator will show charging status.

4.2 Positioning the Cameras

Place the cameras on a flat surface or mount them to a wall. Ensure the camera is at least 3 feet (1 meter) away from your child to avoid potential hazards. Position the cameras to provide a clear view of the monitoring area.




Image 4.1: The parent unit and a single camera, illustrating their compact design.

4.3 Connecting to Wi-Fi and HubbleClub App

For remote viewing and advanced features, download the HubbleClub app on your smartphone or tablet. Follow the inapp instructions to connect your cameras to your home Wi-Fi network. This enables features such as 24-hour recording, live streaming, and remote access.




Image 4.2: The HubbleClub app interface on a smartphone, demonstrating its capabilities for monitoring and managing multiple cameras.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Parent Unit Functions

The 5-inch diagonal color screen on the parent unit allows for direct monitoring. Use the controls to:

- View live video feed from one or both cameras (split screen).
- Utilize two-way communication to speak to your child.
- · Play preloaded lullabies and soothing sounds.
- · Adjust camera pan, tilt, and zoom remotely.

- Routine Management: Schedule and manage routines for sleep and other activities.
- Baby Growth & Development Tracker: Monitor your child's progress.
- Environmental Monitoring: Receive alerts for motion, sound, and temperature changes.
- Expert Advice: Access parenting tips and sleep advice.

5.3 Range and Battery Life

The parent unit offers an impressive range of up to 1,000 feet (300 meters) in optimal conditions. The 3,000mAh battery provides up to 15 hours of operation on a single charge, depending on usage.




Image 5.3: The parent unit in a home setting, emphasizing its long battery life and extended range.

6. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your baby monitor:

- Cleaning: Wipe the parent unit and cameras with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth. Do not use cleaning sprays or liquid cleaners.
- **Storage:** If storing the unit for an extended period, ensure the parent unit battery is fully charged and then store in a cool, dry place.
- Battery Care: Avoid fully discharging the parent unit battery frequently to prolong its lifespan.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Hubble Nursery Pal Link Premium Twin, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Solution
No image/sound on parent unit.	Ensure both the parent unit and cameras are powered on and within range. Check power connections.
Poor image quality.	Check for obstructions between the camera and parent unit. Ensure cameras are in a well-lit area or night vision is active. Adjust camera position.
Parent unit not connecting to Wi-Fi.	Verify your Wi-Fi network is 2.4GHz. Ensure correct Wi-Fi password. Restart your router and the parent unit.
Short battery life.	Reduce screen brightness. Limit continuous live viewing. Ensure the unit is fully charged before use.
App not receiving notifications.	Check app notification settings on your smartphone. Ensure the app has necessary permissions. Verify internet connectivity.


