INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the installation, usage, and maintenance of the Hotop Extra Contact Points Replacement Part for Dog Training Collars. These replacement parts are designed to ensure the continued functionality and comfort of your dog's training collar.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

The package includes the following components:

- 4 x Short Contact Points (0.25 inch)
- 2 x Long Contact Points (0.375 inch)
- 4 x Short Conductive Rubber Caps (6 x 10 mm)
- 2 x Long Conductive Rubber Caps (6 x 14 mm)

This provides a total of 12 pieces, offering sufficient quantity for equipment replacement needs.


Image: Detailed dimensions of the short and long contact points and their corresponding rubber caps.

COMPATIBILITY

These replacement parts are designed to be compatible with various dog training collars. They are suitable for both small and large dog breeds, depending on the length of the contact points used.

Prongs Set in Two Different Sizes

- 4 x Short conductive rubber caps
- 4 x Short contact points

For Big Dogs

- 2 x Long conductive rubber caps
- 2 x Long contact points




Image: Illustration showing the use of shorter contact points and caps for small dogs and longer ones for big dogs.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to replace the contact points and install the conductive rubber caps on your dog training collar receiver. **Note: The receiver collar is not included with this product.**

1. **Remove Old Contact Points:** If replacing existing points, carefully unscrew and remove the old contact points from the receiver unit.
2. **Select Appropriate Contact Points:** Choose either the short (0.25 inch) or long (0.375 inch) contact points based on your dog's coat length and comfort. Shorter points are generally for dogs with shorter coats, and longer points for dogs with thicker coats.
3. **Install New Contact Points:** Screw the selected metal contact points firmly into the designated holes on the training collar receiver. Ensure they are securely fastened but do not overtighten.
4. **Apply Conductive Rubber Caps:** Place the appropriate size conductive rubber caps over the newly installed metal contact points. Push the rubber cap down until it is snug against the base of the contact point, ensuring there is no gap between the cap and the collar receiver. This helps protect your pet's skin and ensures proper conductivity.

- For Replacement or to Refresh Dog Training Collars
- Compatible with dog training collars (receiver collar is not included)



Please Notes: When using, please keep the rubber cap close to the contact point until there is no gap between them to avoid falling.

OPERATING GUIDELINES

Once the contact points and caps are installed, ensure the collar fits properly on your dog. The contact points should make consistent contact with the dog's skin through the fur, but not be so tight as to cause discomfort or irritation. The conductive rubber caps are designed to maintain contact while providing a softer interface with the dog's skin, enhancing comfort and safety during training.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and effectiveness of the contact points and rubber caps:

- Regularly inspect the contact points for any signs of wear, corrosion, or damage.
- Check the rubber caps for tears or looseness. Replace them if they are damaged or no longer fit snugly.
- Clean the contact points and the inside of the rubber caps periodically with a soft, damp cloth to remove dirt, oil, or debris that may affect conductivity.
- Ensure the contact points are always securely screwed into the collar receiver to prevent them from falling off during use.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with the replacement parts, consider the following:

- **Contact points feel loose:** Ensure the contact points are fully screwed in. If they continue to loosen, check the threading on both the contact point and the collar receiver for damage.
- **Rubber caps fall off:** Make sure the correct size rubber cap is used for the contact point. Ensure the cap is pushed down firmly until it sits flush against the collar receiver. If the caps are old or stretched, they may need replacement.
- **Ineffective training signal:** Verify that the contact points are making proper contact with your dog's skin. Adjust the collar's tightness or consider using longer contact points if your dog has a thick coat. Ensure the contact points and caps are clean.
- **Skin irritation:** If your dog experiences skin irritation, ensure the collar is not too tight and that the rubber caps are properly installed. Consult a veterinarian if irritation persists.
