Introduction

Please read this manual thoroughly before assembly and use to ensure proper function and safety.

Safety Information

- **Weight Limits:** Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of **110 lbs (50 kg)** on the tabletop and **11 lbs (5 kg)** on the storage shelf. Overloading can cause damage to the product and potential injury.
- **Assembly:** Ensure all screws and fasteners are securely tightened before use. Periodically check and re-tighten as necessary.
- **Placement:** Place the table on a flat, stable surface. Uneven surfaces can affect stability.
- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, damp cloth for cleaning. Avoid harsh chemicals that may damage the finish.
- **Children:** Keep small parts away from children during assembly. This product is intended for adult use.

Package Contents

Verify that all components and hardware are present before beginning assembly. Refer to the included assembly diagram for a complete list of parts. If any parts are missing or damaged, please contact customer support.

Setup and Assembly

Assembly of the HOMCOM Adjustable Drafting Table is required. It is recommended that at least one person assemble this product. Follow the step-by-step instructions provided in the separate assembly guide included with your purchase. Ensure you have adequate space and the necessary tools (not included) before starting.

Operating Instructions

Adjusting the Tabletop Angle

The drafting table features a 15-level adjustable design, allowing the tabletop to be tilted at an angle range of 0-70 degrees. This provides ergonomic comfort for various activities.

- To Tilt Up:** Gently lift the front edge of the tiltable section of the tabletop. The support mechanism will click into place at each of the 15 available angles. Select your desired angle.
- To Lower:** Lift the tabletop to its highest position to disengage the locking mechanism. Then, carefully lower the tabletop back down to a flat position or another desired angle.

Built-in Design

Using the Sheet Stopper

A sheet stopper is integrated into the tiltable section of the tabletop to prevent papers, books, or drawing materials from sliding off when the surface is angled.

- Ensure the sheet stopper is in the upright position when the tabletop is tilted.
- When the tabletop is flat, the stopper can be pushed down for a flush surface.

Utilizing the Storage Shelf

The open shelf located beneath the main tabletop provides convenient storage for your supplies, books, or other items. Ensure items placed on the shelf do not exceed the 11 lbs (5 kg) weight limit.

Maintenance

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the table surfaces with a clean, damp cloth. For stubborn marks, a mild soap solution can be used, followed by wiping with a clean, dry cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically inspect all screws and bolts to ensure they remain tight. Re-tighten as needed to maintain stability.
- **Environmental Conditions:** Avoid exposing the table to extreme temperatures or humidity, which can affect the engineered wood material.

Troubleshooting

- **Table Wobbles:** Ensure the table is placed on a level surface. Adjust the non-marking feet at the bottom of the legs to compensate for uneven floors. Check that all assembly hardware is securely tightened.
- **Tabletop Not Adjusting Smoothly:** Ensure no obstructions are present in the tilt mechanism. If the mechanism feels stiff, apply a small amount of silicone-based lubricant to the moving parts.
- **Parts Missing/Damaged:** If you discover any missing or damaged parts during assembly, do not

proceed. Contact customer support immediately for assistance.
