INTRODUCTION

The HMF Vintage Combination Padlock is a decorative yet functional security device designed for light-duty applications. Its three-digit combination mechanism offers convenient keyless access, making it suitable for securing small chests, suitcases, bags, or as a decorative accent. This manual provides instructions for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your padlock.

SETUP: SETTING YOUR COMBINATION

Your HMF Vintage Combination Padlock comes with a factory preset combination, typically **0-0-0**. To set your personal combination, follow these steps:

1. Ensure the padlock is currently set to the opening combination (factory default is 0-0-0).
2. Open the padlock by pulling up the shackle.
3. Rotate the shackle 90 degrees (a quarter turn) counter-clockwise from its open position.

4. Press the shackle down firmly into the padlock body while holding it in the 90-degree rotated position.
5. While holding the shackle down, set your desired 3-digit combination by rotating the dials. Choose a memorable number.
6. Release the shackle and return it to its original open position (rotate it back 90 degrees clockwise).
7. Close the shackle. Scramble the dials to lock the padlock. Your new combination is now set.

Important: Make sure to remember your new combination. There is no master key or override function to reset the lock if the combination is forgotten.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

To Unlock the Padlock:

1. Align the three numerical dials to your set combination.
2. Pull up the shackle to open the padlock.

To Lock the Padlock:

1. Close the shackle by pressing it down into the padlock body.
2. Scramble the numerical dials to a random sequence. This will secure the padlock.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and smooth operation of your HMF Vintage Combination Padlock, keep it clean and free from dust and debris. Wipe with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or solvents, as these may damage the finish. If the dials become stiff, a small amount of graphite lubricant or a silicone-based spray can be applied to the moving parts, taking care to avoid contact with the exterior finish.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Forgotten Combination:** This padlock does not have a master key or a backdoor reset method if the combination is forgotten without following the reset procedure. It is crucial to remember your set combination. If lost, the padlock may need to be cut open.
- **Dials are Stiff:** Ensure the dials are clean. If they are difficult to turn, apply a small amount of graphite lubricant or a silicone-based spray to the moving parts, avoiding contact with the exterior finish.
- **Padlock Will Not Open:** Double-check that the correct combination is aligned precisely. Ensure the shackle is not jammed or obstructed.








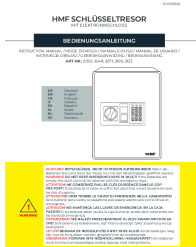
Image: Diagram showing the precise dimensions of the HMF Vintage Combination Padlock, including height, width, depth, and shackle measurements.
