CARE AND MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Blu-ray discs, follow these care guidelines:

- **Handling:** Always hold discs by their edges or the center hole. Avoid touching the shiny playback surface.
- **Cleaning:** If a disc becomes dirty, gently wipe it with a soft, lint-free cloth in a straight line from the center to the outer edge. Do not wipe in circular motions. Use a specialized disc cleaning solution if necessary, but avoid harsh chemicals.

- **Storage:** Store discs in their original case, away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and high humidity. Keep them in a vertical position to prevent warping.
- **Avoid Scratches:** Do not place discs on rough surfaces or stack them without protection.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues during playback, consider the following common solutions:

- **Disc Not Playing:**
 - Ensure the disc is clean and free of smudges or scratches.
 - Verify your player is a Blu-ray player, not a standard DVD player.
 - Check the disc's region code against your player's region settings.

 - Check for visible damage on the disc surface.
 - Ensure your Blu-ray player's firmware is up to date.
- **No Audio/Video:**
 - Confirm all cables (HDMI, audio) are securely connected between your player and TV/audio system.
 - Check your TV's input source selection.
 - Verify audio settings on your Blu-ray player and TV.
