1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your FVBADE 78S Pandora Box Retro Arcade Game Console. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product to ensure proper functionality and longevity.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all items are present in the package:

- FVBADE 78S Main Console Unit (integrated into one of the controllers)
- Second Player Controller Unit
- HDMI Cable
- VGA Cable (if applicable)
- USB Cable (for connecting controllers or external devices)
- Power Adapter
- User Manual (this document)

3. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to set up your FVBADE 78S arcade game console:

3.1 Connecting the Controllers

The FVBADE 78S features two separate controller units. Connect the second player controller to the main console unit using the provided data cable. The cable length is approximately 1.5 meters (4.9 feet), allowing for comfortable spacing between players.

3.2 Connecting to a Display Device

The console supports various display outputs. Choose the appropriate cable for your device:

- **HDMI Output:** Connect the HDMI cable from the console's HDMI port to your TV, PC monitor, or projector. This is the recommended connection for high-definition display.
- **VGA Output:** Connect the VGA cable from the console's VGA port to a compatible PC monitor or projector.
- **USB Output:** The USB port can be used to connect to a PC, PlayStation, or Xbox as an external joystick, if the games support it.

3.3 Power Connection

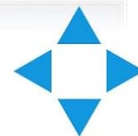

4.3 Game Management Features

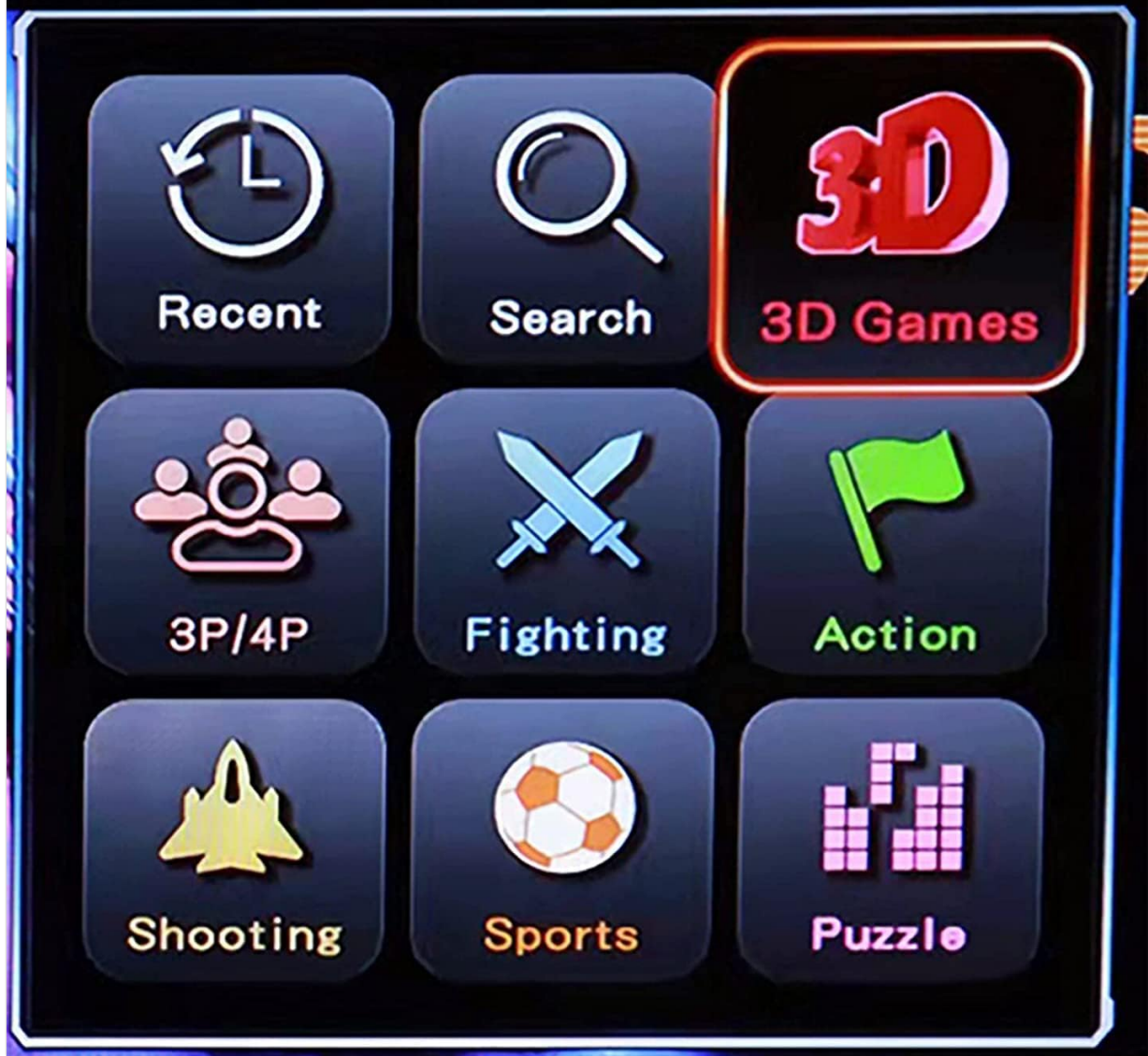


Image 4.3.1: Game Category Menu.

- **Exit:** Return to the main game menu.

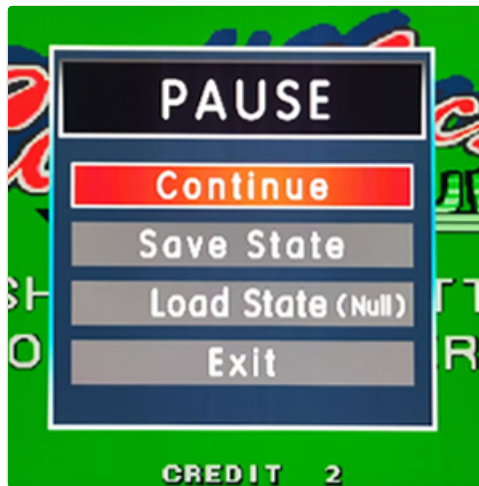


Image 4.4.1: Pause Menu.

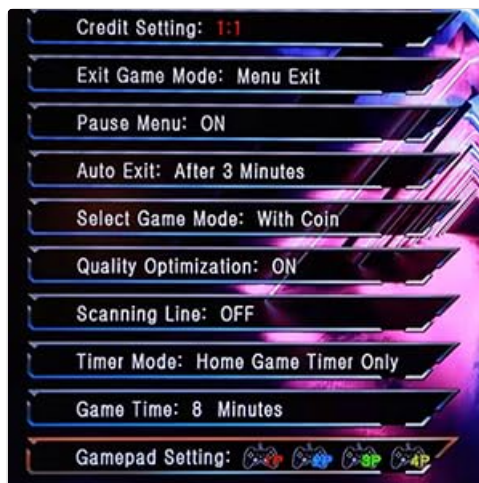


Image 4.5.1: System Settings Menu.

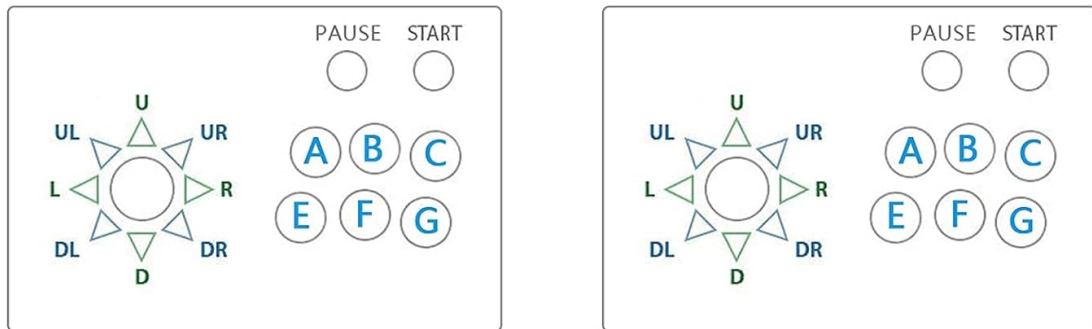


Image 4.6.1: Controller Button Layout.

5. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your FVBADE 78S console, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe down the console and controllers. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or solvents, as these can damage the finish.
- **Storage:** Store the console in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Cable Management:** Ensure all cables are connected securely and are not kinked or strained.
- **Avoid Liquids:** Keep liquids away from the console and controllers to prevent electrical damage.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your FVBADE 78S console, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

6.1 No Power / Console Not Turning On

- **Check Power Connection:** Ensure the power adapter is securely plugged into both the console and a working electrical outlet.
- **Power Switch:** Verify that the power switch on the main console unit is in the "ON" position.

- **Adapter Functionality:** If possible, test the power adapter with another compatible device or try a different outlet.

6.2 No Display / Blue or Green Screen

- **Check HDMI/VGA Cable:** Ensure the display cable (HDMI or VGA) is firmly connected to both the console and the display device. Try re-seating the cable.
- **Input Source:** Confirm that your TV, monitor, or projector is set to the correct input source (e.g., HDMI 1, VGA).
- **Test Different Display:** If possible, try connecting the console to a different display device to rule out an issue with your primary screen.
- **Restart Console:** Power cycle the console by turning it off, unplugging it for a few seconds, and then plugging it back in and turning it on.

6.3 Games Not Playing Correctly / Freezing

- **Restart Game:** Exit the game and restart it.
- **System Restart:** Perform a full system restart.
- **Check for Updates:** While not explicitly mentioned, some systems may offer firmware updates that resolve game compatibility issues. Consult the manufacturer's website if available.
- **Game Specific Issues:** Some games may have known performance quirks.

6.4 Controller Issues (Loose Joystick/Buttons)

- **Check Connections:** Ensure the data cable connecting the two controllers is secure.
- **System Settings:** Verify controller settings in the system menu (Section 4.5).
- **Physical Inspection:** Inspect joysticks and buttons for any visible damage or debris.
