PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The LyxPro CS 39" Electric Guitar features a solid wood construction designed for comfort and sound performance. It includes a smooth Paulownia wood body, a durable Rosewood fingerboard, and a polished Canadian Maple neck. The

guitar is equipped with single-coil pickups and a 5-way rhythm/treble pickup switch for versatile tonal options.

SETUP

1. Unpacking and Inspection

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Inspect the guitar and accessories for any signs of damage. Retain the original packaging for future storage or transport.

2. Connecting the Amplifier (if applicable)

If your kit includes an amplifier, connect the guitar to the amplifier using the provided amplifier cable. Ensure both the guitar and amplifier are turned off before making connections. Plug one end of the cable into the guitar's output jack and the other end into the amplifier's input jack.

3. Tuning the Guitar

Use the included clip-on tuner to accurately tune your guitar. Attach the tuner to the headstock. Pluck each string individually and adjust the tuning pegs until the tuner indicates the correct pitch for each string (E, A, D, G, B, E from thickest to thinnest).

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Using the Controls

- **Volume Knob:** Controls the overall output volume of the guitar. Turn clockwise to increase volume, counter-clockwise to decrease.
- **Tone Knobs:** Adjust the tonal characteristics, from bright to mellow.
- **5-Way Pickup Selector Switch:** Allows you to select different pickup configurations for varied sounds.
 - Position 1 (Bridge): Brightest tone, ideal for lead playing.
 - Position 2 (Bridge and Middle): Combines pickups for a slightly warmer, quacky tone.
 - Position 3 (Middle): Balanced tone.
 - Position 4 (Middle and Neck): Combines pickups for a warmer, fuller tone.
 - Position 5 (Neck): Warmest tone, suitable for rhythm and blues.
- **Tremolo Arm:** Insert into the bridge to create vibrato effects by raising or lowering the pitch of the strings.

2. Playing Techniques

The included learner's guide provides basic instructions for chords, scales, and fundamental playing techniques. Practice regularly to develop your skills. Experiment with the guitar's controls to discover different sounds and find your preferred tone.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe down the guitar body and neck with a soft, dry cloth after each use to remove sweat and oils. For a deeper clean, use a guitar-specific cleaning solution.
- **String Changes:** Replace strings regularly, typically every 1-3 months depending on usage, to maintain optimal tone and playability. Use the provided restring tools if needed.
- **Storage:** Store the guitar in its gig bag or a hard case when not in use to protect it from dust, humidity changes, and physical damage. Avoid extreme temperatures.
- **Fretboard Care:** Periodically clean and condition the rosewood fretboard to prevent drying and cracking.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
No sound from amplifier	Cable not connected, amplifier off, volume low, faulty cable/amp.	Ensure cable is securely connected. Turn on amplifier. Increase guitar and amp volume. Test with a different cable or amp if available.
Guitar won't stay in tune	New strings stretching, improper string winding, worn tuning pegs, nut issues.	Stretch new strings thoroughly. Ensure strings are wound correctly on tuning pegs. Consider professional setup if issues persist.
Buzzing sound when playing	Low string action, uneven frets, improper playing technique.	Check string height and adjust bridge saddles if necessary. Practice proper finger placement. Consult a guitar technician for fret leveling.
Controls not working	Loose wiring, faulty potentiometer/switch.	This typically requires professional repair. Avoid attempting electrical repairs without proper knowledge.


