### 1. INTRODUCTION

The ZOKOP 21 Inch Charcoal Grill is designed for outdoor cooking and heating. Its durable iron construction and heat-resistant paint ensure longevity. Key features include:

- Flame-retardant spark guard provide you a safe and clean environment.
- Lightweight make it carry conveniently.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- For outdoor use only. Do not use indoors or in an enclosed area.
- Keep children and pets away from the grill at all times.
- Use on a flat, stable, non-combustible surface.
- Do not use gasoline, kerosene, or alcohol for lighting charcoal. Use only charcoal lighter fluid.
- Never leave a lit grill unattended.
- Allow the grill to cool completely before moving or cleaning.
- Wear protective gloves when handling hot components.
- Ensure adequate ventilation when using.

#### 4. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to assemble your ZOKOP 21 Inch Charcoal Grill:

1. **Attach the Legs:** Locate the three legs and the corresponding attachment points on the grill bowl. Secure each leg to the grill bowl using the provided screws, washers, and nuts. Ensure they are tightened securely but do not overtighten.

2. **Insert Charcoal Grate:** Place the charcoal grate at the bottom of the grill bowl. This grate supports the charcoal and allows ash to fall through.
3. **Place Cooking Grate:** Position the cooking grate above the charcoal grate. This is where you will place your food.
4. **Position Spark Screen:** Place the spark screen (mesh lid) on top of the grill bowl. This helps contain sparks and embers during use.
5. **Final Check:** Ensure all components are securely in place and the grill is stable on a flat surface before use.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Before first use, it is recommended to "season" the grill by burning a small amount of charcoal for about 30 minutes without food. This helps burn off any manufacturing residues.

1. **Choose a Location:** Place the grill on a level, non-combustible surface, away from flammable materials, buildings, and overhanging structures.



2. **Add Charcoal:** Place charcoal briquettes or lump charcoal onto the charcoal grate. Do not overfill.
3. **Light Charcoal:** Use charcoal lighter fluid according to its instructions. Allow the fluid to soak in for a few minutes, then carefully light the charcoal. Do not add lighter fluid to hot or warm charcoal.
4. **Wait for Ash:** Allow the charcoal to burn until it is covered with a light gray ash (approximately 20-30 minutes). This indicates it's ready for cooking.
5. **Place Food:** Carefully place food on the cooking grate.
6. **Monitor and Cook:** Use the poker tool to adjust charcoal if needed. Keep the spark screen in place to prevent embers from escaping.
7. **Extinguish:** Once cooking is complete, allow the charcoal to burn down naturally. Do not use water to extinguish hot charcoal, as this can damage the grill and create steam hazards.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance will extend the life of your grill.

- **Cleaning:** After the grill has completely cooled, remove the cooking grate and charcoal grate. Scrape off any food residue from the cooking grate. Empty ash from the grill bowl. Wipe down the grill bowl and legs with a damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners.
- **Ash Disposal:** Ensure all ashes are cold before disposing of them. Wrap in heavy-duty aluminum foil and place in a non-combustible container.
- **Storage:** Store the grill in a dry, covered area when not in use. The included carrying bag provides convenient storage and transport.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Charcoal not lighting easily.	Insufficient lighter fluid; charcoal too damp; not enough air circulation.	Ensure charcoal is dry; use adequate lighter fluid; arrange charcoal for better airflow.
Grill is unstable.	Legs not tightened; uneven surface.	Check and tighten all leg screws; move grill to a flat, level surface.
Excessive smoke.	Too much lighter fluid; food drippings.	Allow lighter fluid to burn off completely before cooking; trim excess fat from food.
