Model: SM-421326-DL92

Compatible with Singer 4622 Sewing Machine and Singer Part #421326

1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the proper installation, operation, and maintenance of your UpStart Components Replacement Bobbin Case, Model SM-421326-DL92. This bobbin case is designed as a compatible replacement part for the Singer 4622 Sewing Machine, corresponding to Singer part #421326. Please read these instructions carefully before use to ensure optimal performance and longevity of the product.

2. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Before installing the new bobbin case, ensure your sewing machine is turned off and unplugged from the power source for safety. Refer to your Singer 4622 Sewing Machine's original instruction manual for specific guidance on accessing and removing the existing bobbin case.

2.1 Removing the Old Bobbin Case

1. Raise the needle to its highest position.
2. Open the bobbin cover plate on your sewing machine.
3. Carefully remove the old bobbin case. Note its orientation for easier installation of the new one.

2.2 Installing the New Bobbin Case

The UpStart Components bobbin case is designed for a precise fit.

1. Ensure the new bobbin case is clean and free of any debris.
2. Hold the bobbin case with the finger (the small projection) pointing upwards or towards the front of the machine, depending on your machine's design.
3. Carefully insert the new bobbin case into its designated slot in the sewing machine. It should fit snugly without excessive force.
4. Ensure it is seated correctly and does not wobble.
5. Close the bobbin cover plate.

3. OPERATING THE BOBBIN CASE

Proper loading of the bobbin into the case is crucial for smooth sewing.

3.1 Loading the Bobbin

1. Insert a wound bobbin into the bobbin case. The thread should unwind in the direction specified by your sewing machine's manual (usually clockwise or counter-clockwise).
2. Guide the bobbin thread through the slot in the bobbin case and under the tension spring.
3. Pull the thread gently to ensure it moves smoothly and has appropriate tension.

3.2 Inserting the Loaded Bobbin Case into the Machine

1. With the bobbin loaded, hold the bobbin case by its latch or finger.
2. Insert the loaded bobbin case into the shuttle race of your sewing machine. Ensure the finger of the bobbin case aligns with the notch in the machine's bobbin area.
3. Close the latch or release the finger to secure the bobbin case in place.
4. Pull the upper thread down and around the bobbin case to pick up the bobbin thread, as instructed by your sewing machine's manual.

4. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance of your bobbin case will help ensure consistent stitch quality and extend its lifespan.

- **Cleaning:** Periodically remove the bobbin case from the machine. Use a small brush or lint remover to clear any lint, dust, or broken thread from inside and around the bobbin case, especially near the tension spring.
- **Inspection:** Check the bobbin case for any signs of wear, nicks, or burrs, particularly on the edges where the thread passes. Damaged areas can snag the thread and cause issues.
- **Tension:** The bobbin case has a tension screw. Adjusting this screw should only be done if you are experienced and confident in setting bobbin tension, as incorrect tension can lead to stitching problems. Refer to your sewing machine's manual for guidance on bobbin tension adjustment.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues after installing the new bobbin case, consider the following common problems and solutions:

- **Thread Jamming/Nesting:**

- Ensure the bobbin is correctly wound and inserted into the bobbin case.
 - Verify the bobbin thread is properly routed through the tension spring.
 - Check for any lint or debris inside the bobbin case or shuttle area.
- **Skipped Stitches:**
 - Confirm the bobbin case is fully seated and correctly aligned in the machine.
 - Check the bobbin thread tension; it might be too loose or too tight.
 - **Uneven Stitches:**
 - Review both upper and bobbin thread tension settings.
 - Ensure the bobbin case is free from damage or burrs that could impede thread flow.
