## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your Targus Bluetrace Wireless Ergonomic Mouse (Model: AMW584GL). This advanced mouse combines optical and laser technologies for precise tracking on various surfaces and features an ergonomic design for comfortable use. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product.

## 2. PRODUCT FEATURES

---

- **Advanced BlueTrace Technology:** Offers precise tracking on various surfaces including wood, granite, and carpet, by combining optical and laser technologies.
- **Reliable 2.4GHz Wireless Connection:** Ensures stable and seamless performance with a dedicated USB receiver.
- **Enhanced Functionality with 7 Silent Buttons:** Provides a quiet and highly functional user experience, suitable for productivity and general use.
- **Targus DefenseGuard Protection:** Features integrated antimicrobial protection to continuously prevent the growth of microorganisms on the mouse surface.
- **Ergonomic Design:** Specifically designed for right-handed users to reduce wrist strain during extended use.
- **Long Battery Life:** Boasts over 650 hours of battery life with a low battery indicator, powered by 2 x AA batteries.
- **Broad Compatibility:** Compatible with Chrome OS, Windows (10/8.1/8/7/Vista/XP/2000), and macOS (X 10.6-10.12.4).

## 3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all items are present in the package:

- Targus Bluetrace Wireless Ergonomic Mouse (AMW584GL)
- USB Receiver (stored inside the mouse)
- 2 x AA Batteries

## 4. SETUP GUIDE

### 4.1. Installing Batteries

1. Locate the battery compartment on the underside of the mouse.
2. Slide the battery cover open.
3. Insert the two (2) AA batteries, ensuring correct polarity (+/-) as indicated inside the compartment.
4. Close the battery cover securely.

### 4.2. Connecting the USB Receiver

1. Remove the USB receiver from its storage slot on the underside of the mouse.
2. Plug the USB receiver into an available USB port on your computer.
3. Your computer should automatically detect and install the necessary drivers. This may take a few moments.

### 4.3. Powering On the Mouse

1. Locate the On/Off switch on the underside of the mouse, near the optical sensor.
2. Slide the switch to the "On" position.
3. The mouse is now ready for use.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 5.1. Basic Functions

- **Left Click:** Primary button for selecting items, opening links, etc.
- **Right Click:** Secondary button for context menus and additional options.

- **Scroll Wheel:** Scroll up or down through documents and web pages. The scroll wheel can also be pressed for middle-click functionality.

## 5.2. Advanced Buttons

The Targus Bluetrace mouse features 7 functional buttons. In addition to the standard left, right, and scroll wheel click, it includes:

- **DPI Adjustment Button:** Located near the scroll wheel, this button allows you to cycle through different DPI (Dots Per Inch) settings to adjust cursor sensitivity. Higher DPI means faster cursor movement.
- **Side Buttons:** Typically located on the thumb side of the mouse, these buttons are often pre-programmed for "Forward" and "Back" navigation in web browsers or file explorers. Their functions may be customizable through your operating system's mouse settings.
- **Additional Buttons:** Depending on the specific model, there may be other programmable buttons. Refer to your operating system's mouse settings for customization options.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

### 6.1. Cleaning Your Mouse

The Targus Bluetrace mouse features DefenseGuard Protection, which helps prevent the growth of microorganisms. To maintain cleanliness and functionality:

- Use a soft, lint-free cloth slightly dampened with water or a mild, non-abrasive cleaning solution.
- Wipe the surface of the mouse gently.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or submerging the mouse in liquid.
- Ensure the mouse is completely dry before use.

### 6.2. Battery Replacement

When the low battery indicator illuminates or mouse performance degrades, it's time to replace the batteries. Follow the steps in Section 4.1 to replace the two (2) AA batteries.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Mouse not responding.	Low or dead batteries. USB receiver not connected or loose. Mouse is off.	Replace batteries. Ensure USB receiver is firmly plugged into a working USB port. Turn the mouse On.
Erratic cursor movement or poor tracking.	Dirty optical sensor. Unsuitable surface. Interference.	Clean the optical sensor with a soft, dry cloth. Use the mouse on a clean, non-reflective surface. Move the mouse closer to the USB receiver or away from other wireless devices.
Wireless connection issues.	USB receiver out of range. Interference.	Ensure the mouse is within operating range of the USB receiver. Try plugging the receiver into a different USB port.
Buttons not functioning.	Software issue.	Restart your computer. Check your operating system's mouse settings for button assignments.




Figure 9.1: Image representing Targus Tech Accessories, including a mouse and keyboard, emphasizing the brand's range of peripherals.
