Please read this manual carefully before assembly and use to ensure proper setup and safe operation.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The Yaheetech bed frame is designed for fast and easy assembly. It features pre-attached side and central rails with foldable legs, simplifying the setup process. All necessary parts, hardware, and clear instructions are included.

Assembly Steps:

1. Unpack and Identify Components:

Carefully unpack all components from the box. Lay them out on a clean, soft surface (like a carpet) to prevent scratching. Identify each part using the provided parts list in your physical manual.

3. Connect the Frame Sections:

- **No Box Spring Needed:**

The sturdy steel slat support system eliminates the need for a traditional box spring. Simply place your mattress directly on the frame.

- **Headboard Compatibility:**

The legs of the bed frame include pre-drilled holes for easy attachment of your preferred headboard. Ensure the holes are facing towards the head of the bed during assembly. Additional hardware for headboard attachment is not provided and must be purchased separately.

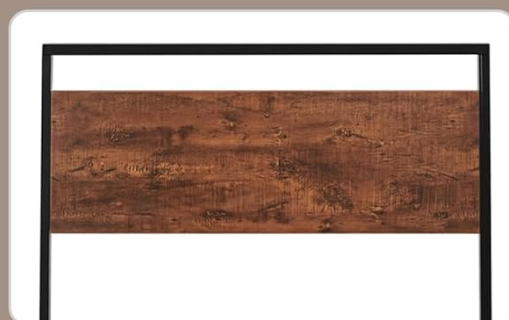
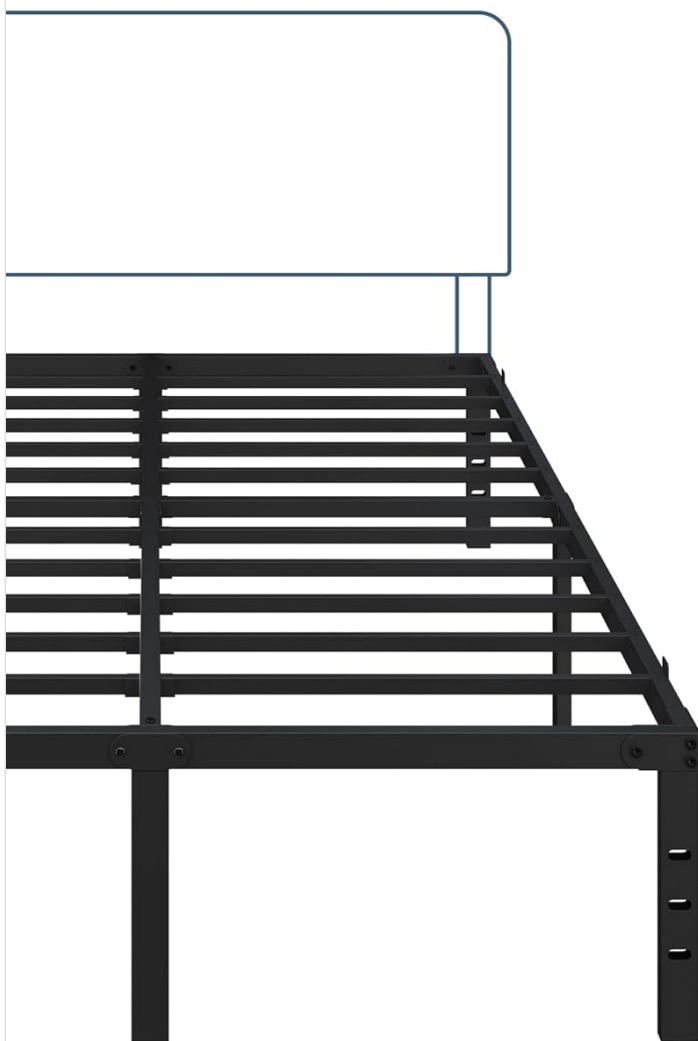


Image: A visual guide demonstrating how the bed frame is compatible with different headboard styles, showing the attachment points.



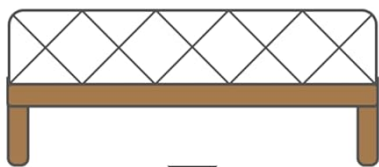

- **Noise-Free and Anti-slip Design:**

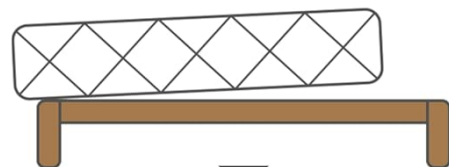

MAINTENANCE

- **Weight Distribution:** Distribute weight evenly across the bed frame to prevent undue stress on specific areas.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your bed frame, please refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bed frame is squeaking.	Loose bolts or slats not properly seated.	Check and tighten all assembly bolts. Ensure all slats are fully inserted into their plastic slots.
Mattress is sliding.	Anti-slip baffles not engaged or mattress too small.	Verify that the anti-slip baffles are correctly positioned. Ensure your mattress size matches the frame (80" L x 60" W for Queen).
Frame feels unstable or wobbly.	Incomplete assembly or loose connections.	Review the assembly instructions and ensure all steps were followed correctly. Tighten all bolts securely. Ensure the frame is on a level surface.
Difficulty attaching a headboard.	Incorrect orientation of legs or missing hardware.	Ensure the legs with pre-drilled holes are facing the head of the bed. Note that headboard attachment hardware is not included with the frame.

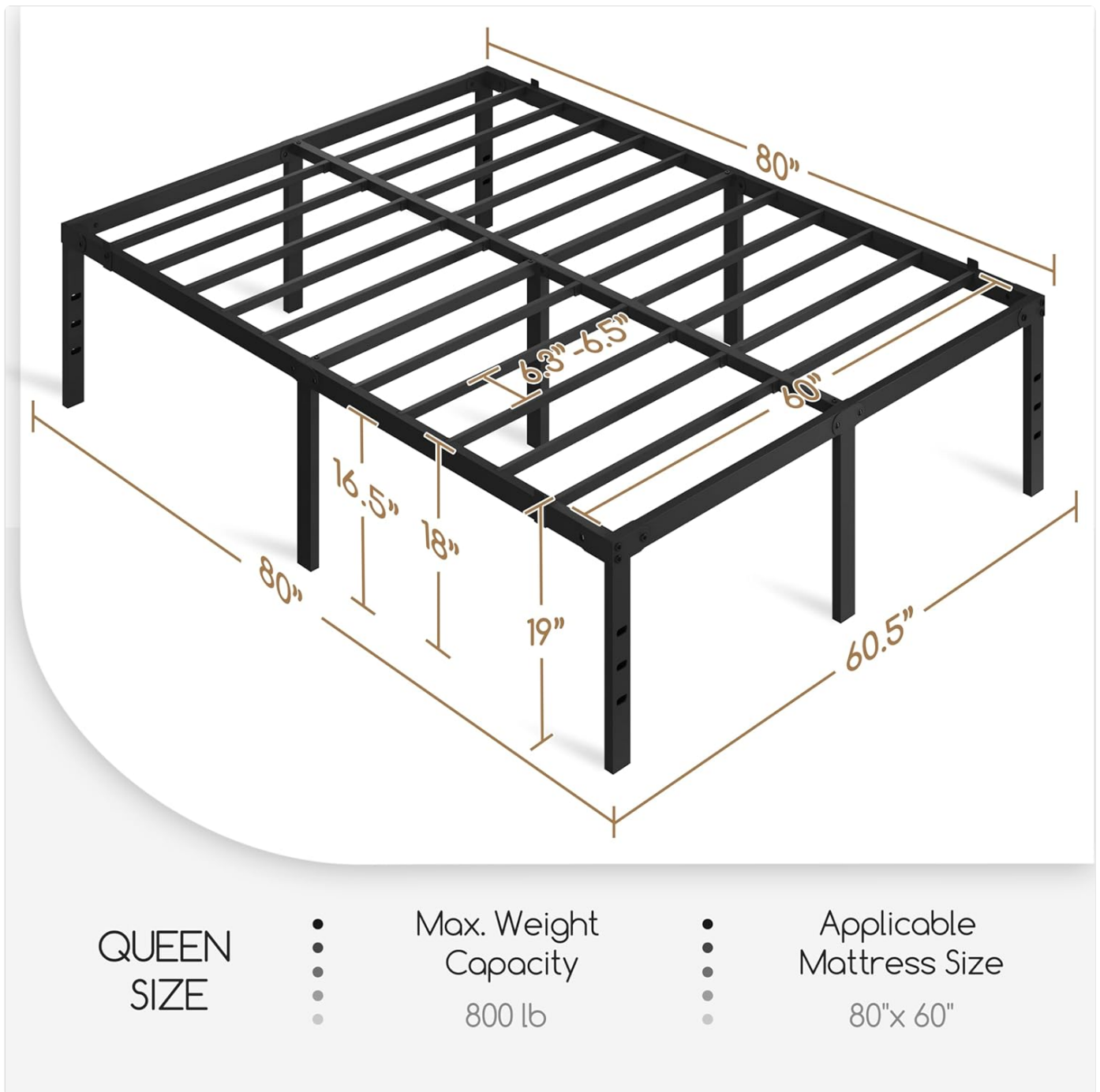


Image: A comprehensive diagram displaying the key dimensions of the Yaheetech Queen Bed Frame, including length, width, height, and under-bed clearance.
