1. Introduction

The Legami Automatic Tombola Bingo Set is a complete game kit designed for entertaining gatherings. This manual provides instructions for setting up, operating, and maintaining your game set.

Product Contents:

- 1 Rotating Metal Ball Cage with automatic ball collection
- 90 Numbered Balls
- 1 Number Board
- 60 Reusable Bingo Cards
- 300 Marking Chips
- 2 Fabric Pouches

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: CHOKING HAZARD - Small parts. Not for children under 3 years.

Always supervise young children during play. Ensure all small components are kept out of reach of infants and toddlers to prevent accidental ingestion.

3. SETUP

- 1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all items from the packaging. Verify that all listed components are present.
- 2. Position the Cage: Place the rotating metal ball cage on a stable, flat surface where the game will be played.
- 3. **Prepare Balls:** Ensure all 90 numbered balls are inside the rotating cage.
- 4. Set Up Number Board: Place the number board adjacent to the cage for easy tracking of called numbers.
- 5. **Distribute Game Materials:** Provide each player with one or more reusable bingo cards and a sufficient quantity of marking chips. Store extra chips in one of the fabric pouches.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS (How to PLAY)

The objective of Tombola/Bingo is to be the first player to mark off a predetermined pattern of numbers on their card and call out "Bingo!" or "Tombola!".

Game Play Steps:

- 1. Player Preparation: Each participant selects one or more bingo cards and receives a supply of marking chips.
- 2. Designate a Caller: One person is chosen to operate the ball cage and call out the numbers.
- 3. **Drawing Numbers:** The caller rotates the handle of the metal cage to mix the balls. A single numbered ball will be automatically dispensed.
- 4. **Calling and Marking:** The caller clearly announces the number on the drawn ball. Players check their cards for the announced number. If a number is present on their card, they cover it with a marking chip. The caller places the drawn ball on the corresponding spot on the number board to keep track of called numbers.

- 5. **Winning:** The first player to complete a predefined pattern (e.g., a horizontal line, a vertical line, a diagonal line, or a full card) shouts "Bingo!" or "Tombola!".
- 6. **Verification:** The caller verifies the winning card against the numbers displayed on the number board. If correct, the player wins.
- 7. **Continue Play:** The game can continue for additional patterns or full cards until all desired prizes are awarded.



5. MAINTENANCE

Cleaning:

- Wipe the metal cage and plastic components (balls, chips, board) with a soft, dry cloth.
- Avoid using abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals, as these may damage the materials or fade the numbers.

Storage:

- After use, gather all numbered balls and marking chips and store them in the provided fabric pouches.
- Store the entire game set in its original packaging or a suitable container in a dry place to prevent loss or damage to components.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
Balls are not dispensing smoothly from the cage.	Debris in the cage mechanism or uneven rotation.	Ensure the cage is clean. Rotate the handle smoothly and consistently.
Numbers on balls are fading.	Normal wear and tear.	Use a permanent marker to carefully re-label the faded numbers.
Missing game components.	Components may have been misplaced or were missing upon purchase.	Refer to the "Product Contents" section to verify all parts. If essential parts were missing upon initial purchase, contact Legami customer support.
