1. Introduction

With long battery life and versatile connectivity options, the UX3000 is ideal for music listening, movies, and gaming.

- 3.5mm Cable for Wired Connection

Note: A USB charger is not included in the package.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

3.1 Headphone Components

Familiarize yourself with the various parts and controls of your Final UX3000 headphones.

Controls and Indicators:

- Power Button: Used to power the headphones on/off and initiate Bluetooth pairing.
- Volume + / Buttons: Adjusts the audio volume.
- Multi-function Button: Controls playback (play/pause), call management (answer/end calls), and activates voice assistant.

- ANC Button: Toggles Active Noise Cancelling on/off.
- Bluetooth / ANC Status Indicator: LED light indicating power, pairing status, and ANC status.
- USB-C Charging Port: For charging the headphones.
- 3.5mm Audio Jack: For wired connection.

4. SETUP

4.1 Charging the Headphones

Before first use, fully charge your UX3000 headphones. Connect the supplied USB-C charging cable to the headphone's USB-C port and the other end to a USB power source (e.g., computer USB port, USB wall adapter). The LED indicator will show charging status and turn off when fully charged.

- Charging Time: Approximately 2.5 hours for a full charge.
- Battery Life: Up to 35 hours of music playback.

4.2 Bluetooth Pairing

To connect your headphones wirelessly to a device:

- 1. Ensure the headphones are powered off.
- 2. Press and hold the Power button for approximately 5 seconds until the LED indicator flashes blue and red, indicating pairing mode.
- 3. On your device (smartphone, tablet, computer), enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
- 4. Select "Final UX3000" from the list of found devices.
- 5. Once connected, the LED indicator will flash blue slowly. A voice prompt will confirm "Device Connected".

Multipoint Connection:

The UX3000 supports multipoint connection, allowing you to connect to two Bluetooth devices simultaneously. For example, you can be connected to your smartphone and your laptop at the same time, seamlessly switching audio sources.

4.3 Wired Connection

For a wired audio experience or when the battery is depleted, use the supplied 3.5mm audio cable.

- 1. Connect one end of the 3.5mm cable to the audio jack on the headphones.
- 2. Connect the other end to the 3.5mm audio output of your device.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Power On/Off

- Power On: Press and hold the Power button for 2 seconds. The LED indicator will flash blue.
- Power Off: Press and hold the Power button for 3 seconds. The LED indicator will turn off.

5.2 Music Playback

- Play/Pause: Press the Multi-function button once.
- Next Track: Press and hold the Volume + button for 2 seconds.
- Previous Track: Press and hold the Volume button for 2 seconds.
- Volume Up: Press the Volume + button briefly.
- Volume Down: Press the Volume button briefly.

5.3 Hybrid Noise Cancelling (ANC)

The UX3000 features Hybrid Active Noise Cancelling, utilizing two microphones per ear cup to effectively reduce ambient noise. One microphone collects external noise, and the other collects sound from the driver unit, allowing for highly accurate anti-noise signal generation.

• Activate/Deactivate ANC: Press the ANC button once. A voice prompt will confirm the status.

5.4 aptX Low Latency Support

The UX3000 supports aptX Low Latency, which minimizes audio delay and ensures proper synchronization with visuals. This feature provides an optimal experience for watching movies and playing games, preventing noticeable lag between audio and video.

5.5 Call Functions

- Answer/End Call: Press the Multi-function button once.
- Reject Call: Press and hold the Multi-function button for 2 seconds.
- Activate Voice Assistant: Double-press the Multi-function button.

6. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Final UX3000 headphones, follow these maintenance guidelines:

• Cleaning: Wipe the headphones with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners, solvents, or strong

chemicals.

- **Storage:** When not in use, store the headphones in the provided soft carrying pouch to protect them from dust and scratches. The headphones are foldable for compact storage.
- Avoid Moisture: Keep the headphones away from water, humidity, and extreme temperatures.
- **Charging:** Do not leave the headphones connected to a charger for extended periods after they are fully charged.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Final UX3000 headphones, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution	
Headphones do not power on.	Low battery.	Charge the headphones fully.	
Cannot pair with device.	Headphones not in pairing mode; device's Bluetooth is off; too many paired devices.	Ensure headphones are in pairing mode (flashing red/blue). Turn on Bluetooth on your device. Forget previous pairings on your device and try again.	
No sound or low volume.	Volume too low; headphones not connected; incorrect audio output selected on device.	Increase volume on both headphones and device. Reconnect headphones. Check audio output settings on your device.	

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Noise Cancelling not effective.	ANC not activated; environmental noise too high for full cancellation.	Ensure ANC is activated. ANC is most effective for low-frequency, constant noises.
Voice prompts (e.g., "Battery Low") occur frequently even when charged.	Potential firmware issue or specific device interaction.	Ensure headphones are fully charged. If issue persists, contact customer support.
