# Cook's Essentials Air Fryer Lid Instruction Manual

## 1. INTRODUCTION

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This manual provides essential information for the safe and effective use of your Cook's Essentials Air Fryer Lid. This universal lid is designed to transform your existing 6- to 8-quart pressure cooker or 8, 10, and 12-inch pots and pans into an air fryer, offering versatile cooking options.

## 2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

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Please read all instructions carefully before using the appliance. Failure to follow these instructions may result in electric shock, fire, or serious injury.

- Always unplug the appliance from the outlet when not in use and before cleaning.
- Do not immerse the lid, cord, or plug in water or other liquids.
- Keep hands and face away from the steam vent during operation.
- Use the appliance on a stable, heat-resistant surface.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- The exterior surfaces of the appliance may become hot during use. Use oven mitts or pot holders when handling.
- Ensure the lid is securely seated on the pot or pressure cooker before operation.

## 4. SETUP

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Follow these steps to prepare your Air Fryer Lid for use:

1. **Choose a Compatible Pot:** Select a 6- to 8-quart pressure cooker or an 8, 10, or 12-inch pot or pan. Ensure the pot is heat-resistant and suitable for cooking.
2. **Place Food in Pot:** Add your desired food to the chosen pot. Do not overfill the pot.
3. **Position the Lid:** Carefully place the Air Fryer Lid onto the rim of your pot, ensuring it sits securely and creates a seal.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Power On:** Once plugged in, the control panel will display. Press the power button to activate.
2. **Select Preset (Optional):** The lid includes four presets for common air frying tasks. Press the preset button to cycle through options.
3. **Adjust Time and Temperature:** Use the dedicated time and temperature buttons to set your desired cooking parameters. The digital display will show the current settings.
4. **Start Cooking:** Press the start button to begin the air frying process. The built-in safety switch ensures operation only when the lid is properly placed.
5. **Monitor Cooking:** Periodically check food for doneness. For even cooking, it may be necessary to shake or flip food halfway through the cooking cycle.
6. **Finish Cooking:** The appliance will beep when the cooking cycle is complete. Carefully lift the lid using the handle, ensuring to place it on the provided silicone mat or a heat-resistant surface.

## 6. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

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Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and performance of your Air Fryer Lid.

- **Unplug Before Cleaning:** Always ensure the appliance is unplugged and completely cooled before cleaning.
- **Lid Cleaning:** The Air Fryer Lid is dishwasher safe. Alternatively, wipe the exterior with a damp cloth. For the interior, use a soft brush or sponge with mild soap and water to clean the heating element and fan area. Ensure no water enters the electrical components.
- **Silicone Mat:** The silicone mat can be washed by hand with soap and water or placed in the dishwasher.

- **Storage:** Store the lid in a dry place when not in use.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

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If you encounter issues, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Appliance does not power on.	Not plugged in; power outlet issue; lid not seated correctly.	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working outlet. Verify the lid is properly placed on the pot, activating the safety switch.
Food is not cooking evenly or is too dry.	Overcrowding the pot; incorrect temperature/time settings.	Avoid overcrowding; cook in smaller batches if necessary. Adjust temperature and time settings. Shake or flip food halfway through cooking.
Error code 'E2' displayed.	Internal malfunction or sensor issue.	Unplug the unit, wait a few minutes, then plug it back in. If the error persists, contact customer support.
