## 1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The KINGONE Stylus Pen KO-A1 is a digital pencil designed for use with compatible iPad models from 2018 and later. It features palm rejection, tilt sensitivity, and a magnetic design for enhanced user experience.

## 2. SETUP AND COMPATIBILITY

---

### Compatibility Check:

The KINGONE Stylus Pen KO-A1 is compatible with specific iPad models released in 2018 and later. Please verify your iPad model number before use. This pen is **not** compatible with iPad Pro 10.5", iPad Pro 9.7", iPhone, Android, Microsoft devices, or iPad models released before 2018.

### Initial Charging:

1. Connect the provided USB-C charging cable to the charging port on the stylus.
2. Connect the other end of the cable to a USB power adapter (not included) or a computer's USB port.
3. The indicator light will show charging status. A full charge typically takes approximately 1 hour.

### Powering On/Off:

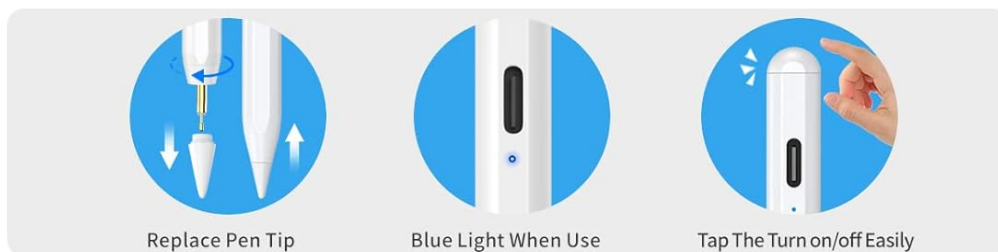
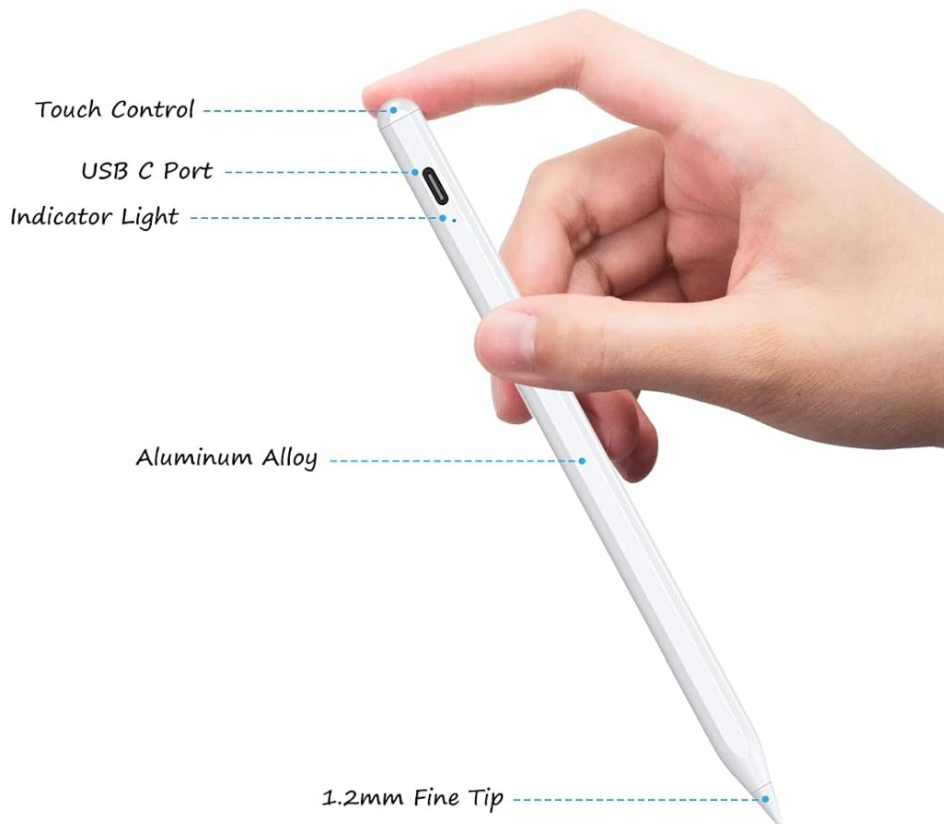
- To turn on the stylus, gently tap the top end of the pen. The indicator light will illuminate blue.
- To turn off the stylus, gently tap the top end of the pen again. The indicator light will turn off.
- The stylus will automatically power off after a period of inactivity to conserve battery.

## 3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### Basic Usage:

Once powered on and compatible with your iPad, the stylus is ready for use. Simply touch the pen tip to the iPad screen to write, draw, or navigate. No Bluetooth pairing is required.

### Palm Rejection:

The stylus features integrated palm rejection technology. This allows you to rest your hand naturally on the iPad screen while writing or drawing without causing unintended marks. Ensure your iPad's 'Only Draw with Apple Pencil' setting (if applicable) is enabled for optimal performance.

## Tilt Sensitivity:

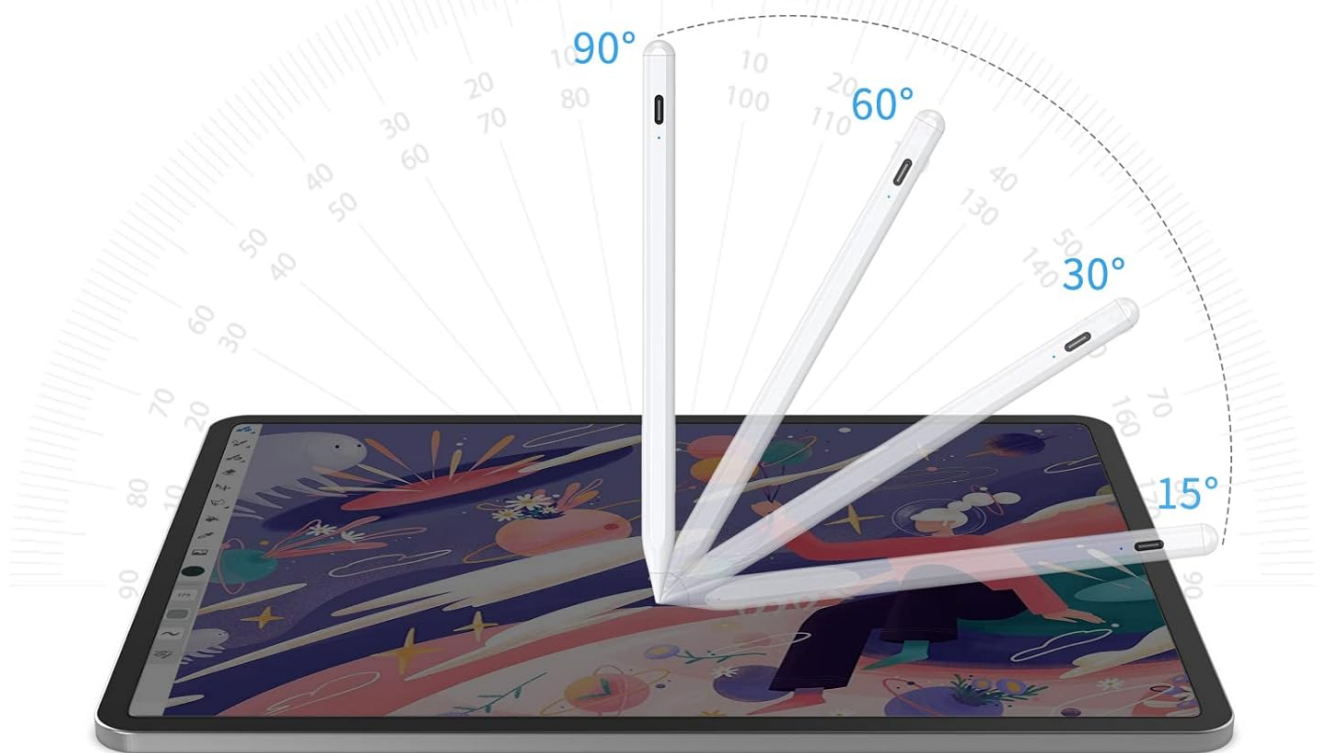
The stylus supports tilt sensitivity, allowing you to vary line thickness by changing the angle at which you hold the pen against the screen. This feature is useful for shading and artistic effects in compatible applications.

## Magnetic Absorption:

## 4. MAINTENANCE

---

### Charging:

Recharge the stylus when the indicator light flashes, indicating low battery. Use the provided USB-C cable for charging. Avoid using damaged cables or non-standard chargers.

### Replacing Pen Tips:

Over time, the pen tip may wear down. To replace it:

1. Gently twist the existing pen tip counter-clockwise to remove it.
2. Select a new replacement tip from the package.
3. Align the new tip with the stylus and twist it clockwise until it is securely fastened. Do not overtighten.

**Cleaning:**

Wipe the stylus body with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive materials. Keep the charging port free of dust and debris.

**5. TROUBLESHOOTING**

---

- **Stylus not turning on:** Ensure the stylus is charged. Tap the top end firmly to activate.
- **Stylus not responding on iPad:**
  - Verify your iPad model is compatible (refer to Section 2).
  - Ensure the stylus is powered on (blue indicator light).
  - Check if your iPad's Bluetooth is turned off (if you previously paired an Apple Pencil, ensure it's disconnected).
  - Restart your iPad.
  - Ensure the pen tip is securely attached and not worn out.
- **Lag or intermittent connection:**
  - Ensure your iPad's operating system is up to date.
  - Close other applications running in the background on your iPad.
  - Recharge the stylus if the battery is low.
- **Indicator Light Meanings:**
  - **Blue:** Stylus is on and operating.
  - **Red (flashing):** Low battery.
  - **Red (solid):** Charging.
  - **Green (solid):** Fully charged.
