DEVICE OVERVIEW

SETUP

1. Inserting SIM and SD Cards

- 1. Locate the SIM tray on the left side of the device (refer to Figure 5).
- 2. Insert the eject pin into the small hole on the SIM tray to open it.
- 3. Carefully pull out the tray.
- 4. Place your Nano-SIM card(s) and/or microSD card into the designated slots on the tray, ensuring correct orientation.
- 5. Gently push the tray back into the phone until it clicks into place.

2. Charging the Battery

- Connect the Type-C cable to the charging port at the bottom of your phone (refer to Figure 3).
- Connect the other end of the cable to the provided charger, then plug the charger into a power outlet.
- Allow the phone to charge fully before initial use. The battery indicator on the screen will show charging status.

3. Powering On and Initial Configuration

- 1. Press and hold the Power button (located on the right side, refer to Figure 4) until the Wiko logo appears.
- 2. Follow the on-screen prompts to select your language, connect to a Wi-Fi network, set up your Google account, and configure security settings (e.g., fingerprint, PIN, pattern).

OPERATING YOUR DEVICE

Basic Navigation

- Touch: Tap an icon to open an app or select an item.
- Swipe: Move your finger across the screen to scroll through pages or content.
- Pinch: Use two fingers to zoom in or out on images and web pages.
- Long Press: Press and hold an item for more options or to move it.

Making Calls and Sending Messages

- Open the "Phone" app to dial numbers or access contacts.
- Open the "Messages" app to compose and send SMS/MMS messages.

Camera Usage

- Tap the "Camera" app icon to open the camera interface.
- Tap the shutter button to take photos. Switch between photo and video modes as needed.
- Utilize the triple camera system for various photographic effects.

Connectivity

- Wi-Fi: Go to Settings > Network & internet > Wi-Fi to connect to available networks.
- Bluetooth: Go to Settings > Connected devices > Bluetooth to pair with Bluetooth accessories.
- Mobile Data: Ensure your SIM card is active and mobile data is enabled in Settings > Network & internet > Mobile network.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning Your Device

- Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and body of the phone.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive materials, or excessive moisture.

Software Updates

 Regularly check for system updates to ensure optimal performance and security. Go to Settings > System > System update.

Battery Care

- Avoid extreme temperatures, as they can degrade battery life.
- Do not leave the phone charging for extended periods after it reaches 100%.

Data Backup

 Regularly back up your important data (photos, contacts, documents) to a cloud service or computer to prevent loss.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Common Issues and Solutions

Issue	Solution
Device not turning on	Ensure the battery is charged. Press and hold the Power button for at least 10-15 seconds to force a restart.
Poor network signal	Check SIM card insertion. Restart the device. Ensure you are in an area with network coverage.
Apps crashing or freezing	Close and reopen the app. Clear the app's cache (Settings > Apps > [App Name] > Storage & cache > Clear cache). Update the app from the Play Store.
Battery drains quickly	Reduce screen brightness. Close unused apps. Disable unnecessary features like GPS or Bluetooth when not in use. Check battery usage in Settings > Battery.
Device unresponsive	Perform a force restart by pressing and holding the Power button for 10-15 seconds.

Factory Reset (Last Resort)

If issues persist, a factory reset may be necessary. This will erase all data on your phone **Backup all important data before proceeding.**

- Go to Settings > System > Reset options > Erase all data (factory reset).
- Follow the on-screen instructions to confirm the reset.
