INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Cangaroo Always Together Bedside Crib. This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your new bedside crib. Please read all instructions carefully before assembly and use, and keep this manual for future reference.

The Cangaroo Always Together Bedside Crib is designed to provide a safe and comfortable sleeping environment for your baby, allowing them to sleep close to you. It features adjustable height, a rocking function, and a tilt option to aid digestion and breathing. It can be used as a standalone crib or attached to a parent's bed.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- **WARNING:** Always ensure the crib is assembled correctly and all locking mechanisms are engaged before placing a child inside.
- **WARNING:** Do not use this product if any parts are broken, torn, or missing. Contact Cangaroo for replacement parts if needed.
- **WARNING:** The maximum weight capacity for this crib is 12 kg. Do not exceed this limit.
- **WARNING:** Never leave your child unattended in the crib.
- **WARNING:** Ensure the crib is placed on a flat, stable, and horizontal surface. Non-slip feet are provided for secure placement.
- **WARNING:** When used as a bedside crib, ensure there is no gap between the crib and the parent's bed that could trap a child. Always secure the crib firmly to the parent's bed using the provided attachment system.
- **WARNING:** Do not add extra mattresses, pillows, or padding inside the crib. Use only the mattress provided by the manufacturer.
- Keep the crib away from open flames, heaters, and other sources of strong heat.
- Regularly check all screws, bolts, and fasteners to ensure they are tight and secure.

- Crib frame components
- Fabric crib body
- Mattress
- Attachment straps for bedside use
- Assembly hardware (screws, bolts, etc.)

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly of the Cangaroo Always Together Bedside Crib is required. Follow these general steps. Refer to the included assembly guide for detailed, step-by-step visual instructions.

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging and lay them out on a clean, flat surface.
2. **Assemble Frame:** Connect the main frame components according to the diagrams in your assembly guide. Ensure all connections are secure and click into place where applicable.
3. **Attach Fabric Body:** Slide or clip the fabric crib body onto the assembled frame. Ensure all zippers or fasteners are properly secured.
4. **Insert Mattress:** Place the provided mattress into the crib. Ensure it fits snugly without gaps around the edges.
5. **Final Check:** Before first use, double-check that all parts are correctly assembled and securely fastened.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Height Adjustment

The crib features 5-way adjustable height settings, ranging from 45 cm to 60 cm. To adjust the height, locate the adjustment buttons or levers on each side of the crib frame. Simultaneously press and hold them while raising or lowering the crib to the desired position. Ensure both sides are adjusted to the same height and lock securely into place before use.

2. Tilt Function

The crib can be tilted by up to 30 degrees. This feature is designed to assist with a baby's digestion, improve breathing, and help manage reflux. To activate the tilt, adjust one side of the crib to a higher setting than the other. Ensure the tilt is gentle and secure. Always monitor your baby when using the tilt function.

3. Rocking Function

To engage the rocking function, ensure the crib's feet are set to the rocking position. This typically involves rotating the feet or unlocking a mechanism that allows the base to rock gently. The rocking motion can help soothe your baby to sleep.

4. Bedside Crib Mode

The crib can be used as a bedside sleeper by lowering one side. Locate the release mechanism for the side panel and carefully lower it. Position the crib next to your parent's bed, ensuring there are no gaps. Use the provided attachment straps to securely fasten the crib to your bed frame. The crib is compatible with various types and models of parent beds.

5. Standalone Crib Mode

To use the product as a standalone crib, ensure both sides are raised and locked into position. The crib can then be placed anywhere in the room, provided it is on a stable surface and away from hazards.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Fabric Care:** The fabric components of the crib should be hand washed only. Do not machine wash, bleach, tumble dry, or iron. Allow to air dry completely.
- **Frame Cleaning:** Wipe the metal and plastic parts of the frame with a damp cloth and mild soap. Dry thoroughly. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Mattress Care:** The mattress cover can be removed and hand washed. The foam insert should be spot cleaned with a damp cloth and allowed to air dry completely before reinserting.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the crib in a clean, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Crib feels unstable:** Ensure all frame components are fully engaged and locked. Check that the height adjustment mechanisms on both sides are set to the same level and securely locked.
- **Difficulty adjusting height or tilt:** Ensure the adjustment buttons/levers are fully pressed. Check for any obstructions in the mechanism.
- **Side panel not lowering/raising smoothly:** Check for any fabric or debris obstructing the sliding mechanism. Ensure the release buttons are fully depressed.
- **Rocking function not working:** Verify that the feet are correctly positioned for rocking mode and not locked in a stationary position.
