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1. INTRODUCTION

2. INITIAL SETUP

2.1 Unpacking and First Power On

1. Carefully remove the laptop and all accessories from the packaging.
2. Connect the power adapter to the laptop's power port and then to an electrical outlet.
3. Open the laptop lid and press the power button to turn on the device.

2.2 Operating System and Software Setup

Upon first boot, you will be guided through the Windows 11 Home setup process. Follow the on-screen instructions to configure your language, region, network, and user account. The laptop comes with Office Home 2024 pre-installed; follow the activation prompts to set up your office suite.

2.3 Connecting Peripherals

Utilize the available ports to connect external devices such as a mouse, external display, or USB drives. Refer to the 'Ports' section in Specifications for a detailed list of available ports.

3. OPERATING YOUR LAPTOP

3.1 Keyboard and Touchpad

The laptop features 2x 1.5W stereo speakers with HD Audio and Dolby Audio support, providing enhanced sound quality for multimedia consumption.

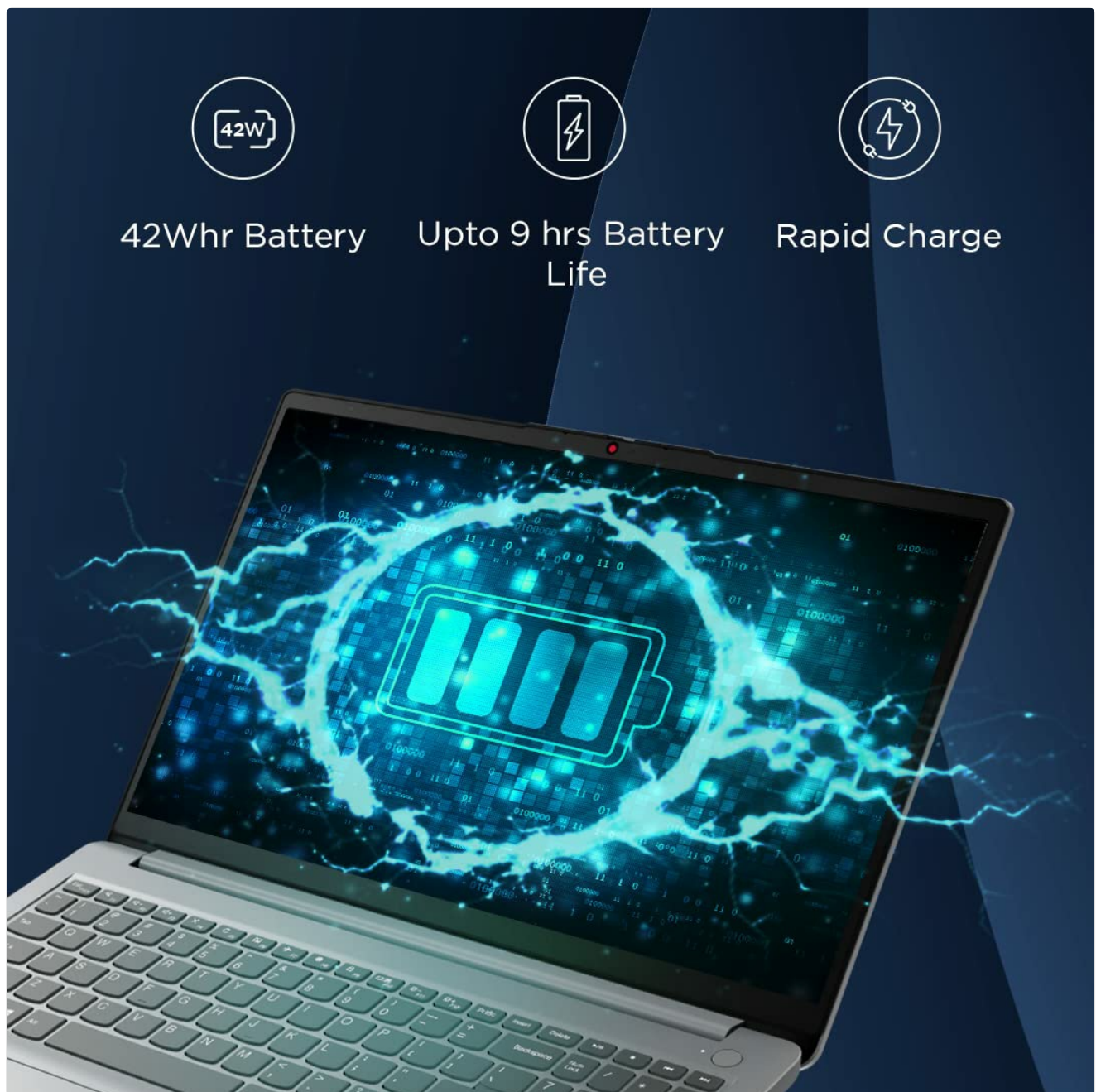


Figure 3.3: Audio Features

The laptop is equipped with a 42Wh battery, offering up to 9 hours of usage. It supports Rapid Charge technology, allowing the battery to charge up to 80% in approximately 1 hour.

4. MAINTENANCE

4.1 Cleaning Your Laptop

- Use a soft, lint-free cloth slightly dampened with water or a screen cleaner to clean the display.
- For the keyboard and chassis, use a soft cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- Ensure the laptop is powered off and unplugged before cleaning.

4.2 Battery Care

- To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently.
- Store the laptop in a cool, dry place if not used for extended periods.
- Use only the original Lenovo power adapter for charging.

4.3 Software Updates

Regularly check for and install operating system updates (Windows Update) and driver updates (Lenovo Vantage or Lenovo Support website) to ensure system stability and security.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter. For more complex problems, refer to the Warranty & Support section.

5.1 Power Issues

- **Laptop does not turn on:** Ensure the power adapter is securely connected and the battery has sufficient charge. Try holding the power button for 10-15 seconds to perform a hard reset.
- **Battery not charging:** Verify the power adapter and cable are not damaged. Try a different power outlet.

5.2 Display Problems

- **No display on screen:** Connect an external monitor to check if the issue is with the laptop's display. Press **Fn + F2** (or the appropriate function key for display toggle) to switch display output.
- **Dim display:** Adjust brightness using the function keys (**Fn + F5/F6** or similar icons).

5.3 Audio Issues

- **No sound:** Check volume levels in Windows and ensure speakers are not muted. Verify audio drivers are up to date.
- **Distorted sound:** Update audio drivers. Try connecting headphones to determine if the issue is with the internal speakers.
