# Crosley CR8017B-BK Voyager Portable Vinyl Record Player Turntable Instruction Manual

Model: CR8017B-BK

## INTRODUCTION

The Crosley Voyager Record Player is designed to combine classic vinyl listening with modern audio technology. This portable turntable supports multiple record speeds and features built-in speakers, Bluetooth connectivity for both input and output, and various audio ports for versatile use. This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, and maintaining your record player.

## PRODUCT FEATURES

- **Three-Speed Belt-Drive Turntable:** Plays 33 1/3, 45, and 78 RPM records.
- **Adjustable Pitch Control:** Fine-tune playback speed.
- **Cueing Lever:** Gently lowers and raises the needle.
- **Bluetooth In:** Stream digital music from your device to the turntable's built-in speakers.
- **Bluetooth Out:** Connect the turntable wirelessly to external Bluetooth speakers.
- **Built-in Dynamic Full-Range Stereo Speakers:** Integrated audio output.
- **Auxiliary Input:** Connect external audio sources via a 3.5mm audio cable.
- **RCA Output:** Connect to an external stereo system for enhanced audio.
- **Headphone Jack:** For private listening.
- **Portable Suitcase Design:** Compact and easy to transport with a carry handle.




Image: Key features of the Crosley Voyager turntable, highlighting the 3-speed selector, compact and portable design, and built-in stereo speakers.

## SETUP

1. **Unpack the Turntable:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Ensure all packing materials are removed from the turntable platter and tonearm.
2. **Place the Turntable:** Position the turntable on a flat, stable surface away from direct sunlight, heat sources, or excessive vibration.
3. **Connect Power:** Insert the power adaptor into the DC 12V input jack on the back of the turntable, then plug the adaptor into a wall outlet.
4. **Remove Stylus Protector:** Gently remove the white plastic stylus protector from the needle.
5. **Initial Power On:** Turn the POWER/VOLUME knob clockwise to turn on the unit. The power indicator light will illuminate.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### Playing Records

1. **Select Speed:** Set the speed selector switch (33, 45, or 78 RPM) to match the record you are playing. Use the included 45 RPM adapter for 7-inch records with large center holes.
2. **Place Record:** Place a record on the turntable platter.
3. **Unlock Tonearm:** Release the tonearm clip.
4. **Raise Tonearm:** Lift the cueing lever to raise the tonearm.
5. **Position Tonearm:** Manually move the tonearm over the desired track of the record.
6. **Lower Tonearm:** Gently lower the cueing lever to place the stylus on the record. The platter will begin to spin.
7. **Adjust Volume:** Rotate the POWER/VOLUME knob to adjust the sound level.
8. **Adjust Pitch:** Use the PITCH control knob to fine-tune the playback speed if needed.
9. **End of Playback:** When the record finishes, the tonearm will automatically return to its rest position (if auto-stop is enabled). Lift the tonearm, return it to the rest, and secure the clip.

### Bluetooth Input (Streaming to Turntable)

1. **Select Bluetooth Mode:** Slide the PHONO/BT switch to the BT position. The Bluetooth indicator light will flash blue.
2. **Pair Device:** On your Bluetooth-enabled device (e.g., smartphone, tablet), search for "Crosley Voyager" in the Bluetooth settings and pair. Once connected, the indicator light will glow solid blue.
3. **Play Music:** Start playing music on your device. The audio will stream through the turntable's built-in speakers.
4. **Adjust Volume:** Control the volume using both your device and the turntable's POWER/VOLUME knob.

### Bluetooth Output (Streaming from Turntable)

1. **Enable Pairing on External Speaker:** Put your external Bluetooth speaker into pairing mode.
2. **Select Bluetooth Output Mode:** Slide the PHONO/BT switch to the BT position. The Bluetooth indicator light will flash blue.
3. **Initiate Pairing:** The turntable will automatically search for and connect to the nearest Bluetooth speaker in pairing mode. Once connected, the indicator light will glow solid blue.
4. **Play Record:** Place a record and begin playback as described above. The audio will now stream to your external Bluetooth speaker.

## Using Aux Input or Headphone Jack

- **Auxiliary Input:** Connect an external audio device (e.g., MP3 player) to the AUX IN port on the back of the turntable using a 3.5mm audio cable. The audio will play through the turntable's speakers.
- **Headphone Jack:** For private listening, plug headphones into the headphone jack on the front panel. The built-in speakers will be muted.

## MAINTENANCE

---

- **Cleaning the Stylus:** Use a soft brush to gently clean the stylus (needle) from back to front. Avoid touching the stylus with your fingers.
- **Cleaning the Turntable:** Wipe the turntable cabinet with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Record Care:** Keep records clean and free of dust. Store them vertically in their sleeves to prevent warping.
- **Stylus Replacement:** The stylus has a limited lifespan. If sound quality deteriorates, replace the stylus. Consult Crosley support for compatible replacement styli.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you experience issues with your Crosley Voyager turntable, please refer to the following common solutions:

- **No Power:** Ensure the power adaptor is securely connected to both the turntable and a working wall outlet. Check if the POWER/VOLUME knob is turned on.
- **No Sound:**
  - Check the POWER/VOLUME knob and turn it up.
  - If using Bluetooth output, ensure the external speaker is powered on and paired correctly.
  - If using RCA output, verify connections to your stereo system and its input selection.

- If using headphones, ensure they are fully plugged in.
- Ensure the stylus protector has been removed.
- **Skipping or Distorted Sound:**
  - Clean the record and stylus.
  - Ensure the turntable is on a stable, level surface.
  - Check if the record is warped or damaged.
  - Verify the correct speed setting (33 1/3, 45, or 78 RPM) is selected.
- **Bluetooth Pairing Issues:**
  - Ensure the turntable is in the correct Bluetooth mode (input or output).
  - Make sure your device or external speaker is in pairing mode and within range.
  - Try restarting both the turntable and the Bluetooth device.





Image: Detailed diagram illustrating the overall dimensions of the Crosley Voyager turntable.
