INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the user manual for your new OnePlus 9RT 5G smartphone. This guide provides essential information on setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your device. Please read this manual carefully to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your smartphone.

SETUP

1. Unboxing and Initial Inspection

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Ensure the device and accessories are free from damage. The package typically includes the OnePlus 9RT smartphone, a charger, a USB cable, and a SIM ejector tool.

2. SIM Card Installation

Locate the SIM card tray on the side of your device. Use the provided SIM ejector tool to open the tray. Insert your Nano-SIM card(s) into the tray with the gold contacts facing down. Ensure the tray is fully reinserted into the device.

3. Initial Power On and Setup

Press and hold the power button until the OnePlus logo appears. Follow the on-screen instructions to select your language, connect to a Wi-Fi network, and set up your Google account. This process will also guide you through setting up security features like fingerprint unlock or facial recognition.

1. Basic Navigation

Your OnePlus 9RT features a responsive AMOLED touchscreen. Use gestures for navigation:

- **Swipe up from the bottom:** Go to the home screen.
- **Swipe up and hold:** Open recent apps.
- **Swipe from the left or right edge:** Go back.
- **Swipe down from the top:** Access notifications and quick settings.

2. Making Calls and Sending Messages

Tap the Phone icon to make calls. Enter the number or select a contact. Tap the Messages icon to send text messages. Select a contact and type your message.

3. Connecting to Wi-Fi

Go to **Settings > Wi-Fi**. Toggle Wi-Fi on and select your desired network. Enter the password if prompted.

4. Using the Camera

The OnePlus 9RT features an advanced camera system co-developed with SONY, utilizing the IMX766 sensor for enhanced photography, especially in low-light conditions. Open the Camera app, select your desired mode (Photo, Video, Portrait, Nightscape), and tap the shutter button to capture images or start recording.

5. Gaming Features

The OnePlus 9RT is optimized for mobile gaming. It offers features to enhance response times, improve Wi-Fi stability, and provide immersive haptic feedback. Access Game Space for specific gaming optimizations and settings.

MAINTENANCE

1. Cleaning Your Device

Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and body of your phone. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials. Do not expose the device to excessive moisture.

2. Software Updates

Regularly check for and install software updates to ensure your device has the latest features, security patches, and performance improvements. Go to **Settings > System > System updates**.

3. Battery Care

To prolong battery life (4500 Milliamp Hours), avoid extreme temperatures. Use the original charger and cable. It is recommended to keep the battery charge between 20% and 80% for optimal long-term health.

4. Storage Management

Your device comes with 128GB of internal storage. Regularly review and delete unnecessary files, apps, and media to maintain optimal performance. You can check storage usage in **Settings > Storage**.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your OnePlus 9RT, try the following solutions:

- **Device not powering on:** Ensure the battery is charged. Connect the device to its charger for at least 15 minutes, then try powering it on again.
- **Network connectivity issues:** Check if your SIM card is properly inserted. Try toggling Airplane Mode on and off. Restart your device. Verify your mobile data settings.
- **Wi-Fi connection problems:** Ensure Wi-Fi is enabled. Restart your router and your phone. Forget the network and reconnect.
- **Device overheating:** Excessive heat can occur during prolonged heavy usage, such as gaming or video streaming. Close background applications, reduce screen brightness, and avoid using the device while charging if it feels excessively warm. If overheating persists, contact support.
- **Apps crashing or freezing:** Clear the cache for the problematic app (**Settings > Apps > App info > Storage & cache > Clear cache**). If the issue continues, try reinstalling the app.
- **Slow performance:** Free up storage space, close unused apps, and restart your device regularly.
