Model: LaFerrari Aperta (B09MYR9L97)

## INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe operation, setup, and maintenance of your RASTAR 1/14 Scale Ferrari LaFerrari Aperta RC Drift Car. Please read this manual thoroughly before operating the vehicle to ensure proper function and longevity.

## SAFETY INFORMATION

- This product is suitable for users aged 8 years and above. Adult supervision is recommended for younger users.
- Do not operate the RC car near people, pets, or obstacles.
- Avoid operating in wet conditions or on public roads.
- Always turn off the car and remote control when not in use.
- Use only the recommended batteries. Do not mix old and new batteries, or different types of batteries.
- Keep fingers, hair, and loose clothing away from moving parts.

- 1 x RASTAR 1/14 Scale Ferrari LaFerrari Aperta RC Car
- 1 x 2.4GHz Remote Controller
- 1 x Instruction Manual

## SETUP

---

### 1. Battery Installation (RC Car)

1. Locate the battery compartment on the underside of the RC car.
2. Use a screwdriver to open the battery compartment cover.
3. Insert 5 x AA batteries into the compartment, ensuring correct polarity (+/-).
4. Replace the battery compartment cover and secure it with the screw.

### 2. Battery Installation (Remote Controller)

1. Locate the battery compartment on the back of the remote controller.
2. Open the battery compartment cover.
3. Insert 2 x AA batteries into the compartment, ensuring correct polarity (+/-).
4. Replace the battery compartment cover.

### 3. Pairing the Car and Remote

- Ensure both the RC car and the remote controller have fresh batteries installed.
- Turn on the RC car using the power switch located on its underside.
- Turn on the remote controller. The indicator light on the remote should blink.
- The remote control will automatically pair with the car. Once paired, the indicator light on the remote will stop blinking and remain solid.
- If pairing fails, turn off both devices and repeat the steps.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### Basic Controls

- **Forward:** Push the throttle trigger forward.
- **Reverse:** Pull the throttle trigger backward.
- **Turn Left:** Turn the steering wheel on the remote counter-clockwise.
- **Turn Right:** Turn the steering wheel on the remote clockwise.
- **Stop:** Release the throttle trigger to its neutral position.

## Drifting Function

The Ferrari LaFerrari Aperta RC car is designed for drifting. To perform a drift:

1. Accelerate the car to a moderate speed (at least 2 meters of clear space is recommended).
2. While maintaining speed, quickly press the speed button (if available on your remote) and simultaneously turn the steering wheel sharply left or right.
3. The car will sideslip due to its speed, inertia, and oversteering. Practice is required to master drifting techniques.

## Performance Notes

- **Remote Range:** Up to 98 feet (approximately 30 meters).
- **Speed:** Approximately 5.1 mph (8.2 km/h).
- **Frequency:** 2.4GHz system allows multiple cars to operate simultaneously without interference.

## MAINTENANCE

### Cleaning

- Wipe the car with a soft, dry cloth after each use to remove dust and debris.
- Do not use water or chemical cleaners, as this can damage electronic components.

### Battery Care and Storage

- Always remove batteries from both the car and the remote control when not in use for extended periods.
- Store the car and remote in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Dispose of used batteries responsibly according to local regulations.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Car does not respond to remote.	Low batteries in car or remote; Car and remote not paired; Power switch off.	Replace batteries; Re-pair car and remote; Ensure power switches are ON.
Poor range or intermittent control.	Weak batteries; Environmental interference; Operating beyond range.	Replace batteries; Move to an open area away from other electronic devices; Operate within specified range.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Car moves slowly or drifts poorly.	Low car batteries; Obstruction in wheels.	Replace car batteries; Check wheels for debris and clear if necessary.
