

3. SETUP


3.1 Attaching the Stand

- 1. Place the TV screen-down on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches.
- 2. Align each stand leg with the corresponding slots on the bottom of the TV.
- 3. Secure each leg with the provided screws.

3.2 Connecting Devices

Connect your external devices such as cable boxes, gaming consoles, or sound systems to the appropriate ports on the back of the TV.

- **HDMI Ports:** The TV features 3 HDMI 2.0 ports and 1 HDMI 2.1 port with eARC for high-definition audio and video.
- Ethernet: For a stable wired internet connection.

4.4 Picture and Sound Settings

4.5 Accessibility Features

5. MAINTENANCE

To clean the screen, gently wipe it with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth. For stubborn marks, slightly dampen the cloth with water. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.

5.2 Software Updates

Your Fire TV receives guaranteed software security updates for at least four years from its last availability for purchase. Ensure your TV is connected to the internet to receive these updates, which improve performance and security. You can check for updates in the TV's settings menu.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Fire TV, consider the following common solutions:

- No Power: Ensure the power cord is securely connected to both the TV and the power outlet. Try a
 different outlet.
- No Picture/Sound: Verify that all HDMI cables are correctly connected to the TV and external devices.
 Check the input source selection on your TV.
- Remote Not Responding: Replace the AAA batteries in the Fire TV Alexa Voice Remote. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV.
- **Network Connectivity Issues:** Check your Wi-Fi router and internet connection. Restart your router and the TV. For a more stable connection, consider using an Ethernet cable.
- App Performance: If an app is slow or unresponsive, try restarting the app or clearing its cache in the TV's settings. Ensure the TV's software is up to date.
- Alexa Not Responding: Ensure the microphone is not muted (check the physical switch on the TV). Speak clearly and be within range of the TV.
