- 1. Heat Water: Heat fresh water to approximately 90-96°C (195-205°F). Do not use boiling water directly.
- 2. **Bloom the Coffee:** Slowly pour just enough hot water over the coffee grounds to saturate them completely. Wait for about 30 seconds. This allows the coffee to
