1. Introduction

Thank you for choosing the Thule Evo FixPoint Roof Rack System. This system is designed to provide a secure and versatile solution for transporting gear on vehicles equipped with integrated fixed points, T-profile, or custom install rack attachment points. 2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Thule Evo FixPoint is a load carrier foot designed for the Thule Evo roof rack system. It provides a strong and stable base for various Thule accessories.

- **Easy Installation:** Foot installs easily onto vehicles with integrated fixed points, T-profile, or custom install rack attachment points.
- **Secure Attachment:** Features an ergonomic torque limiter key that indicates when the rack is safely and properly secured to your vehicle, preventing overtightening.
- Thule One-Key Compatible: Secures to vehicle with Thule One-Key locks (sold separately) for enhanced security.
- Vehicle Specific Fit: Always check the Thule Buyer's Guide to find the correct roof rack components for your specific car model.

3. SAFETY INFORMATION

Always prioritize safety during installation and use. Failure to follow these guidelines may result in property damage, injury, or death.

- Ensure all components are correctly installed and tightened according to the instructions.
- Do not exceed the maximum load capacity specified for your vehicle's roof or the Thule roof rack system.
- Regularly check the tightness of all bolts and straps, especially before long trips and after driving on rough roads.
- · Distribute the load evenly on the roof rack.
- Drive at reduced speeds, especially in crosswinds, on rough roads, or when carrying large or heavy loads.
- Avoid automatic car washes when the roof rack or accessories are installed.
- Be aware of the increased height and width of your vehicle when carrying loads, especially when entering garages or low-clearance areas.

4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The Thule Evo FixPoint system is designed for straightforward installation. Refer to the specific fit kit instructions provided with your product for precise measurements and vehicle-specific details.

General Installation Steps:

- 1. Prepare the Vehicle: Ensure your vehicle's roof and fixed points are clean and free from debris.
- Assemble Foot Packs: Attach the foot packs to the crossbars (sold separately) according to the instructions provided with the crossbars.
- 3. **Position on Roof:** Place the assembled roof rack system onto your vehicle's fixed points. Ensure correct alignment as per your vehicle's fit guide.
- 4. **Secure the Feet:** Use the ergonomic torque limiter key to tighten the foot packs onto the fixed points. The key will click when the correct torque is reached, indicating a secure fit without overtightening.
- 5. Install Locks (Optional): For added security, install Thule One-Key locks into the foot pack covers.
- 6. **Final Check:** Before driving, gently pull on the crossbars to ensure they are firmly attached to the vehicle.




Image: The ergonomic torque limiter key ensures proper tightening of the foot pack.

5. OPERATION

Once installed, your Thule Evo FixPoint roof rack system is ready to carry various Thule accessories such as bike carriers, ski carriers, cargo boxes, and kayak carriers.

- Always refer to the specific instructions for any Thule accessory you attach to the roof rack.
- Ensure all loads are securely fastened to prevent shifting during transit.
- Periodically check the security of your load during long journeys.

6. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance will extend the life of your Thule Evo FixPoint roof rack system.

- Cleaning: Clean the roof rack regularly with mild soap and water. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect all components for wear, damage, or corrosion. Replace any damaged parts immediately.
- **Lubrication:** Lubricate moving parts and lock cylinders annually with a non-petroleum-based lubricant.
- Storage: If not in use for extended periods, remove the roof rack and store it in a dry, protected area.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Thule Evo FixPoint system, consider the following:

- Loose Fit: Re-tighten the foot packs using the torque limiter key until it clicks. Ensure the correct fit kit is used for your vehicle.
- **Noise:** Excessive noise can be caused by improper installation, loose components, or incorrect positioning of accessories. Recheck all connections and ensure accessories are aerodynamic.
- **Difficulty Installing Accessories:** Ensure the T-track rubber strip is correctly inserted and trimmed if necessary.
- **Missing Parts:** If any parts are missing upon delivery, contact your retailer or Thule customer support immediately.




