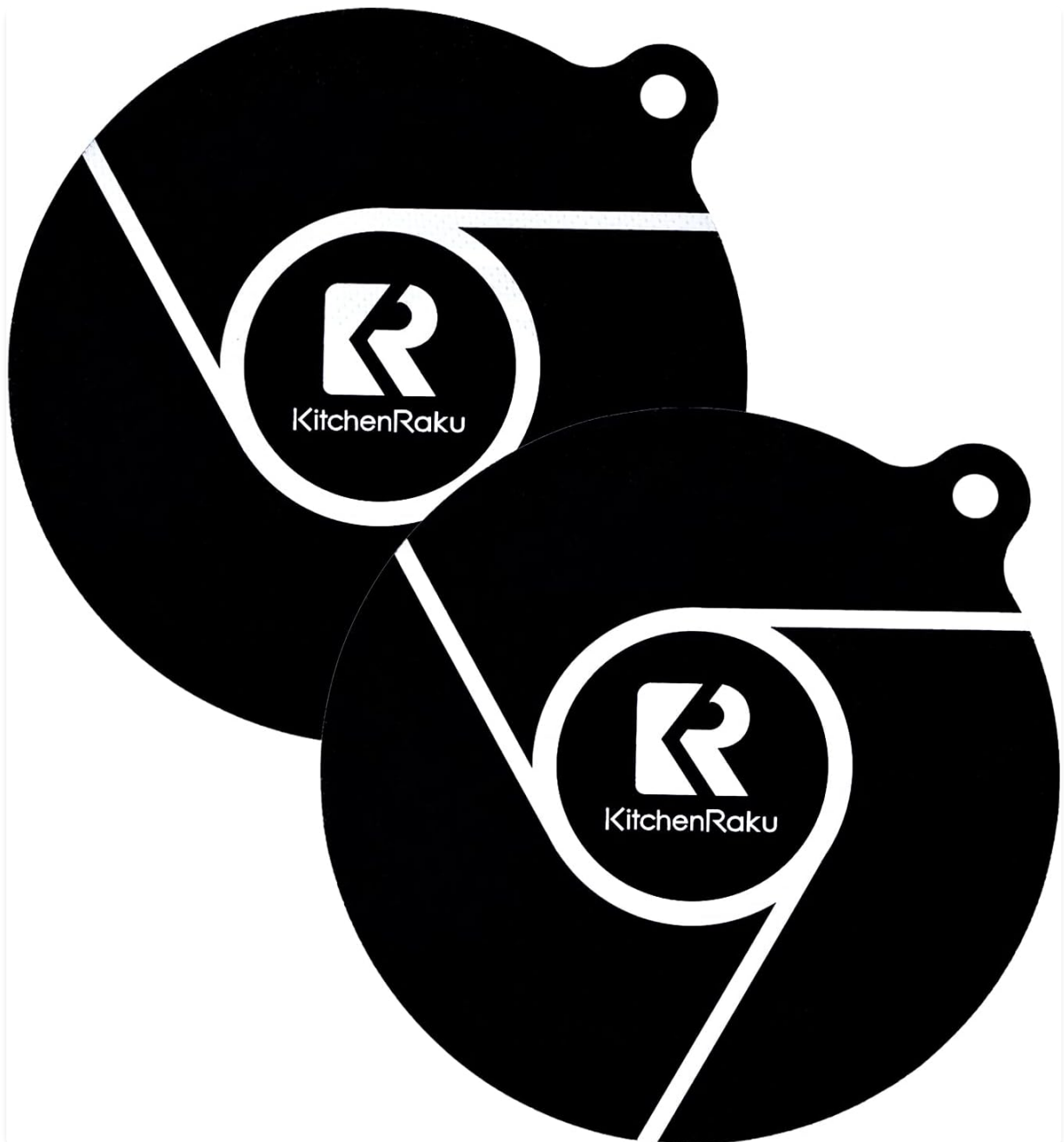

### PRODUCT OVERVIEW

It helps prevent scratches and stains, extending the lifespan of your appliance. Made from platinum food-grade silicone, it is reusable, 100% non-stick, and heat resistant up to 450°F.

The mat features a non-slip surface to keep pots and pans stable during cooking. Its flexible and durable design makes it easy to clean and dishwasher safe. Additionally, it includes a hanging hole for convenient drying and storage. This versatile mat can also be used as an air fryer mat, microwave mat, oven baking mat, trivet, placemat, pot holder, grip support, food cover, or utensil rest.

#### **IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION**

- **Compatibility:** This mat is **only for use on induction (magnetic) cooktops**. It is not suitable for regular electric glass or ceramic cooktops. Using it on non-induction cooktops will cause the mat to burn.
- **Temperature Limit:** Do not expose the mat to temperatures over 450°F (232°C).

If you can use any glass, ceramic or aluminium cookware, or the plate turned red when cooking, then your cooktop is not an induction cooktop.

### SETUP

Before first use, wash the mat with warm water and mild detergent, then dry thoroughly.

1. Ensure your induction cooktop surface is clean and dry.
2. Carefully place the KITCHENRAKU KR Induction Cooktop Protector Mat directly onto the desired cooking zone of your induction cooktop.
3. Ensure the mat lies flat and is centered on the cooking zone.

### OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

#### Using the Mat for Cooking

1. Place the mat on your induction cooktop as described in the Setup section.
2. Place your induction-compatible pot or pan directly on top of the mat.
3. Activate your induction cooktop and adjust the power (200-2200W) or temperature settings. The mat

will not interfere with the induction heating process.

4. Monitor cooking temperatures to ensure they do not exceed 450°F (232°C).

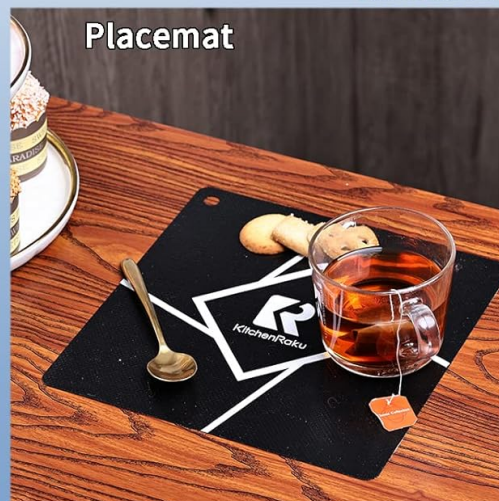

## TROUBLESHOOTING

### Cooktop Not Activating or Mat Burning

- **Verify Cooktop Type:** Confirm that your cooktop is an induction (magnetic) model. The mat is not compatible with electric glass or ceramic cooktops.
- **Check Cookware Compatibility:** Ensure your pots and pans are induction-compatible. Induction cooktops require ferromagnetic cookware.
- **Temperature Exceeded:** If the mat shows signs of burning or melting, the temperature limit of 450°F (232°C) has been exceeded. Reduce the heat setting on your cooktop.
