- Do not paint the detector.
- Do not use cleaning products on the detector.
- Regular testing and maintenance are essential for proper functioning.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

- Choose Location:** The detector functions optimally when mounted on the ceiling, at least 1.85 meters (approximately 6 feet) above the heating source. Ideal locations include near a water heater or gas oven in the kitchen.
- Mounting:** Use the provided screws to securely mount the detector to the ceiling or wall.
- Battery Installation:** Install the included battery. The detector will emit a short beep when the battery is nearly empty, indicating it's time for replacement.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The detector is designed for continuous operation.

Alarm Signal

The detector will emit a loud 85 dB alarm when the carbon monoxide concentration exceeds safe levels.

Low Battery Warning

A short beep will sound when the battery is nearly empty. Replace the battery promptly to ensure continuous protection.

Testing the Detector

Test the detector monthly by pressing the test button to ensure it is functioning correctly.

MAINTENANCE


