1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the assembly, operation, and maintenance of your Yaheetech Small Animal Cage, Model 591934. Designed for small animals such as ferrets, chinchillas, and sugar gliders, this cage offers a secure and comfortable habitat. Please read all instructions carefully before assembly and use.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always ensure all parts are securely fastened before placing animals inside.
- Regularly inspect the cage for any damage or loose components.
- The bar spacing is 3/4 inch. Ensure this spacing is suitable for your specific pet to prevent escape or injury.
- For animals with sensitive feet, consider adding solid floor coverings to platforms and ramps to prevent discomfort or injury.

- Keep the cage away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and hazardous materials.

3. PARTS LIST

Before beginning assembly, verify that all components listed below are present. All necessary hardware, numbered parts, and tools are provided.

Included Components:

- Metal Cage Panels
- Removable Tray
- Plastic Platform (1x)
- Plastic Ramp (1x)
- Fabric Covers for Platform and Ramp (2x)
- Wheels (4x)
- Assembly Hardware (bolts, nuts, etc.)
- Assembly Tools (Allen wrench)

4. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the step-by-step instructions provided in the package for detailed assembly. It is recommended to loosely fasten all bolts initially and tighten them once the main structure is complete to ensure proper alignment.

1. Unpack all components and verify against the parts list.
2. Assemble the base frame, attaching the four wheels securely.
3. Attach the side and back panels to the base.
4. Insert the removable tray into its designated slot at the bottom of the cage.
5. Install the plastic platform and ramp, ensuring they are stable. Apply the fabric covers to the platform and ramp.
6. Attach the front door panel, ensuring the locking mechanism functions correctly.
7. Secure the top panel, ensuring the rooftop opening mechanism is functional.
8. Once all panels are in place, fully tighten all bolts.

5. OPERATING THE CAGE

5.1 Access Doors

The cage features a full-width swing locking door on the front for secure access to your pet and for placing accessories. An additional opening on the rooftop is designed for convenient feeding and safe access.

5.2 Mobility

The cage sits on a rolling stand equipped with 360-degree casters, allowing for easy maneuverability. This feature enables you to move the cage effortlessly to any desired location.

5.3 Storage

The 4-wheel stand also provides an extra mesh storage shelf below the cage, ideal for keeping pet accessories, food, and cleaning supplies handy and organized.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Cleaning the Removable Tray

The cage is equipped with a removable pull-out tray at the bottom, designed for easy waste collection. To clean, simply slide out the tray, dispose of waste, and wash with pet-safe cleaning solutions. Ensure the tray is completely dry before reinserting.

6.2 General Cage Cleaning

Regularly wipe down the metal bars and plastic components with a damp cloth and pet-safe cleaner. The fabric ramp and platform covers can be removed and washed as needed to maintain hygiene.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

7.1 Pet Escaping

If your pet is escaping, double-check that all doors are securely latched and that the bar spacing is appropriate for your animal's size. Smaller animals may require additional mesh or barriers to prevent escape through the 3/4 inch bar spacing.

7.2 Unstable Ramps/Platforms

Ensure that the plastic ramps and platforms are correctly hooked into the cage bars. If they feel unstable, re-adjust their position or check for any bent hooks. Fabric covers should be securely attached to prevent slipping.

7.3 Difficulty Moving Cage

Check that the wheels are not locked and are free of debris. Ensure all four wheels are properly installed and rotating 360 degrees. If a wheel is damaged, contact customer support for a replacement.
