## 1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

---

The SogesHome Free Standing Clothing Rack, Model UT-011, is a versatile storage solution designed for bedrooms, entryways, and other living spaces. It combines a sturdy hanging rod for garments with three-tier storage shelves, offering ample space for clothes, shoes, bags, and other accessories. Its A-line design ensures stability, and the vintage brown finish complements various home decors.

### Key Features:

- **Ample Storage:** Features a hanging rod and three shelves for organized storage.
- **Sturdy Construction:** Made with a powder-coated metal frame and E1 particle wood boards.
- **Stable Design:** A-line structure and adjustable foot pads enhance stability.

## 2. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

---

Before beginning assembly, ensure all parts are present and undamaged. It is recommended to assemble the unit on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches. All required tools are included in the package.

### Package Contents:

Refer to the included instruction manual for a detailed list of parts and hardware. Typically, the package includes:

- Metal frame components (A-frame uprights, connecting bars)
- Wooden shelf boards
- Hanging rod
- Adjustable foot pads
- Assembly hardware (screws, bolts, Allen wrench)

## Assembly Steps:

1. **Unpack and Identify Parts:** Carefully unbox all components and lay them out. Match each part to the diagram in the provided instruction manual.

6. **Adjust Foot Pads:** Place the assembled rack in its desired location. Adjust the foot pads at the bottom of the frame to ensure the rack is level and stable on uneven surfaces.

### 3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

The SogesHome Free Standing Clothing Rack is designed for efficient organization of your garments and accessories.

#### Using the Hanging Rod:

- Use standard hangers to hang coats, shirts, dresses, and other clothing items.
- Distribute weight evenly along the rod to maintain balance and prevent strain on the frame.
- Do not exceed the maximum load capacity of 66 lbs (30 kg) for the hanging rod.

#### Utilizing the Storage Shelves:

- The three-tier shelves are suitable for folded clothes, shoes, bags, hats, scarves, and decorative items.
- Place heavier items on the bottom shelf (max 66 lbs / 30 kg) for better stability.
- The upper shelves can hold up to 33 lbs (15 kg) each.
- Consider using storage baskets or bins on the shelves for smaller items to maintain a tidy

appearance.

## 4. MAINTENANCE

Proper care and maintenance will extend the life and appearance of your SogesHome clothing rack.

### Cleaning:

- **Metal Frame:** Wipe the metal frame with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that could damage the powder coating.
- **Wooden Shelves:** The E1 particle wood boards are waterproof and scratch-resistant. Clean them with a soft, damp cloth and mild detergent if necessary. Dry immediately to prevent water spots.
- Do not use excessive water directly on the wooden surfaces.

### General Care:

- Regularly check all screws and bolts to ensure they remain tight. Retighten as needed to maintain structural integrity.
- Avoid placing extremely hot or cold items directly on the wooden shelves without protection.
- Do not overload the hanging rod or shelves beyond their specified weight capacities.

- Keep the rack away from direct sunlight and excessive humidity to prevent material degradation.

## 5. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter any issues with your clothing rack, refer to the following common solutions:

### Stability Issues:

- **Wobbling:** Ensure all screws and bolts are securely tightened. Check that the rack is placed on a flat, level surface.
- **Uneven Floor:** Adjust the foot pads at the bottom of the frame. Turn them clockwise or counter-clockwise until the rack is stable and level.
- **Overloading:** Reduce the weight on the hanging rod or shelves if the rack appears unstable. Ensure weight is distributed evenly.

### Missing or Damaged Parts:

- If you find any parts missing or damaged upon opening the package, do not proceed with assembly.
