INTRODUCTION

This user manual provides essential information for the safe and effective operation of your Hubble Nursery Pal Essentials 2.8 inch Video Baby Monitor. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product and retain it for future reference.

The Hubble Nursery Pal Essentials is designed to help you monitor your baby with a secure and private connection, offering features such as room temperature sensing, digital zoom, and two-way communication.

PRODUCT COMPONENTS

The Hubble Nursery Pal Essentials 2.8 inch Video Baby Monitor system typically includes the following components:

- Parent Unit (2.8-inch color screen video monitor)
- Baby Unit (Camera with remote zoom, pan, and tilt)
- Power Adapters for Parent Unit and Baby Unit
- Quick Start Guide (not included in this manual)



SETUP

1. Powering On the Units

1. Connect the power adapter to the Baby Unit (camera) and plug it into a wall outlet.
2. Connect the power adapter to the Parent Unit (monitor) and plug it into a wall outlet. The Parent Unit has an extended battery for portable use, but it should be charged before first use.

2. Positioning the Baby Unit (Camera)

Place the Baby Unit in a location that provides a clear view of your baby's crib or sleeping area. Ensure it is at least 1 meter (3 feet) away from the baby to prevent any cord hazards. The camera features remote zoom, pan, and tilt capabilities, allowing for flexible positioning.

3. Initial Pairing (if necessary)

The Parent Unit and Baby Unit are typically pre-paired at the factory. If they do not connect automatically, refer to the troubleshooting section or the quick start guide for manual pairing instructions.

4. HubbleClub App Connection (Optional)

For enhanced features and remote monitoring, download the HubbleClub app on your smartphone. The app allows for secure Wi-Fi connection to the camera, enabling features like baby growth and development tracking, expert sleep advice, and parenting tips.



OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Parent Unit Overview

The 2.8-inch color screen on the Parent Unit displays the live video feed from the Baby Unit. Controls on the Parent Unit allow you to manage various functions.

- **Volume Control:** Adjust the audio level of your baby's sounds.
- **Digital Zoom:** Magnify the image on the screen for a closer look.
- **Two-Way Talk:** Press and hold the talk button to speak to your baby through the Baby Unit.
- **Menu Navigation:** Access settings for brightness, lullabies, and other features.

2. Monitoring Features

- **Room Temperature Display:** The Parent Unit displays the current room temperature detected by the Baby Unit, helping you ensure a comfortable environment for your baby.
- **Infrared Night Vision:** The Baby Unit automatically activates infrared night vision in low-light conditions, providing a clear black-and-white video feed of your baby even in complete darkness.
- **Visual Sound Level Indicator:** LED lights on the Parent Unit indicate the level of sound detected in your baby's room, even if the volume is turned down.
- **Soothing Nature Sounds/Lullabies:** The Baby Unit can play pre-programmed soothing nature sounds or lullabies to help calm your baby. These can be controlled from the Parent Unit or the HubbleClub app.
- **7-Color Night Light:** The Baby Unit features an integrated 7-color night light, which can be adjusted to provide a gentle glow in the nursery.



MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your baby monitor.

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the surfaces of the Parent Unit and Baby Unit. Do not use cleaning sprays or liquid cleaners.
- **Battery Care:** For the Parent Unit's rechargeable battery, avoid extreme temperatures. Fully charge the unit before long periods of inactivity.
- **Storage:** Store the monitor in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight when not in use.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Hubble Nursery Pal Essentials, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Solution
---------	-------------------

Problem	Possible Solution
No picture or sound on Parent Unit.	<p>Ensure both Parent Unit and Baby Unit are powered on and connected to their respective power adapters.</p> <p>Check if the Parent Unit's battery is charged.</p> <p>Move the Parent Unit closer to the Baby Unit to improve signal range (up to 300m/1000ft in open space).</p> <p>Re-pair the units if necessary (refer to quick start guide for specific steps).</p>
Picture is black and white.	<p>This indicates that the infrared night vision is active due to low light conditions. This is normal operation.</p>
Static or interference.	<p>Move the units away from other electronic devices (e.g., microwaves, Wi-Fi routers) that may cause interference.</p> <p>Adjust the position of the Baby Unit or Parent Unit.</p>
Cannot connect to HubbleClub App.	<p>Ensure your smartphone is connected to a stable Wi-Fi network.</p> <p>Verify that the Baby Unit is connected to your home Wi-Fi network.</p> <p>Restart the Baby Unit and your smartphone.</p> <p>Check for app updates.</p>
