1. Introduction

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: TOY INSIDE - For use under adult supervision.

- Always ensure adult supervision when a child is using the tricycle.
- Do not use the tricycle near stairs, on steep slopes, or in areas with vehicular traffic.
- Ensure all parts are securely assembled before each use.
- Children should wear appropriate safety gear, such as a helmet, when riding.
- The maximum weight capacity for this tricycle is 50 kg.

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly should be performed by an adult. Please follow these general steps. Refer to the included assembly diagram for detailed instructions.

- 1. Unpack Components: Carefully remove all parts from the packaging.
- 2. Attach Rear Wheels: Securely attach the two rear wheels to the main axle.
- 3. Install Front Wheel and Pedals: Attach the front wheel assembly, ensuring the pedals are correctly

oriented and secured.

- 4. **Mount Handlebar:** Insert the handlebar into the front fork and tighten it firmly. The handlebar is adjustable to accommodate your child's growth.
- 5. Attach Seat: Secure the seat to the frame.
- 6. Install Storage Basket: Attach the rear storage basket to the designated points on the frame.
- 7. Final Check: Before first use, ensure all screws, bolts, and connections are tight and secure.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Smoby Rookie Tricycle is designed for simple and intuitive use by children aged 2 years and up.

- **Riding:** Instruct the child to sit comfortably on the seat, place their feet on the pedals, and grasp the handlebars. They can propel the tricycle by pedaling and steer by turning the handlebars.
- Adjustable Handlebar: The handlebar height can be adjusted to suit the child's height as they grow. Loosen the securing mechanism, adjust to the desired height, and re-tighten firmly.
- Silent EVA Wheels: The tricycle features silent EVA wheels for quiet operation, suitable for both indoor and outdoor use.

6. MAINTENANCE

- Cleaning: Wipe the tricycle with a damp cloth and mild soap. Avoid harsh chemicals that may damage the finish.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check all nuts, bolts, and screws for tightness. Re-tighten as necessary. Inspect wheels and pedals for wear or damage.
- **Storage:** Store the tricycle in a dry, sheltered area to prevent rust and material degradation.
- Lubrication: If any moving parts, such as the wheels or pedals, begin to squeak, apply a small amount of silicone-based lubricant.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Squeaky Wheels:** If the wheels produce a squeaking sound, apply a small amount of silicone spray or light oil to the axle points where the wheels rotate. Ensure the lubricant does not get on the wheel treads.
- Loose Handlebar/Seat: If the handlebar or seat feels loose, check and tighten the corresponding fastening mechanisms. Refer to the assembly section for guidance.
- **Difficulty Pedaling:** Ensure no debris is caught in the pedal mechanism or around the front wheel axle. Check that the pedals are securely attached.




Image 8.1: A technical diagram illustrating the key dimensions (length, width, height) of the Smoby Rookie Tricycle.
