1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the Philips SPK9201B Wired RGB Gaming Mouse. 3. SETUP

The Philips SPK9201B Gaming Mouse features plug-and-play connectivity, making setup straightforward.

1. **Connect the USB Cable:** Locate an available USB port on your computer (PC or Laptop). Insert the USB connector of the Philips SPK9201B Gaming Mouse into the USB port.
2. **Driver Installation:** The mouse is designed for universal compatibility with Windows, macOS, and Linux operating systems. Necessary drivers will typically install automatically upon connection.
3. **Confirmation:** Once connected, the mouse's RGB lighting should illuminate, indicating it is powered on and ready for use.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Philips SPK9201B Gaming Mouse is equipped with features designed to enhance your gaming and

computing experience.

4.1. Button Functions

The mouse features 6 buttons for various functions. These buttons can often be customized using dedicated software (if available from the manufacturer) or operating system settings.

- **Left Click:** Primary action button.
- **Right Click:** Secondary action button, typically for context menus.
- **Scroll Wheel (Clickable):** For scrolling and often a middle-click function.
- **DPI Switch Button:** Located near the scroll wheel, used to cycle through DPI settings.
- **Side Buttons (2):** Often used for forward/backward navigation in web browsers or customizable in games.

4.2. Adjusting DPI (Dots Per Inch)

The mouse offers 4 adjustable DPI levels, allowing you to change cursor sensitivity on the fly. Press the dedicated DPI switch button (usually located behind the scroll wheel) to cycle through the following resolutions:

- 1000 DPI
- 1600 DPI
- 3200 DPI
- 6400 DPI

Each press of the DPI button will switch to the next level. The current DPI setting may be indicated by a change in the RGB lighting pattern or color, depending on the mouse's design.

4.3. RGB Lighting

The Philips SPK9201B features dynamic RGB backlighting. The lighting effects are pre-programmed and activate automatically when the mouse is connected. Specific controls for lighting customization may be available through optional software, if provided by Philips.

4.4. Macro Programming

The mouse supports macro programming functionality. This feature typically requires dedicated software, which may be available for download from the Philips support website. Once installed, the software allows you to assign complex sequences of commands to the programmable buttons, enhancing efficiency in games and applications.

5. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your gaming mouse.

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry, lint-free cloth to wipe the surface of the mouse. For stubborn dirt, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a mild cleaning solution. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Sensor Maintenance:** Keep the optical sensor on the underside of the mouse clean and free from dust or debris to ensure accurate tracking.
- **Cable Care:** Avoid sharp bends or excessive pulling on the USB cable to prevent damage.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the mouse in a clean, dry environment away from extreme temperatures.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Philips SPK9201B Gaming Mouse, refer to the following common solutions:

- **Mouse Not Responding:**
 - Ensure the USB cable is securely connected to your computer.
 - Try connecting the mouse to a different USB port.
 - Restart your computer.
- **Inaccurate Tracking:**
 - Clean the optical sensor on the underside of the mouse.
 - Ensure you are using the mouse on a suitable surface (e.g., a mouse pad).
 - Adjust the DPI setting to a different level.
- **Buttons Not Working:**
 - Check for any software conflicts or re-install mouse drivers if necessary.
 - Test the mouse on another computer to rule out system-specific issues.
