#### INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the KitchenAid 7 Cup Food Processor Plus. This manual provides essential instructions for safe operation, assembly, use, care, and maintenance of your appliance. Please read all instructions carefully before first use and retain for future reference.

This product is a renewed, certified refurbished unit. It has been inspected and tested to ensure it meets original performance standards.

#### IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Always follow basic safety precautions when using electrical appliances to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and/or injury to persons, including the following:

- · Read all instructions.
- Do not immerse the motor base in water or other liquid.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use, before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning.
- Avoid contact with moving parts.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been dropped or damaged in any manner.
- The use of attachments not recommended or sold by KitchenAid may cause fire, electric shock, or injury.
- · Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter.
- Keep hands and utensils away from moving blades or discs while processing food to prevent the risk of severe injury to persons or damage to the food processor. A scraper may be used but only when the food processor is not running.
- Blades are sharp. Handle carefully.
- To reduce the risk of injury, never place cutting blade or discs on base without first putting the work bowl properly in

place.

- Be certain lid is securely locked in place before operating appliance.
- Do not attempt to defeat the lid interlock mechanism.
- · Do not process hot liquids.
- This appliance is intended for household use only.

# PARTS AND FEATURES

Familiarize yourself with the components of your KitchenAid 7 Cup Food Processor Plus.

- Motor Base with Controls (Low, High, Off/Pulse)
- 7 Cup Work Bowl
- · Work Bowl Lid with Feed Tube
- Food Pusher
- Multi-purpose Blade (for chopping, pureeing, kneading)
- Reversible Medium Slicing/Shredding Disc
- · Thick Slicing Disc
- Dough Blade

# SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

- 1. Before first use, wash all parts except the motor base in warm, soapy water. Rinse and dry thoroughly. The work bowl, lid, and blades are top-rack dishwasher safe.
- 2. Place the motor base on a clean, dry, level surface.
- 3. Place the 7-cup work bowl onto the motor base, aligning the handle with the right side of the base. Twist clockwise until it locks into place.

- 4. Insert the desired blade or disc onto the drive adapter in the work bowl. Ensure it is seated properly.
- 5. Place the work bowl lid onto the work bowl, aligning the lid tab with the work bowl handle. Twist clockwise until it locks into place. The processor will not operate unless the lid is securely locked.
- 6. Ensure the food pusher is in place in the feed tube if not immediately adding ingredients.
- 7. Plug the power cord into a grounded electrical outlet.

# **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

# Using the Multi-purpose Blade (Chop, Puree, Knead)

- 1. Assemble the food processor with the multi-purpose blade.
- 2. Add ingredients to the work bowl. Do not overfill.
- 3. Secure the lid.
- 4. Select the desired speed: Low for chopping, High for pureeing, or use Off/Pulse for controlled processing.
- 5. Process until desired consistency is reached. For best results when chopping, use the Pulse function.
- 6. To knead dough, use the dough blade and select the Low speed.
- 7. When finished, switch to Off and unplug the appliance before removing the lid and work bowl.

# **Using Slicing/Shredding Discs**

- Assemble the food processor with the desired slicing or shredding disc. Ensure the disc is placed correctly on the drive adapter.
- 2. Secure the lid.
- 3. Turn the food processor to High speed.
- 4. Place ingredients into the feed tube. Use the food pusher to guide ingredients through the feed tube. Apply even, gentle pressure.
- 5. Do not force ingredients through the feed tube.
- 6. When finished, switch to Off and unplug the appliance before removing the lid and work bowl.

Note: For optimal performance, process firm ingredients like carrots or potatoes on **High** speed. Softer ingredients like tomatoes may yield better results with a lighter touch on the food pusher.

#### CARE AND CLEANING

Proper care ensures the longevity and performance of your food processor.

- · Always unplug the food processor before cleaning.
- The motor base should be wiped clean with a damp cloth. Do not immerse the motor base in water or other liquids.
- The work bowl, lid, multi-purpose blade, dough blade, and slicing/shredding discs are top-rack dishwasher safe. Alternatively, they can be hand washed in warm, soapy water.
- Handle blades and discs with extreme care as they are very sharp.
- For stubborn food residue, soak parts in warm, soapy water before cleaning.
- · Ensure all parts are completely dry before storing.
- All accessories nest easily inside the 7 cup work bowl for compact storage.

#### TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Food processor does not start.	<ul><li>Not plugged in.</li><li>Lid or work bowl not properly locked.</li><li>Power outage.</li></ul>	<ul> <li>Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a grounded outlet.</li> <li>Check that the work bowl and lid are twisted and locked into their correct positions.</li> <li>Check household circuit breaker.</li> </ul>
Motor stops during operation.	<ul><li>Overload protection activated.</li><li>Lid or work bowl became unlocked.</li></ul>	<ul> <li>Turn off, unplug, remove some ingredients, and wait 10-15 minutes for the motor to cool before restarting.</li> <li>Ensure the work bowl and lid are securely locked.</li> </ul>
Uneven chopping/processing.	<ul> <li>Too many ingredients.</li> <li>Ingredients not cut to uniform size.</li> <li>Incorrect speed or technique.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Process smaller batches.</li> <li>Cut ingredients into approximately 1-inch pieces before processing.</li> <li>Use the <b>Pulse</b> function for better control when chopping.</li> </ul>
