4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The Inter Link Multifunction Cabinet is delivered disassembled and requires assembly. Follow the included assembly instructions carefully for a quick and straightforward setup. The design allows for easy assembly even without prior extensive experience.

4.1 Before You Begin

- Ensure you have all components listed in the packaging. Check for any damage before starting assembly.
- Clear a spacious, clean, and flat area for assembly to prevent loss of parts and facilitate movement.
- Gather necessary tools, such as a Phillips head screwdriver (manual or electric) and a hammer.
- It is highly recommended to have two people for assembly due to the cabinet's size and weight (44 kg).

4.2 Assembly Steps

1. Unpack all parts and verify them against the parts list provided in the separate assembly guide.
2. Follow the step-by-step diagrams and written instructions meticulously as outlined in the assembly manual.
3. Pay close attention to the orientation of panels and the correct insertion of all fasteners to ensure structural integrity.
4. Install the adjustable shelves in the right-side compartment according to your desired height. Pre-drilled holes are provided for easy customization and secure placement.

Important: Ensure all screws and fittings are securely tightened before moving or loading the cabinet to prevent instability and potential hazards.

5. OPERATION AND USAGE

Your Inter Link Multifunction Cabinet is designed for versatile storage and ease of use. Here are some guidelines for optimal operation and usage:

- **Storage Capacity:** Utilize the various compartments to organize different types of items. The tall left compartment is ideal for storing long items like brooms, mops, or a vacuum cleaner, while the right side with adjustable shelves is

perfect for smaller items such as cleaning supplies, toiletries, or pantry items.

- **Weight Distribution:** Always distribute the weight of stored items evenly across the shelves and compartments to maintain the cabinet's stability. Avoid placing excessively heavy items on upper shelves to prevent tipping.
- **Door Operation:** Open and close the cabinet doors gently. Avoid slamming them to prevent unnecessary wear and tear on hinges and to ensure the longevity of the cabinet.

6. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and maintain the aesthetic appearance of your Inter Link Multifunction Cabinet, follow these simple maintenance tips:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe all surfaces with a soft, slightly damp cloth. For stubborn marks, use a mild, non-abrasive cleaning solution. Avoid harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or scouring pads that could damage the melamine finish.
- **Spills:** Promptly clean any liquid spills to prevent staining or material degradation, especially on edges and seams.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically (e.g., every 6-12 months) check all screws, hinges, and fittings to ensure they remain tight. Re-tighten if necessary to maintain stability and proper door alignment.
- **Avoid Excessive Moisture:** While durable, prolonged exposure to excessive moisture or direct water contact should be avoided to prevent swelling or degradation of the particle board.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your cabinet and provides potential solutions.

7.1 Cabinet Wobbles After Assembly

- **Solution:** First, ensure all screws and fasteners are fully tightened. Next, verify that the cabinet is placed on a level surface. If your floor is uneven, consider using furniture pads or shims under the cabinet's feet to stabilize it.

7.2 Doors Do Not Align Properly or Close Evenly

- **Solution:** Check the hinge adjustments. Most cabinet hinges allow for minor adjustments (up/down, left/right, in/out) using a screwdriver. Refer to the specific hinge instructions, if provided in the main assembly manual, for detailed adjustment procedures. Ensure the cabinet itself is level.

8. SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: Failure to follow these safety guidelines may result in injury or damage to the product.

- Always follow the assembly instructions carefully and use appropriate tools for assembly. Do not force components.
- Be aware of the cabinet's significant weight (44 kg / 97 lbs) during handling, lifting, and installation. It is strongly recommended to have assistance when moving the cabinet to prevent personal injury.
- Do not exceed the stated load limits of the shelves or the cabinet as a whole. Distribute weight evenly across all compartments to maintain stability.
- To prevent tipping, especially in households with children or pets, consider securing the cabinet to a wall using appropriate anti-tip hardware. This hardware is typically not included and must be purchased separately.
- Keep all small parts and assembly hardware out of reach of children and pets to prevent choking hazards.
